

Hello fellow voters. I am Mireille Leroy and I am a candidate for the New York City Council from Southeast Queens, District 28, representing South Jamaica, which includes the South Jamaica houses, the Baisely Park houses, Rochdale Village, as well as South Ozone Park and Richmond Hill. I am running for City Council because our community has not been served.
