Notice of Intent to Enter into Negotiations for a Demonstration Project

CENTRAL ELECTRONIC DISPATCH FOR WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE FOR-HIRE SERVICE – Demonstration Project/Testing or experiment required – PIM #1568P00002 – DUE June 25, 2007 at 3:00 p.m.

The NYC Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) intends to enter into negotiations with Executive Charge, Inc., 1440 39<sup>th</sup> Street, Brooklyn, NY 11218, to conduct a demonstration project to establish the effectiveness of a central electronic dispatch system for wheelchair accessible for-hire service in New York City. The demonstration project will be testing dispatch technology for this service. Pursuant to Section 3-11 of the PPB Rules, the ACCO has determined that it is advantageous to the City of New York to utilize a demonstration project, which will allow the City to test and evaluate the above services to determine if the approach is successful and should be competitively acquired.
