

Stretch Limousine Inspection Information

To have your stretch limousine inspected, please follow the steps below:


STEP 1: You must bring with the coach letter with you to the TLC's LIC facility.

A coach letter is the document that proves that your vehicle was stretched by a Manufacturing-certified stretch limousine builder. The letter must contain the Model, Year and VIN Number of the Limo, Manufacturers' authorization, and the Coach Builder's company name and contact information.

Please note: The Coach Builder information is located on the driver's side door frame. It will have the coach builder's name and the car's information (including passenger capacity).

If the coach builder has gone out of business or of the sticker is missing or unreadable, you will need to contact the original seller or the vehicle manufacturer to get the coach builder's information.

You can only register the following stretched limousines with the TLC:



Please Note: Other vehicles are not accepted by the TLC even if they are stretched by an authorized QVM/CMC Dealer.

STEP 2: An appointment to have your vehicle inspected at our Woodside inspection facility will be scheduled for you by a TLC representative.

After your TLC vehicle application has been processed and your DMV registration verified a TLC representative will notify you of your appointment date, time and location.

Please note: An inspection can be requested after the vehicle has been registered with NYS DMV by calling (718)391-5641 and requesting an inspection appointment.

The limousine permit will be affixed to your car **only** after passing inspection by a member of the TLC's inspection staff.
