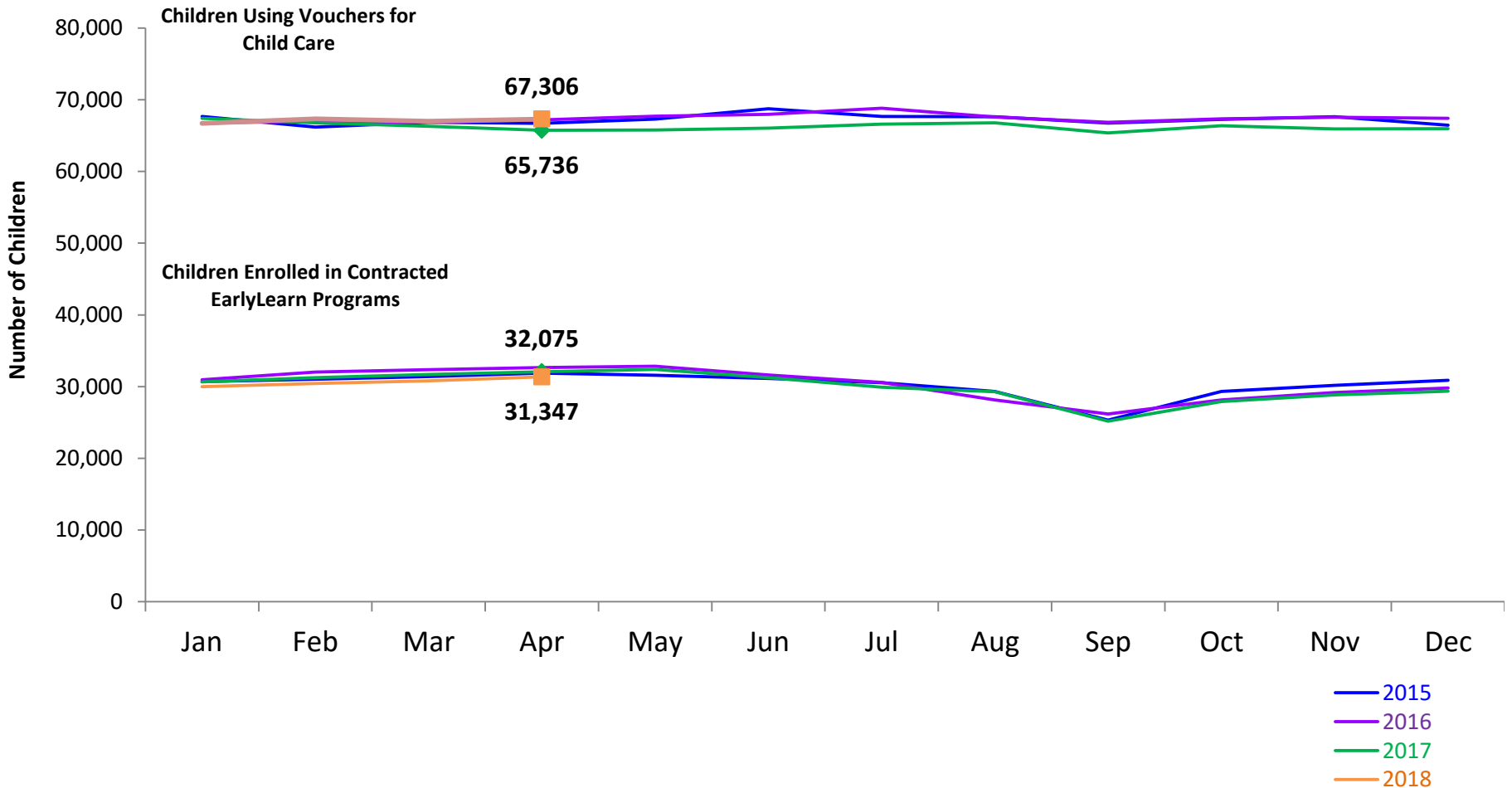

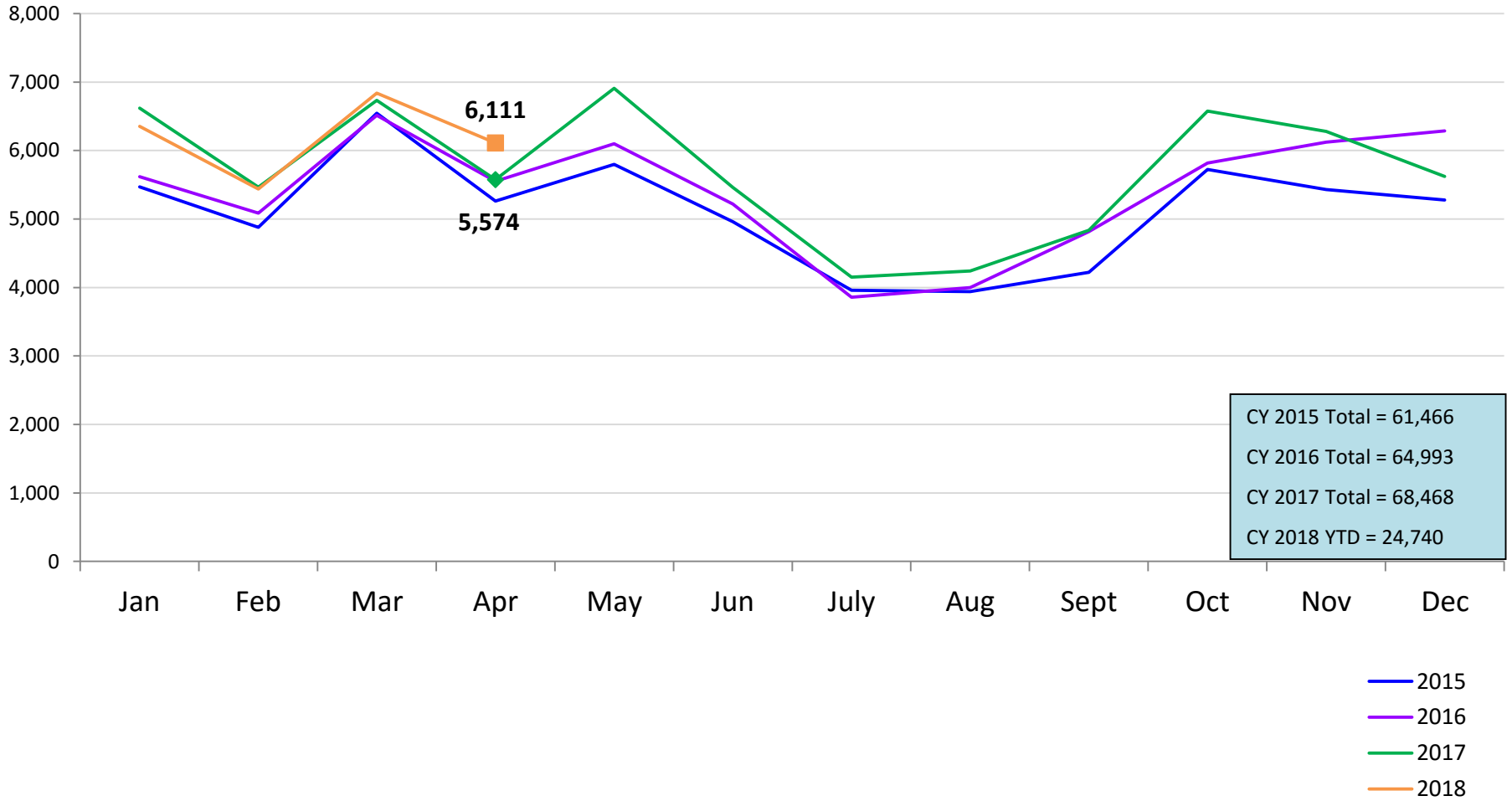
Children Enrolled in Contracted EarlyLearn Programs and Children Using Vouchers for Child Care

January 2015 – April 2018 (End of Month)



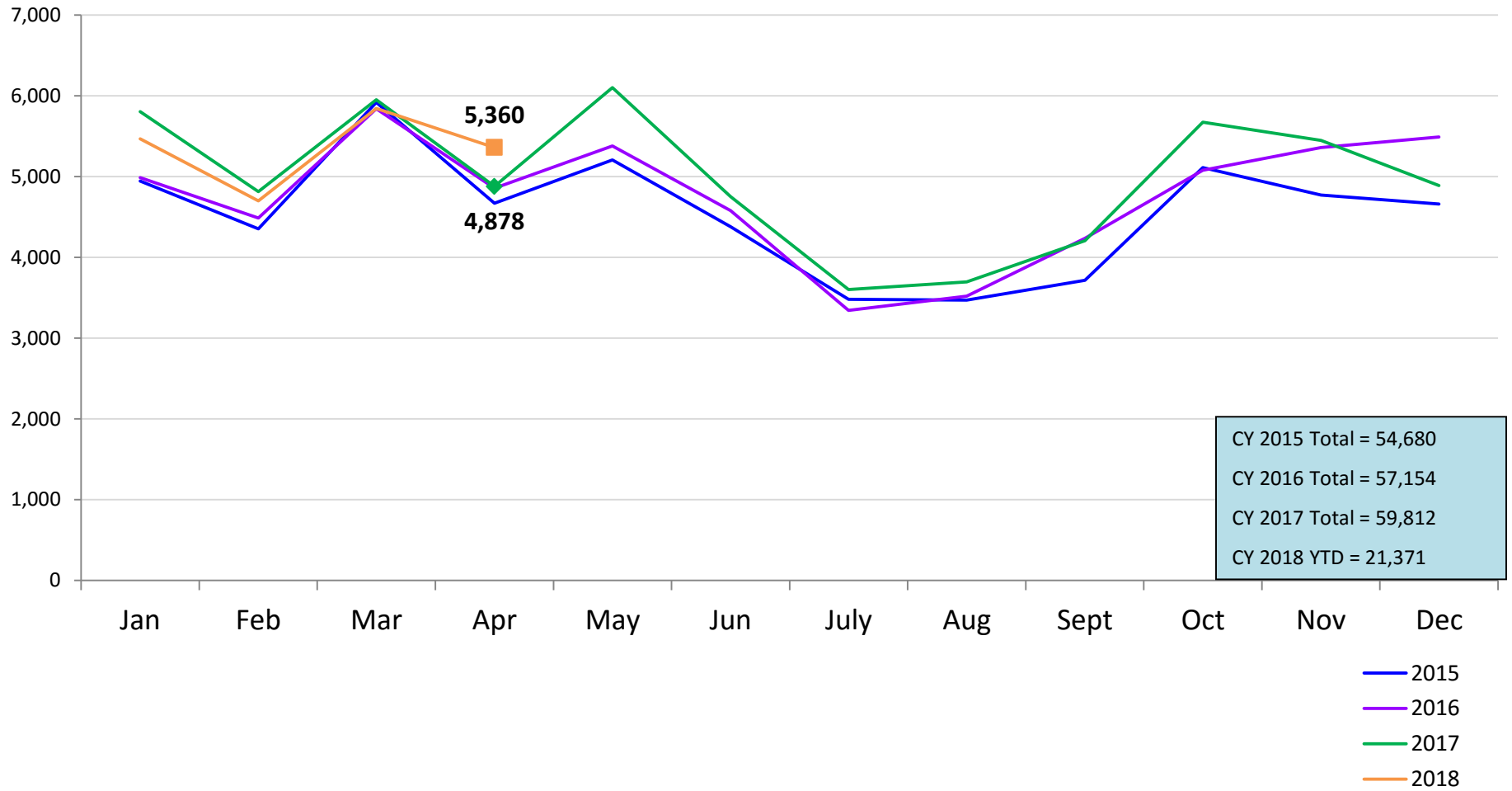
SCR Intakes

January 2015 – April 2018 (Monthly Total)



