

Requesting Child Protective Records

Child protective records are not available pursuant to the Freedom of Information Law. A request for one's own child protective records must be notarized.

Copies of child protective records can be requested by sending a written and notarized request including the full name and date of birth for the record of the person requesting by email to ACSRecordRequests@acs.nyc.gov.
