


# LaGuardia Airport share a taxi, save money

## How LGA Group Rides Work

1. For the LGA Group Ride fare, you must share a yellow taxi with one or two other people.
2. Fare is \$22/person with two passengers and \$18/person with three passengers.
3. LGA Group Ride fares include all tolls and surcharges.
4. LGA Group Rides only travel to the drop-off zone in Midtown Manhattan. The zone is between 35th & 59th St and between 2nd Ave & 8th Ave (see map).
5. Drivers are required to begin trip once the taxi has 3 passengers or when the trunk is full. You may request for the driver to leave with 2 passengers if both riders want to pay the 2-passenger fare.
6. Your driver cannot pick up additional passengers along the ride.
7. Your driver must take the Midtown Tunnel or RFK Bridge, unless passengers select a different route.
8. The driver must use the taximeter for LGA Group Rides.
9. Each passenger may use cash or a credit/debit card to pay the fare.
10. Tipping is optional and in addition to the Group Ride fare.
11. LGA Group Ride taxi stands are in operation Monday through Friday, 7 AM – 10 AM & 4 PM – 8 PM.





# Port Authority Bus Terminal share a taxi, save money

## How Group Rides Work

1. You must be willing to share with at least one other passenger.
2. Fare is \$3/passenger.
3. Drop-offs are permitted along route to 6th Ave and W. 59th St (See suggested route on map).
4. Your driver cannot pick up additional passengers after leaving the bus terminal.
5. We recommend you pay your fare upon entering the taxi. Each passenger may use cash or a credit/debit card.
6. Group Ride fares include all taxes and surcharges.
7. The driver must use the taximeter for all Group Rides.
8. Tipping is optional and in addition to the flat fare.
9. The Port Authority Bus Terminal Group Ride taxi stand is in operation Monday to Friday, 6 AM – 10 AM.