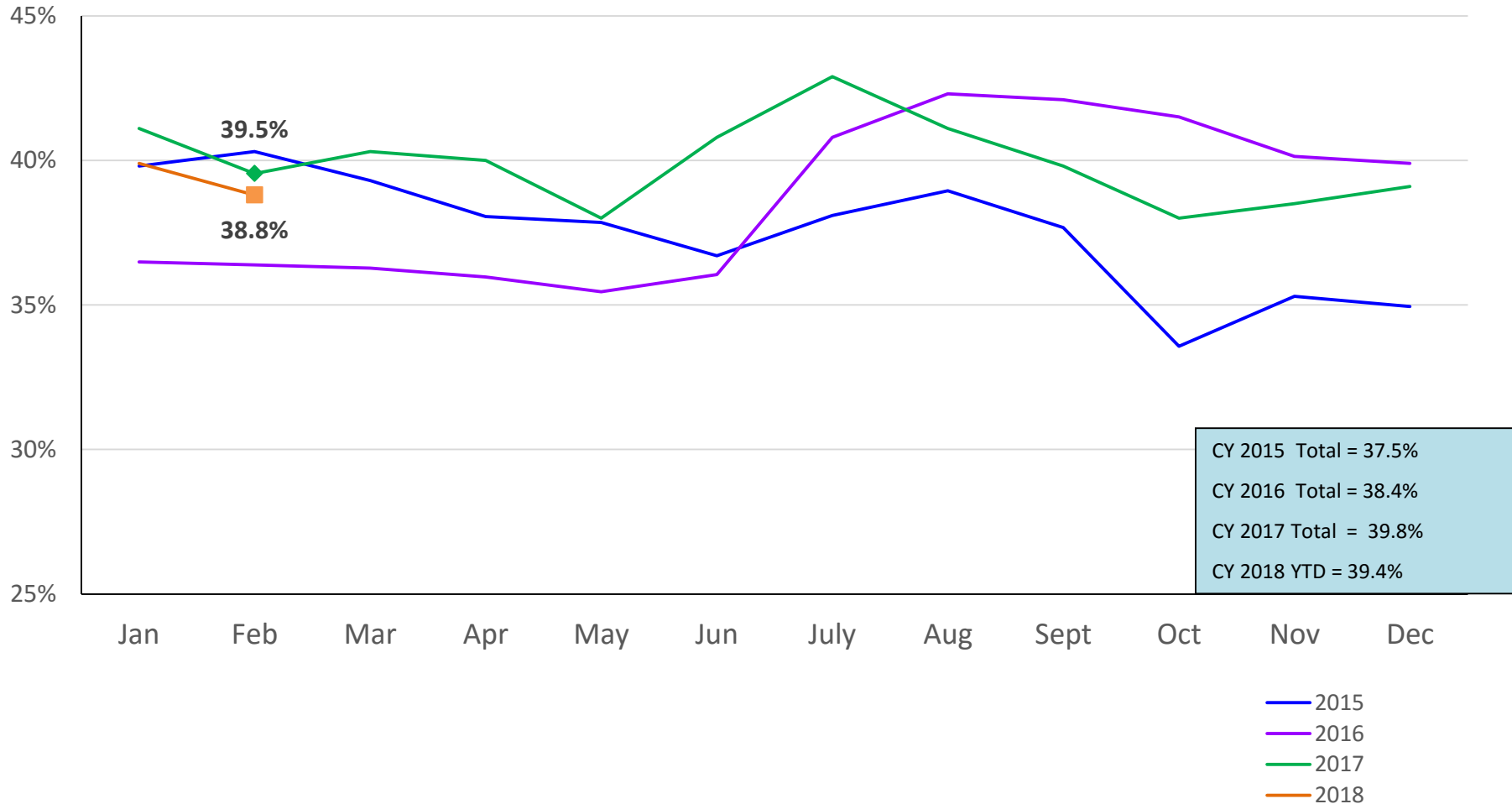

January 2015 – April 2018 (Monthly Total)



