I'm Jimmy McMillan, the founder of the Rent Is Too Damn High Movement. Many of you know who I am.

My issue is about rent. My issue is about rent. Can't buy food, breakfast, lunch or dinner because of rent. Can't take a vacation because of rent.

We have a problem that you created by voting for these guys who are rich. How are we going to solve this problem? When you go to the polls, you're going to see the name Jimmy McMillan. Hit it.
