Depending upon the total number of points accumulated within a 15 month period, a driver may be considered a Persistent Violator. TLC offers a course that will allow a driver to lower the amount of points on a license. This course provides vital lessons by refreshing driving knowledge with a review of safe driving tips and an overview of the TLC driver and vehicle rules.