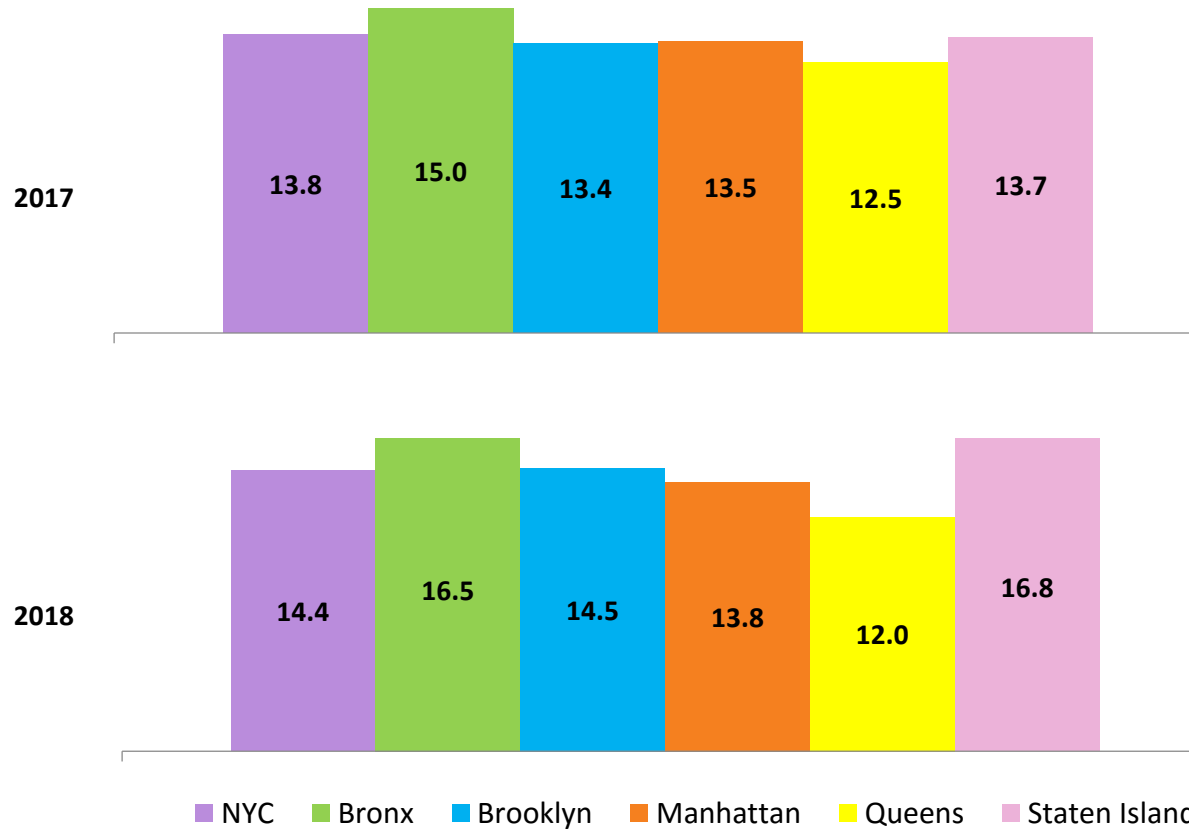
SCR Investigation Indication Rate

Average P/D Combined Caseload*

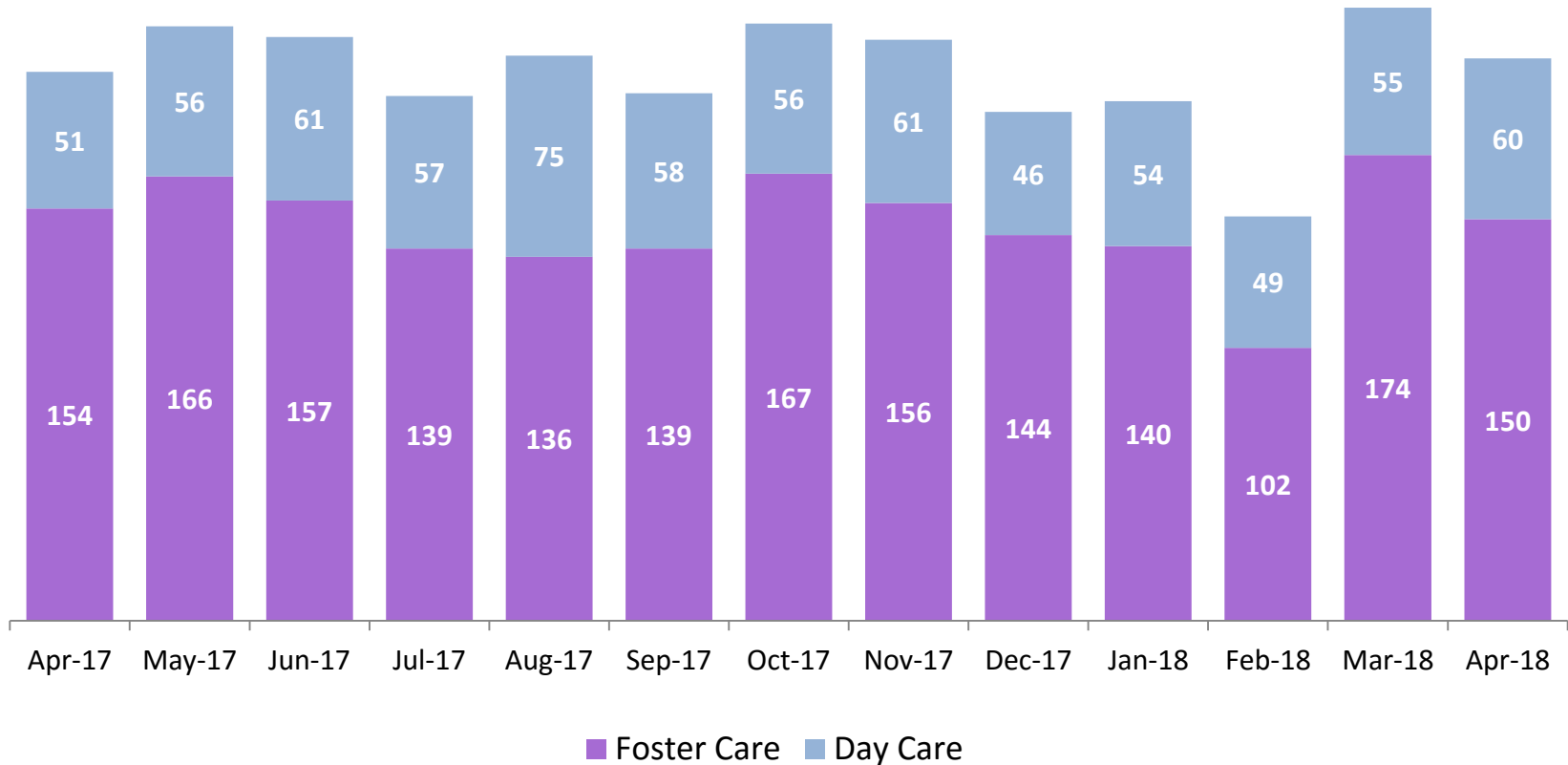

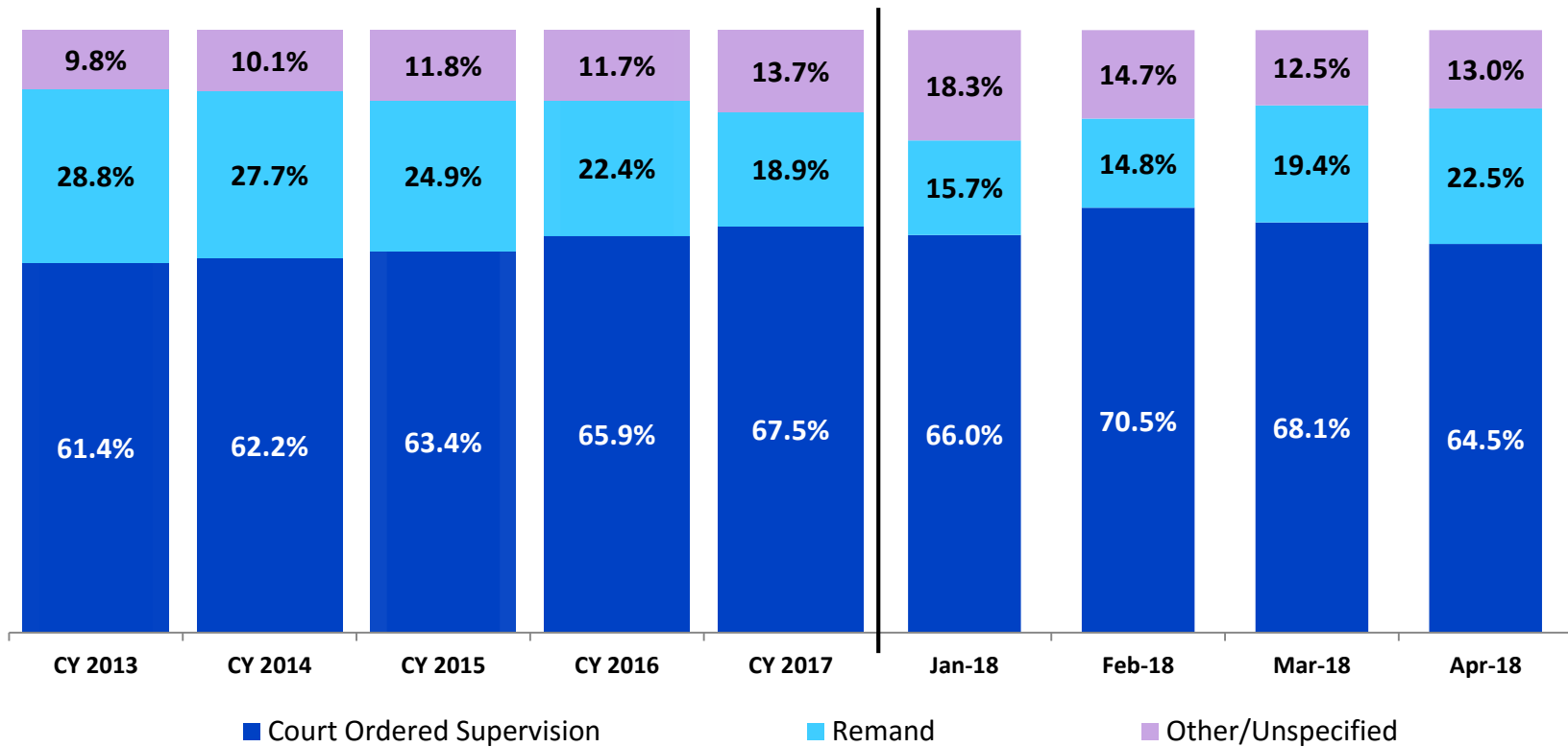

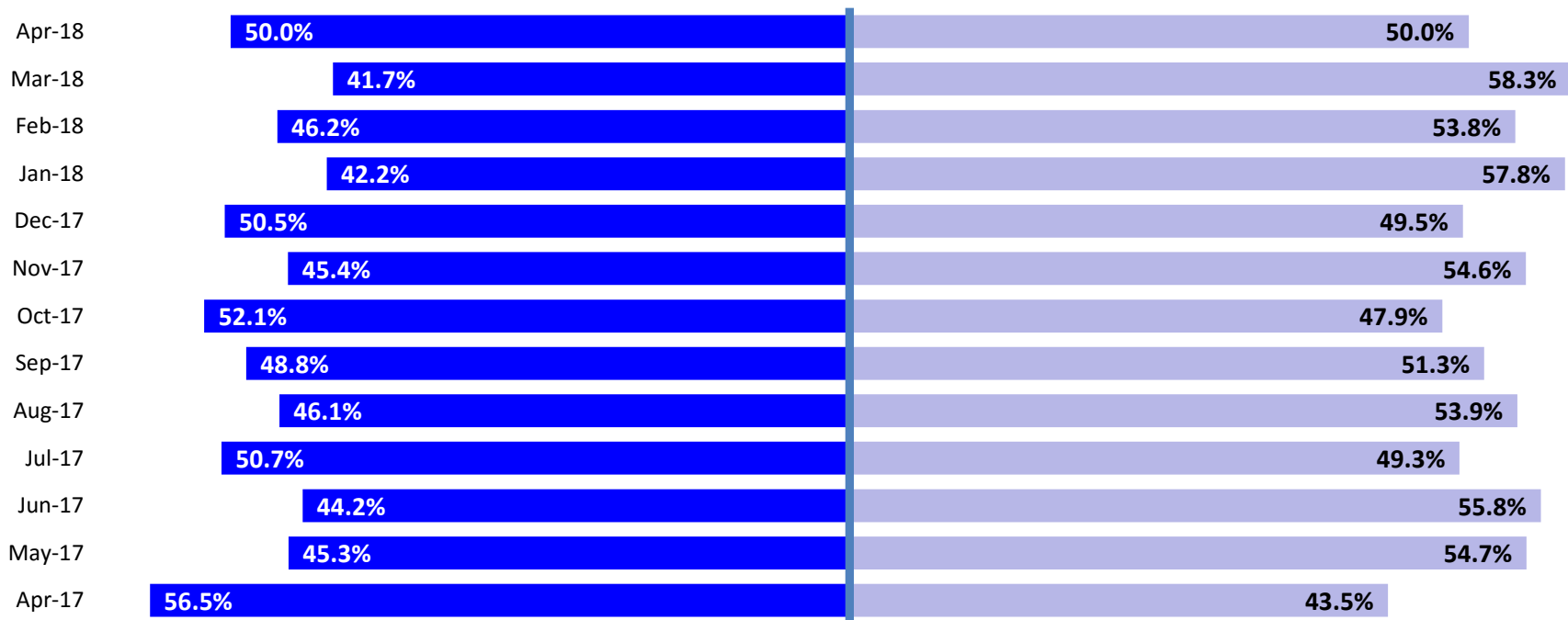

