HAC provides training to young adults ages from 16 to 21 to better prepare them to meet the challenges of renting an apartment and maintaining it long term.

4:00 pm to 5:30 pm, except for holidays. Qualified youth in foster care do not need to register to attend.

Get the help you need:

HAC will help with Intake Housing Applications.

A review team of three senior **HAC** staff members will expedite court orders.

The review team will also work with foster care providers to assess housing preparedness and make referrals to **HAC** specialists for one-on-one technical assistance, in the areas of education, employment and mental health.
