

Hello. My name is Allan Jennings. I am a candidate for the City Council in the 28th Councilmanic District, which represents parts of Richmond Hill, South Ozone Park, Jamaica and Rochdale Village.

While in the New York City Council, I secured \$7.5 million for laptop computers for every child in the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th grades in my District. You can go nowhere else in the country to find one school, much less twelve schools, in one community that has so much technology in the classrooms.

While in the City Council, I also funded many after-school programs such as math programs at PS 155 and PS 160, an athletic program at PS 48 and PS 121, a tennis program at PS 223, a sports and arts program at PS 124 as well as a homework help program at PS 40.

I also funded August Martin High School with a \$200,000 grant for their culinary program and gave over \$85,000 of college scholarships of \$500 each to 170 students at August Martin High School and Richmond Hill High School.

I also co-sponsored and passed many bills into law such as real estate property tax exemptions for persons with disabilities and the elderly and a law suspending parking meters on Sunday. I was only one of two Council Members who had the courage to vote against the 18-1/2 percent property tax increase.

While in the City Council, my District office was open from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. I would always return phone calls and personally send a letter to everyone who contacted my office. If you had a problem, you could always count on me to do my best to help you.