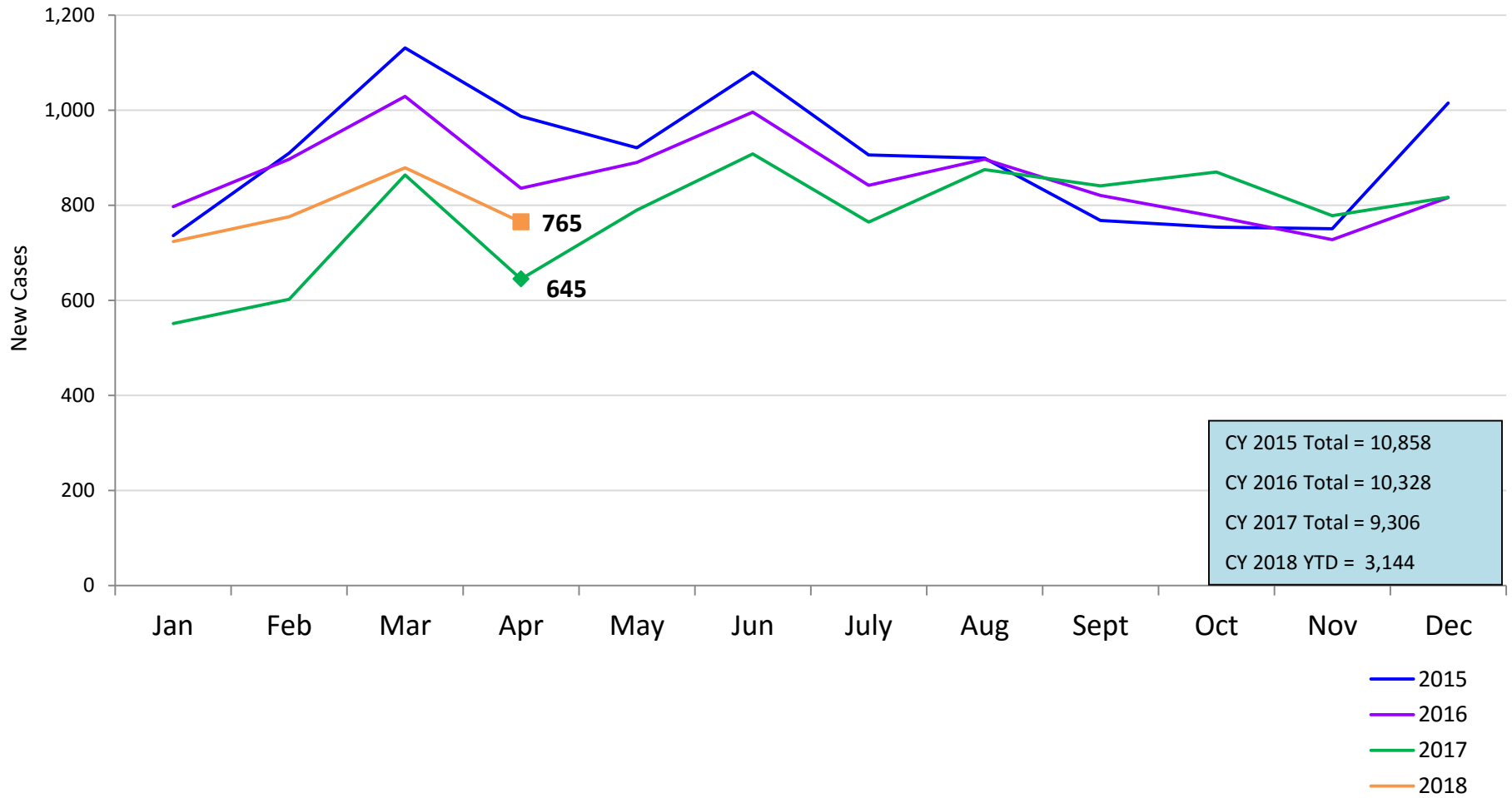

New Child Welfare Preventive Cases*

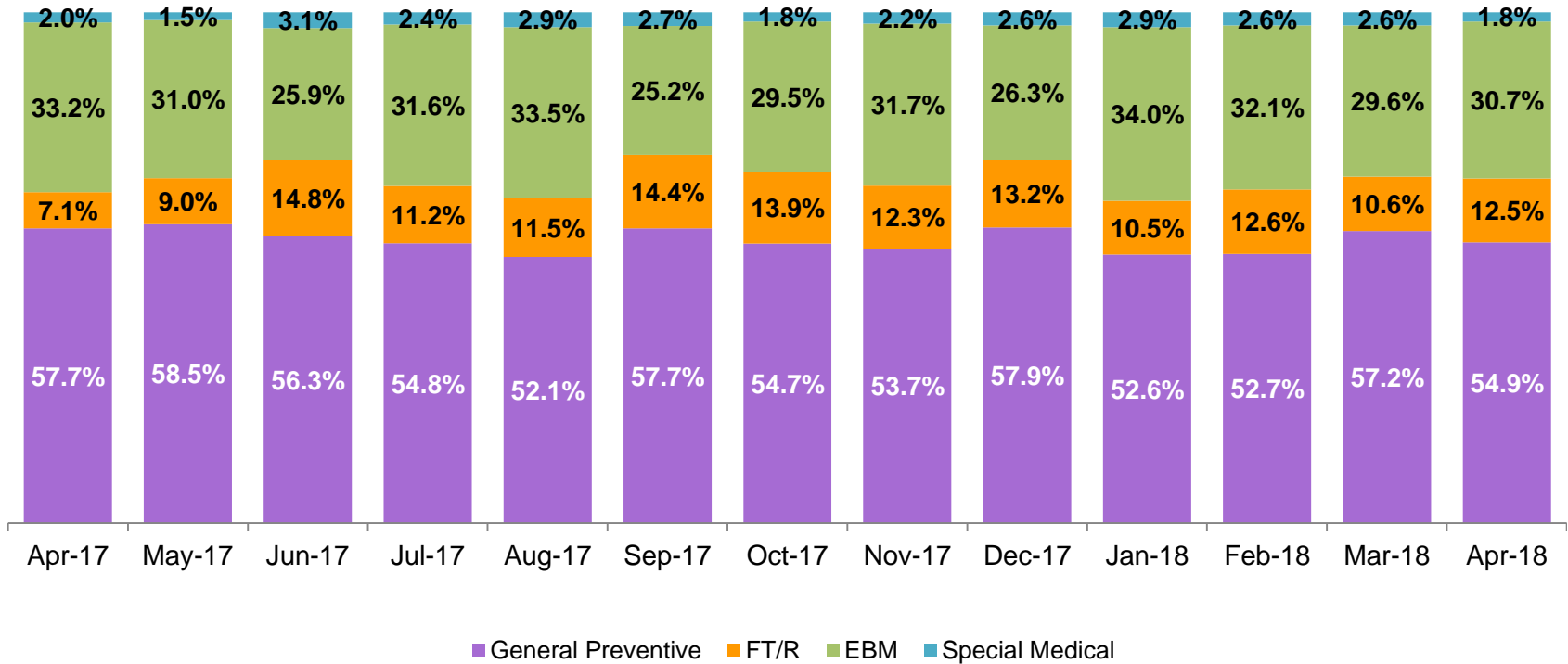

New Child Welfare Preventive Cases by Program Type *

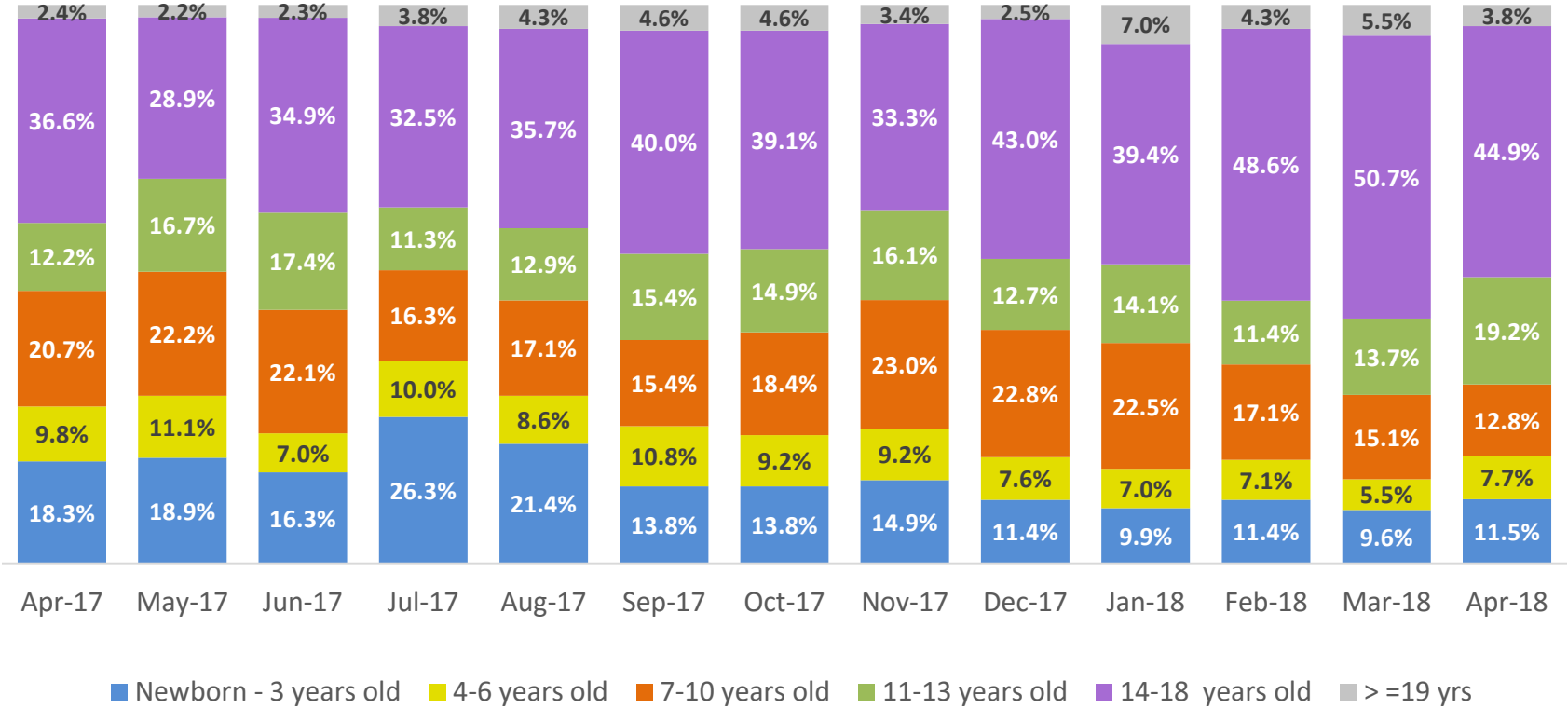

