### Notice of Public Hearing Lease Caps

The Taxi and Limousine Commission ("TLC") will hold a public hearing on the maximum lease rates for taxicabs, known as "lease caps," pursuant to section 1-78(f) of the TLC rules. The TLC requests comments and testimony as to operating expenses, driver earnings and the retention of experienced drivers in the taxi industry. Any statistical data, studies and/or surveys would be of specific interest to the TLC. Also, the TLC seeks the submission of actual evidence relating to driver earnings and any proposed modifications in the existing lease caps.

A public hearing will be held by the TLC at its offices at 40 Rector Street, 5th Floor, New York, New York 10006 on March 9, 2006, at 9:30 a.m. Persons wishing to testify at the hearing may notify the TLC in advance, either in writing or by telephone to the TLC's Office of Legal Affairs at the address and telephone given below. Any request for a sign language interpreter or other form of reasonable accommodation for a disability at the hearing must be submitted to the Office of Legal Affairs in writing, by telephone, or by TTY/TDD no later than March 1, 2006.