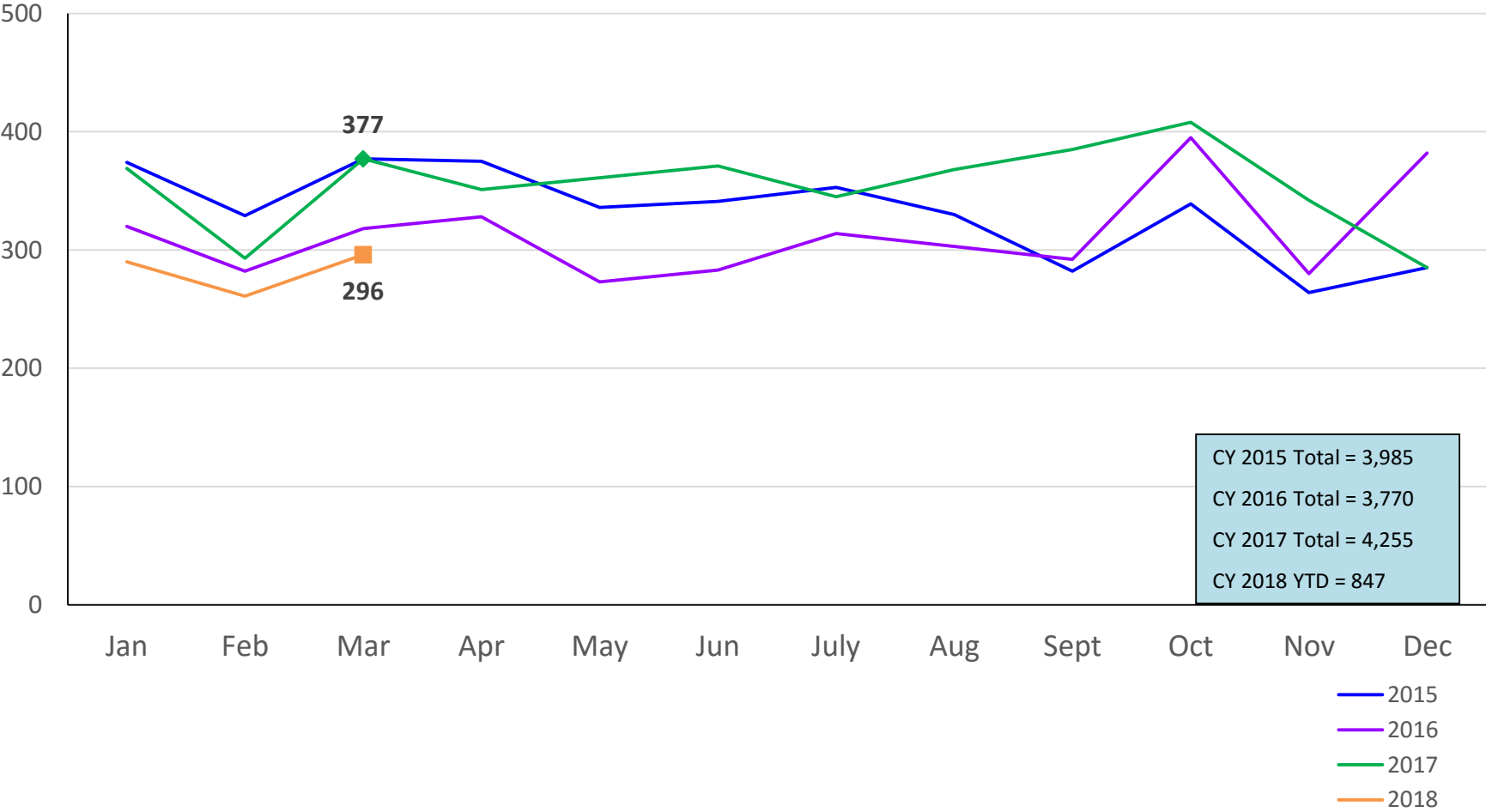
Average Daily Children's Center Population April 2017 – April 2018

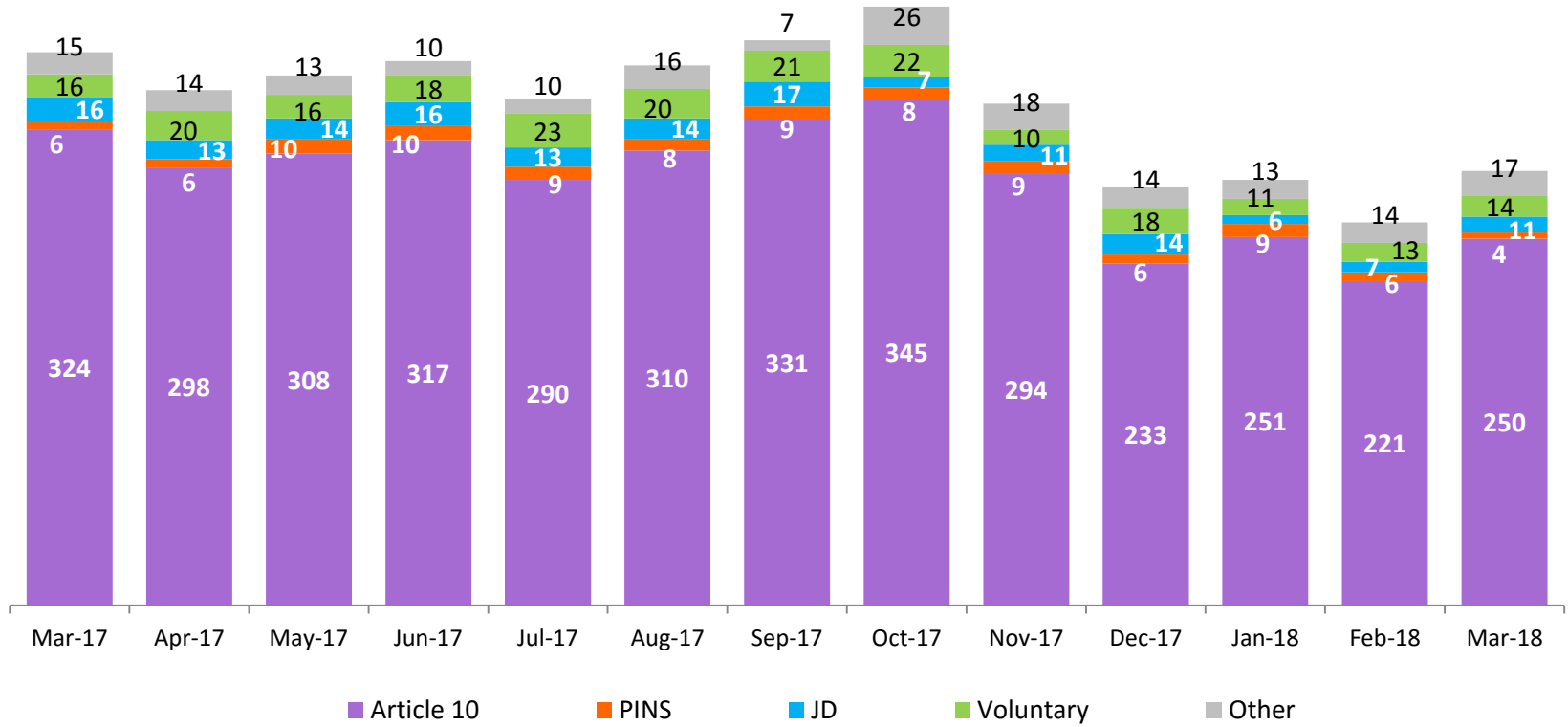
New Monthly Placements of Children into Foster Care

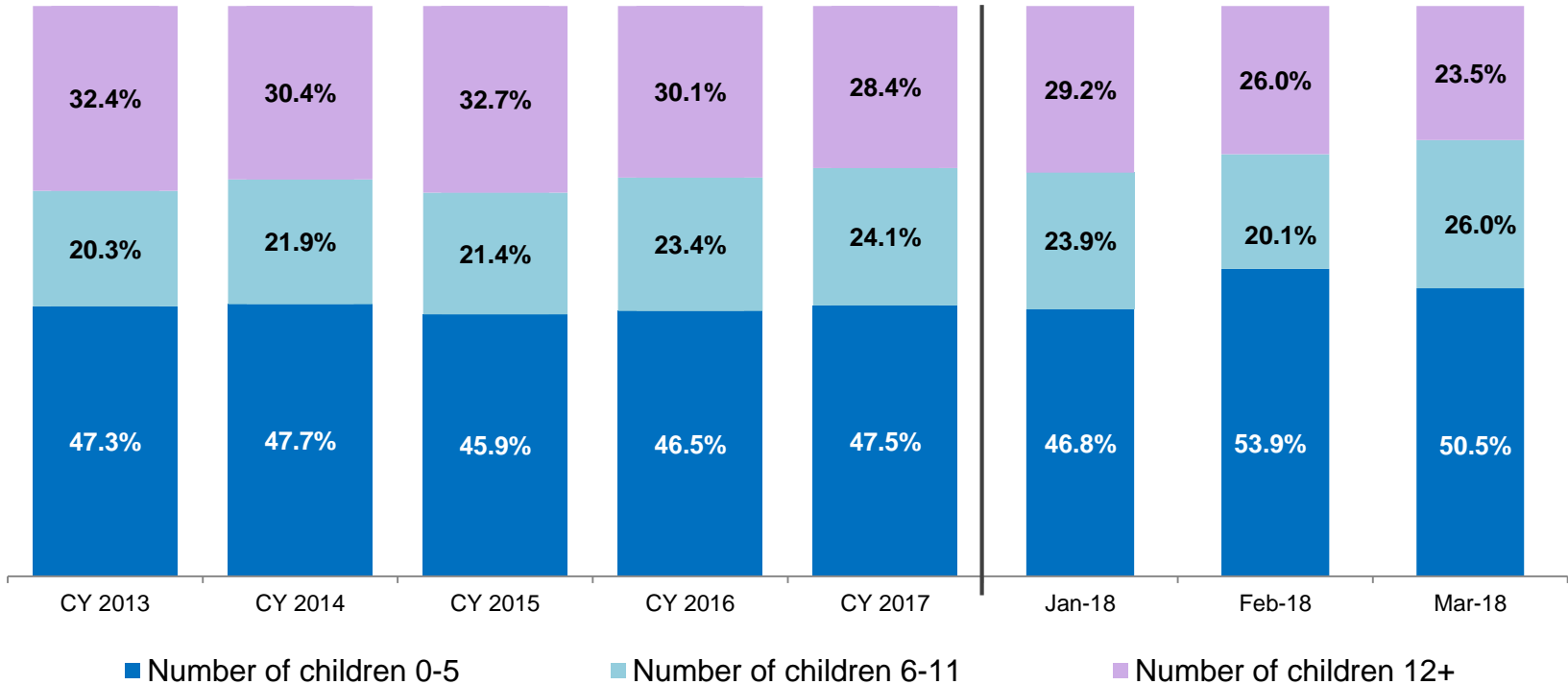

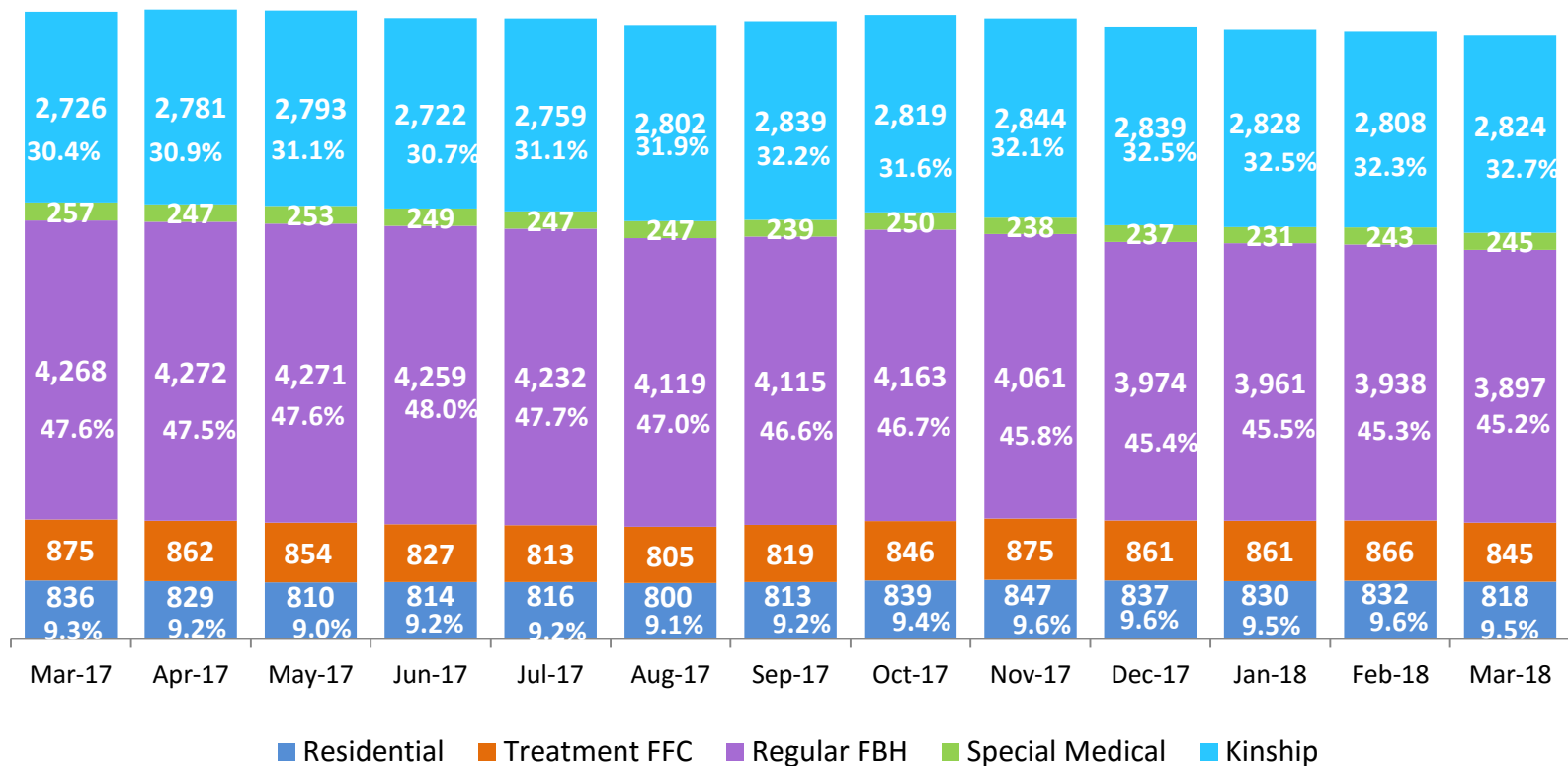

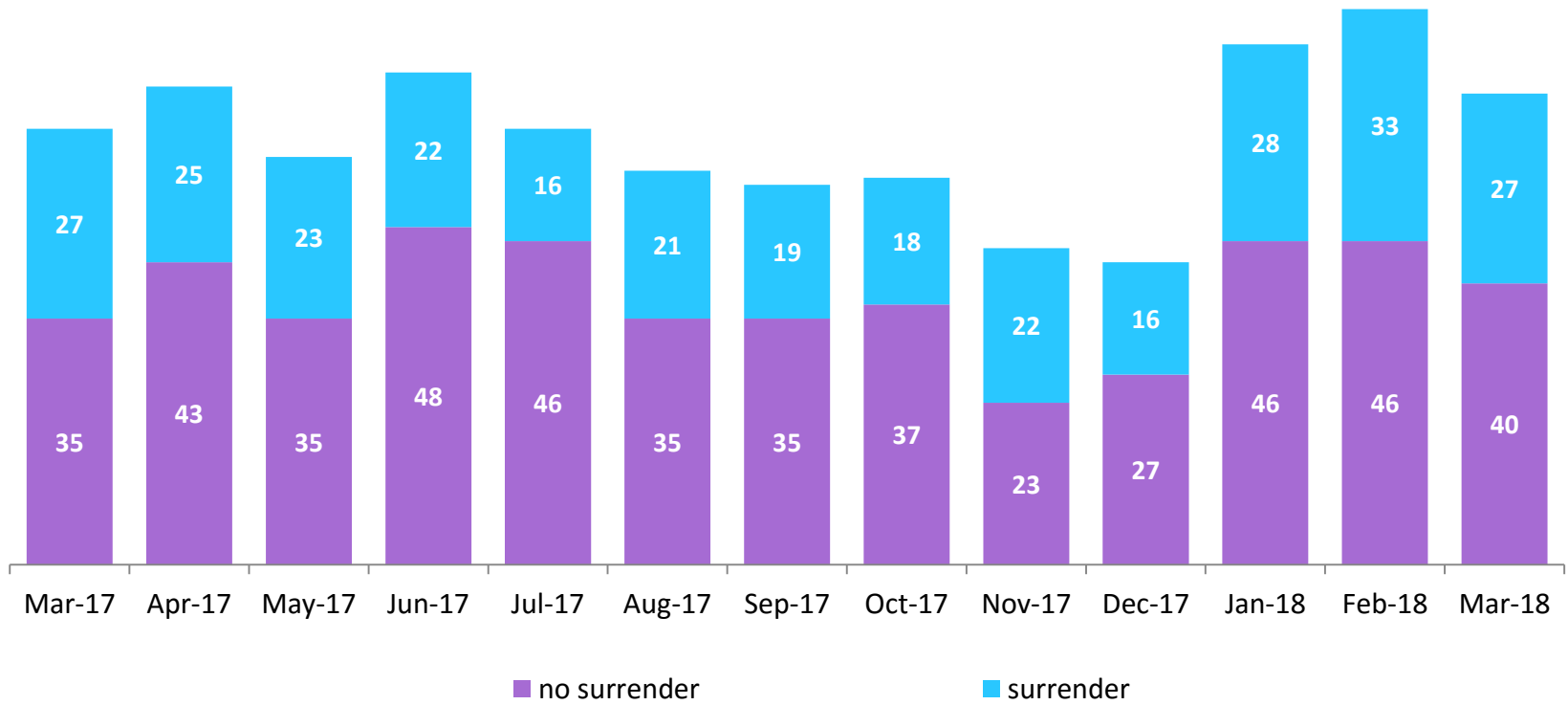

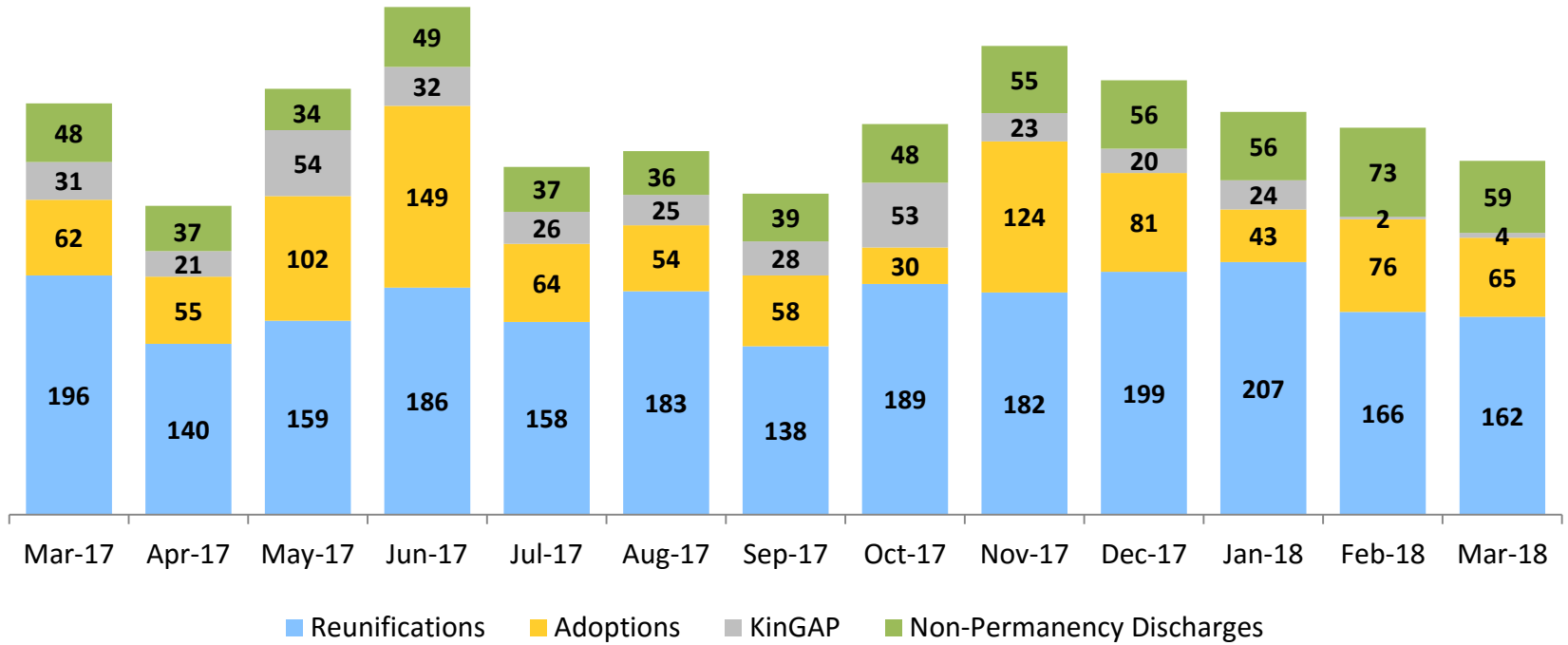

Permanency and Non-Permanency* Discharges from Foster Care** March 2017 – March 2018

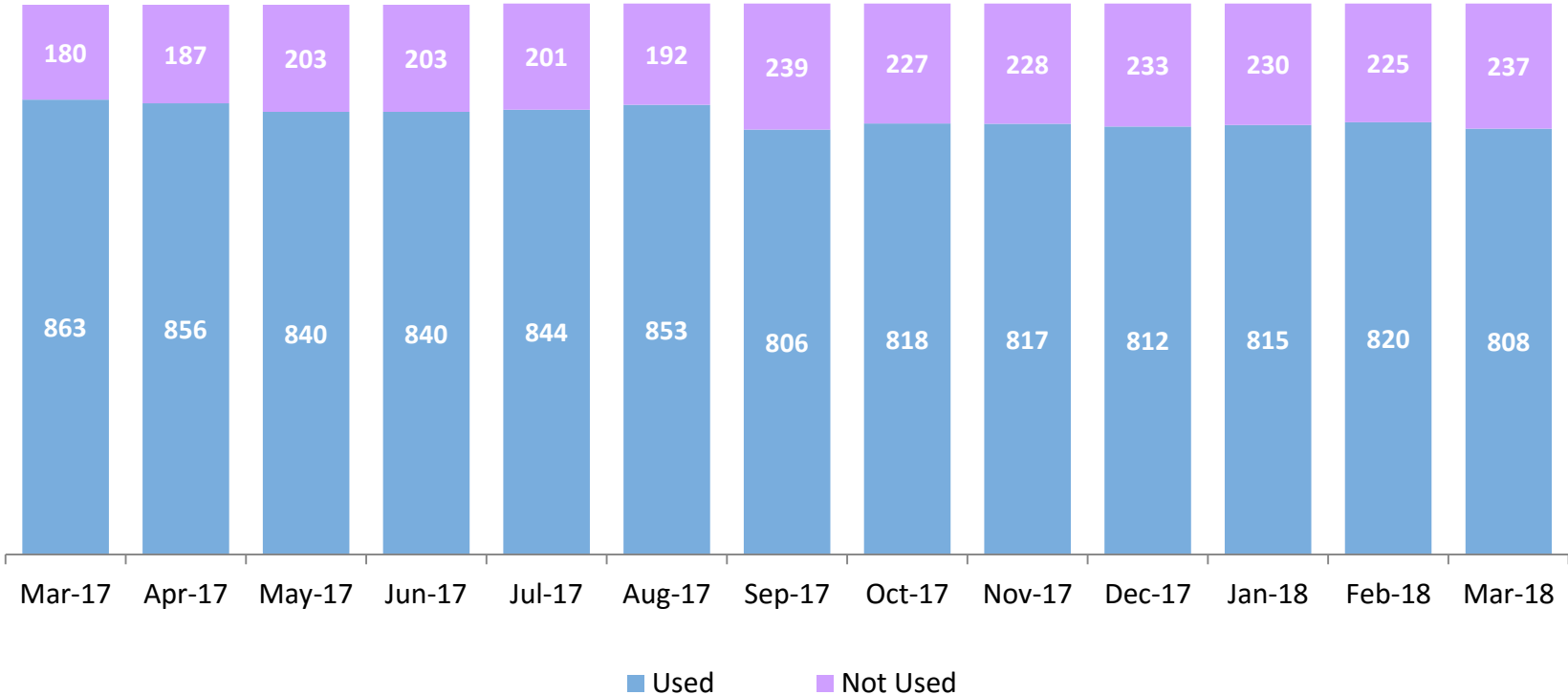

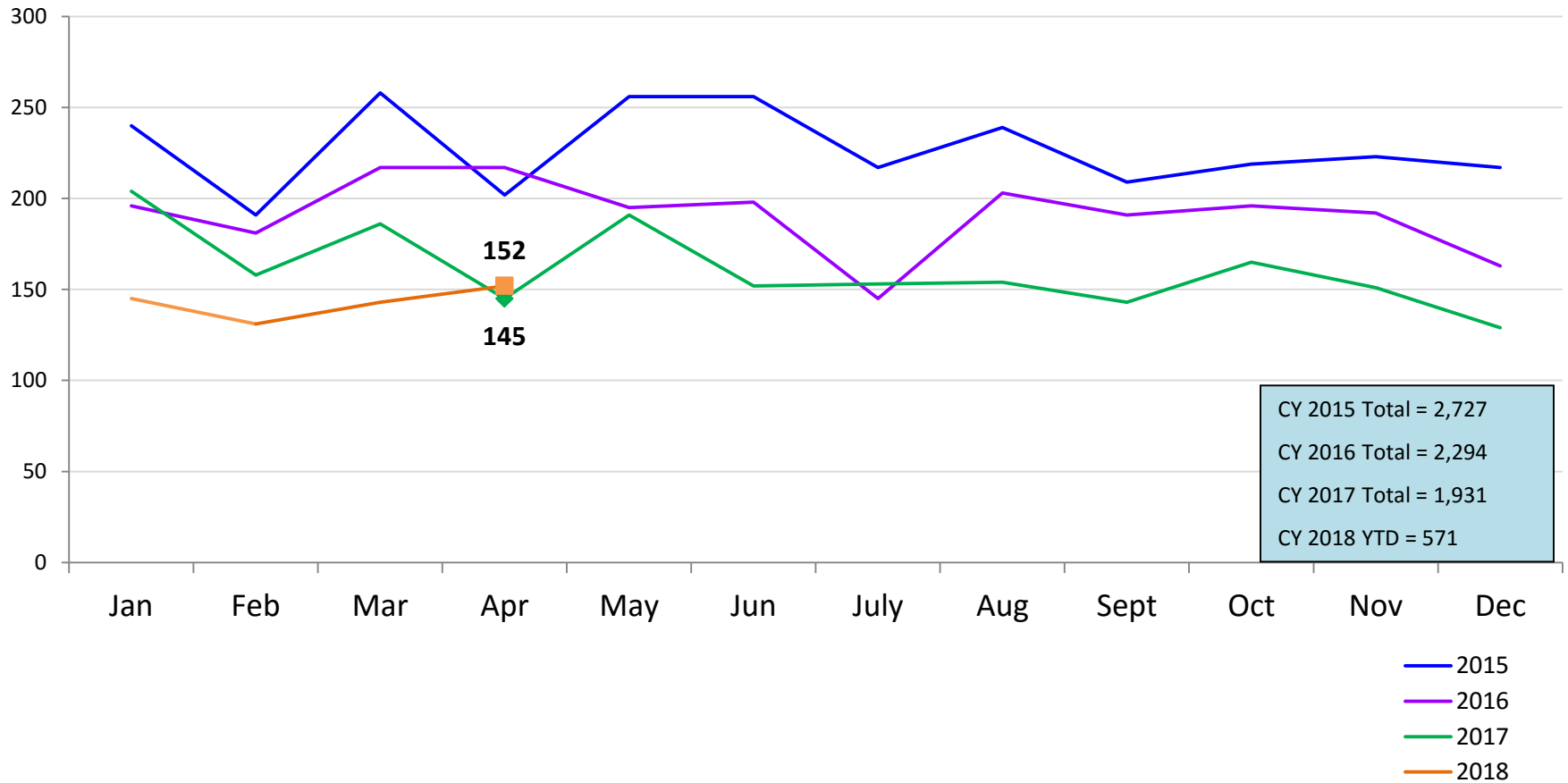

Residential Care Capacity and Utilization March 2017 – March 2018



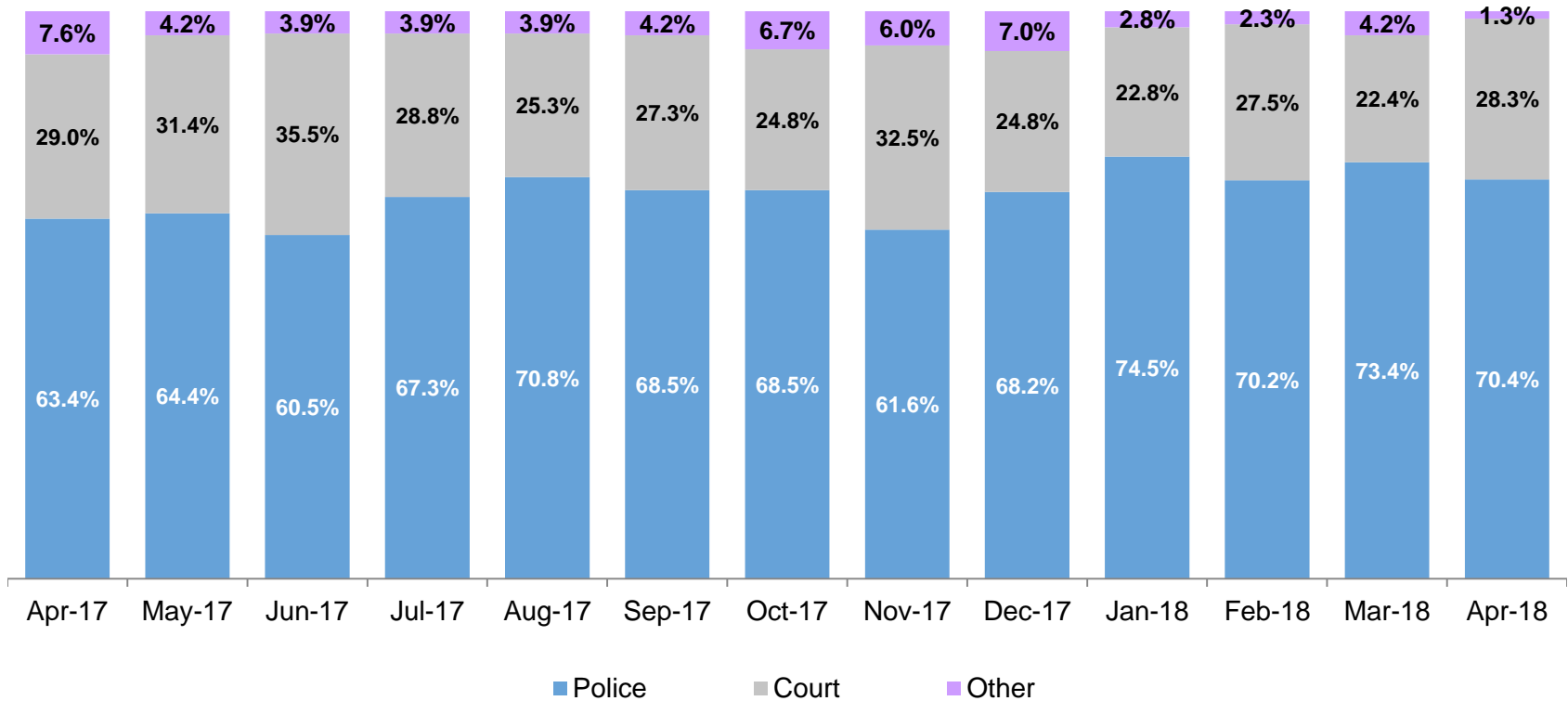

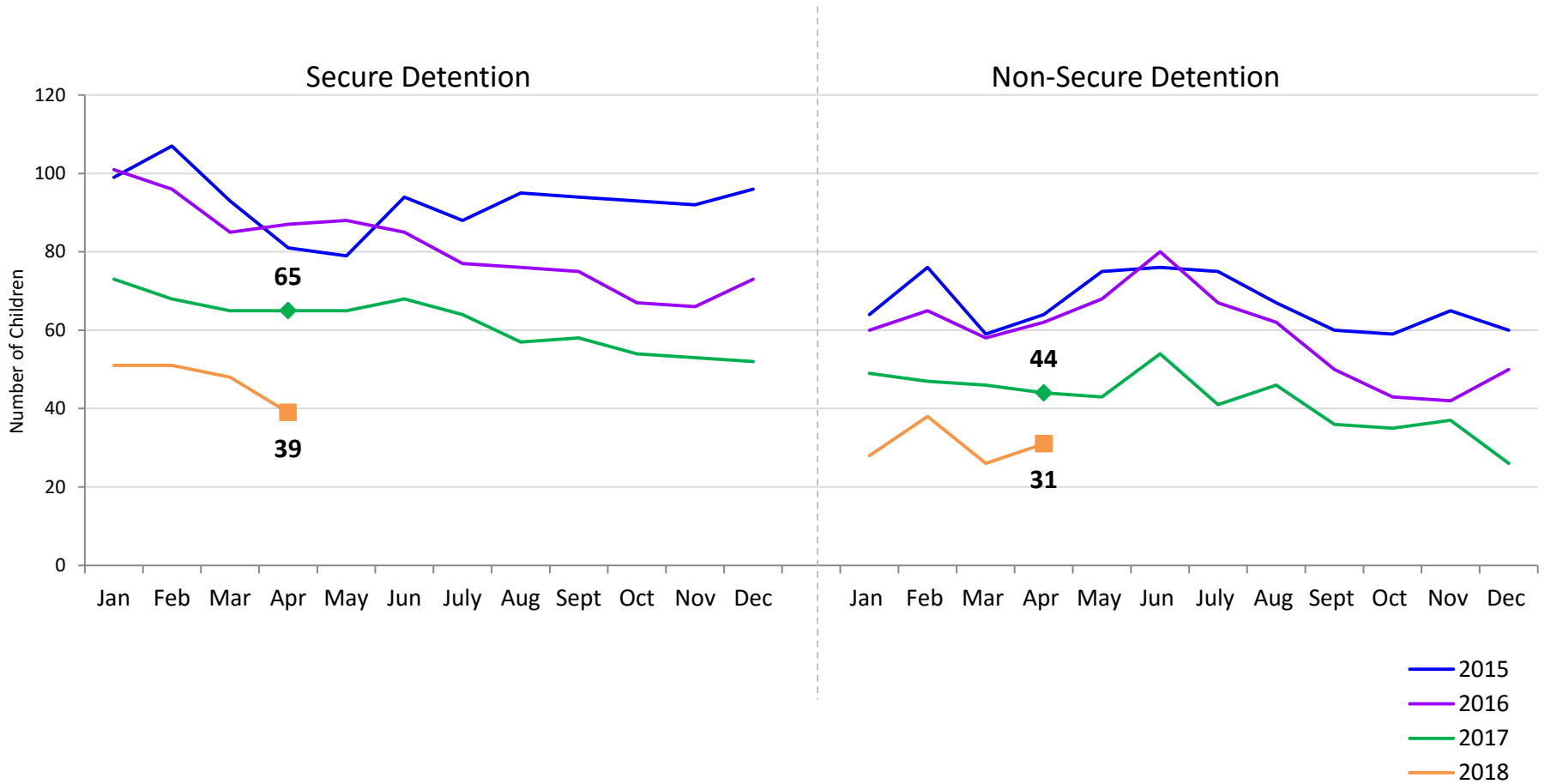

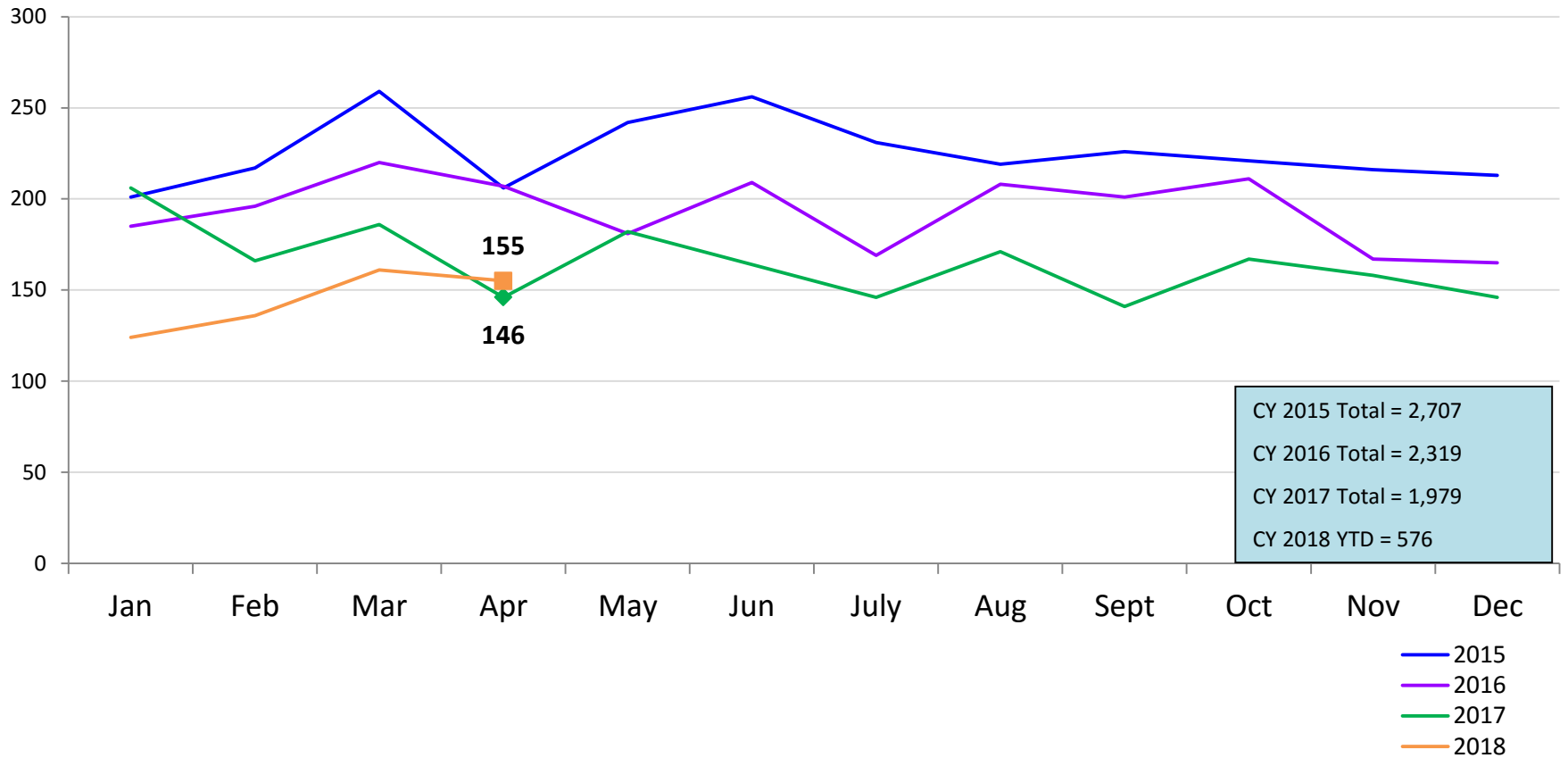

January 2015 – April 2018

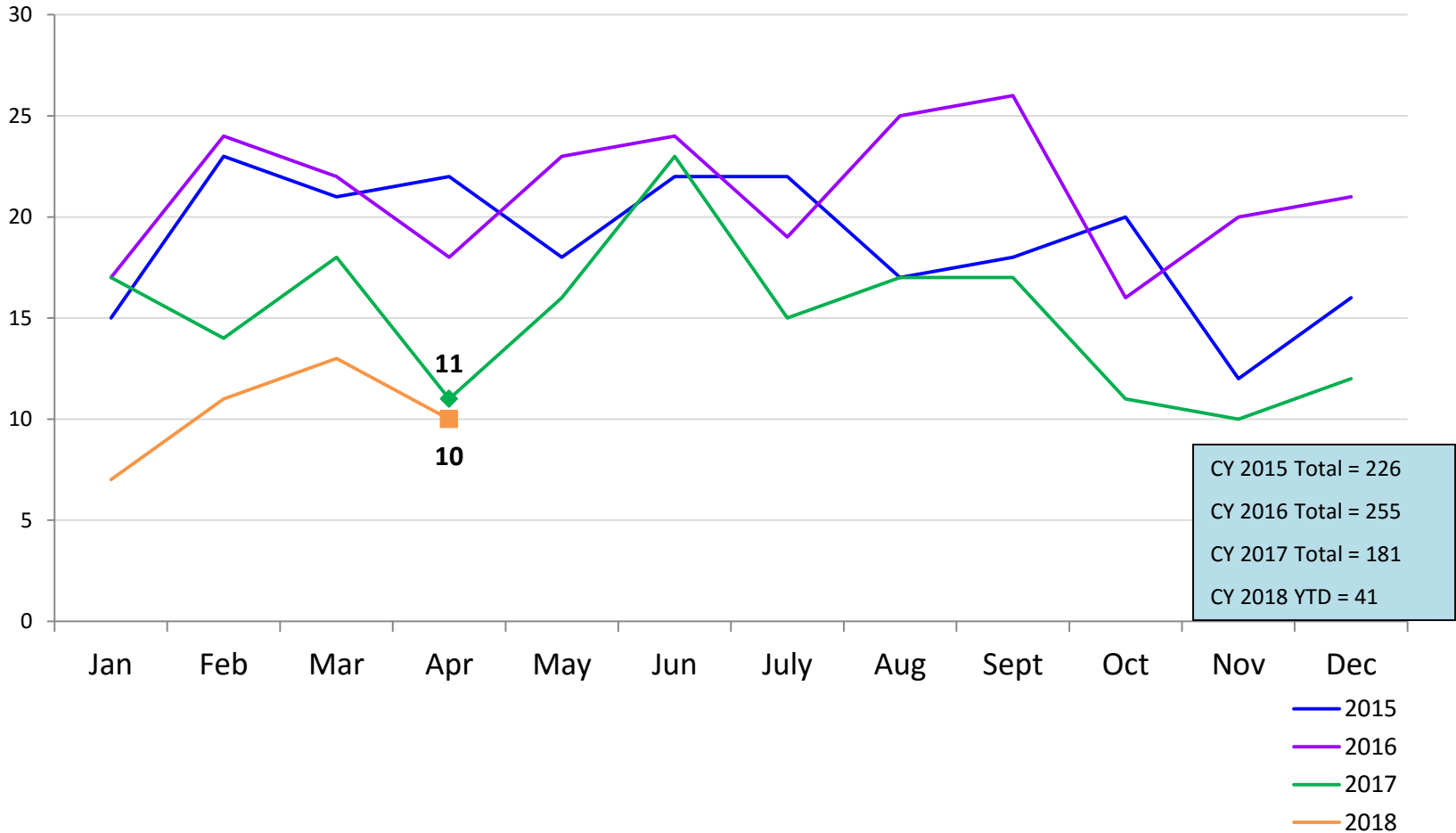


Total Monthly Releases from Detention January 2015 – April 2018 (Monthly Total)

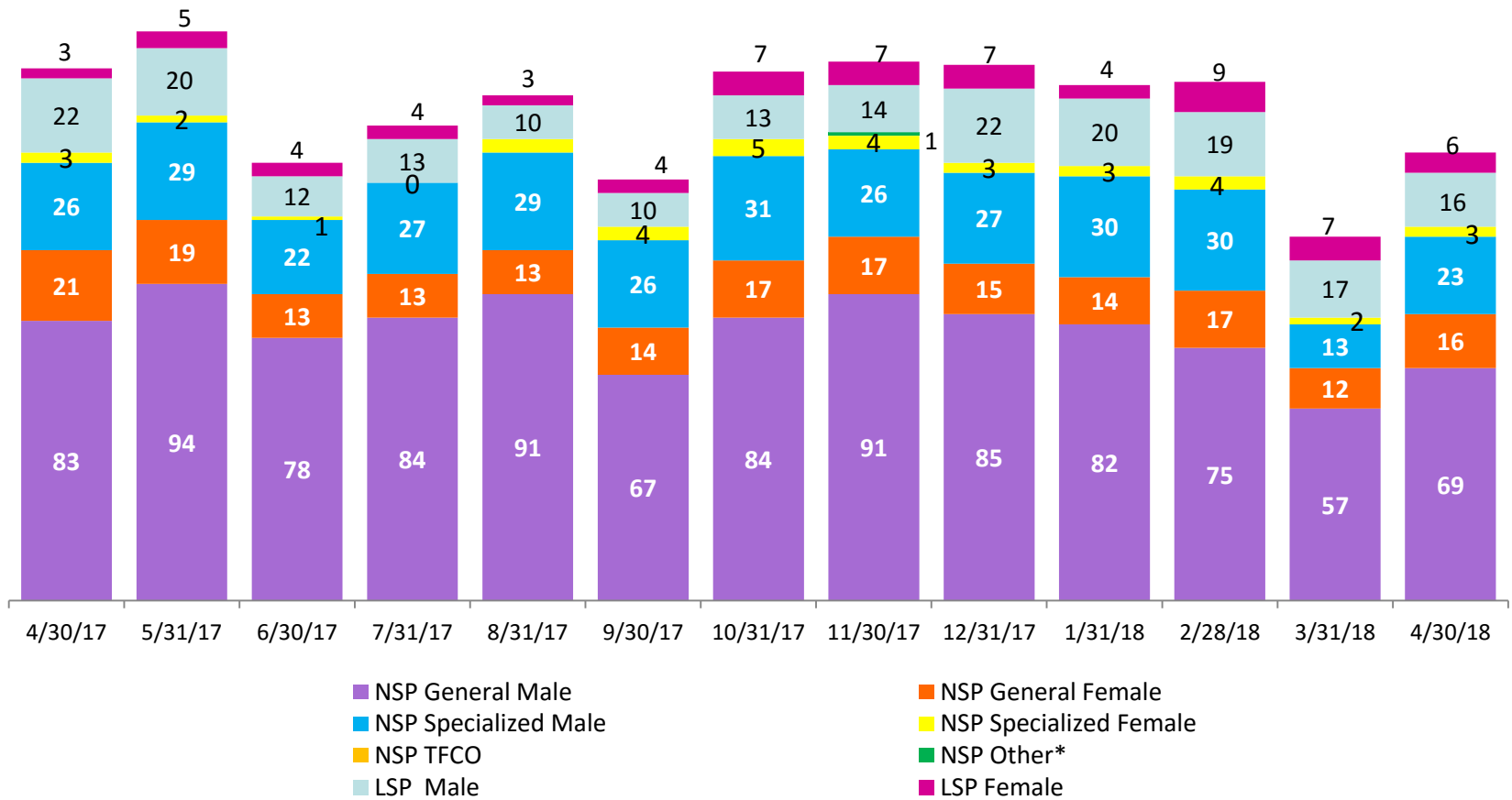

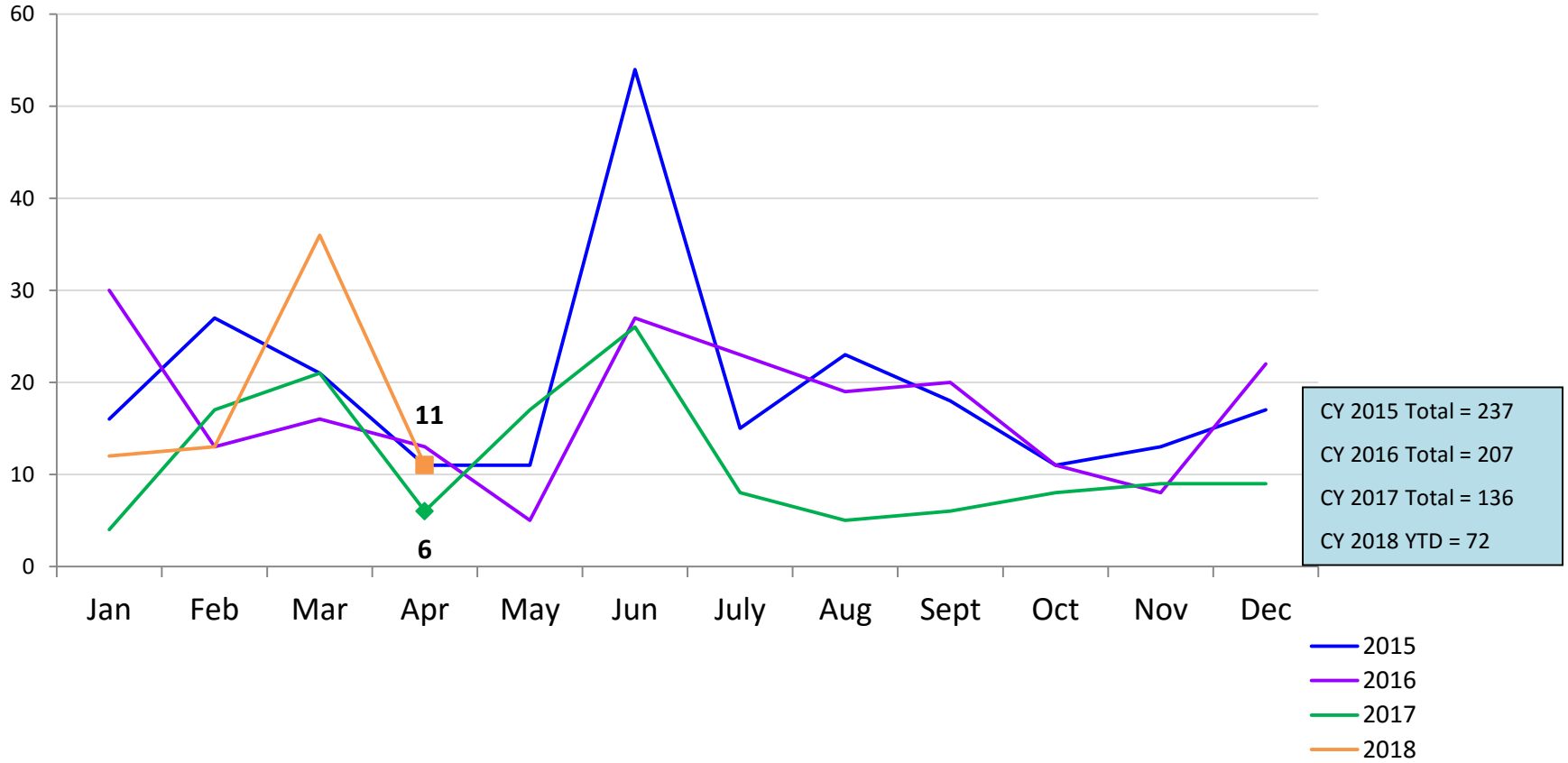

Figure 1: SCR Intakes by Borough, FEB 17 – APR 17 and FEB 18 – APR 18

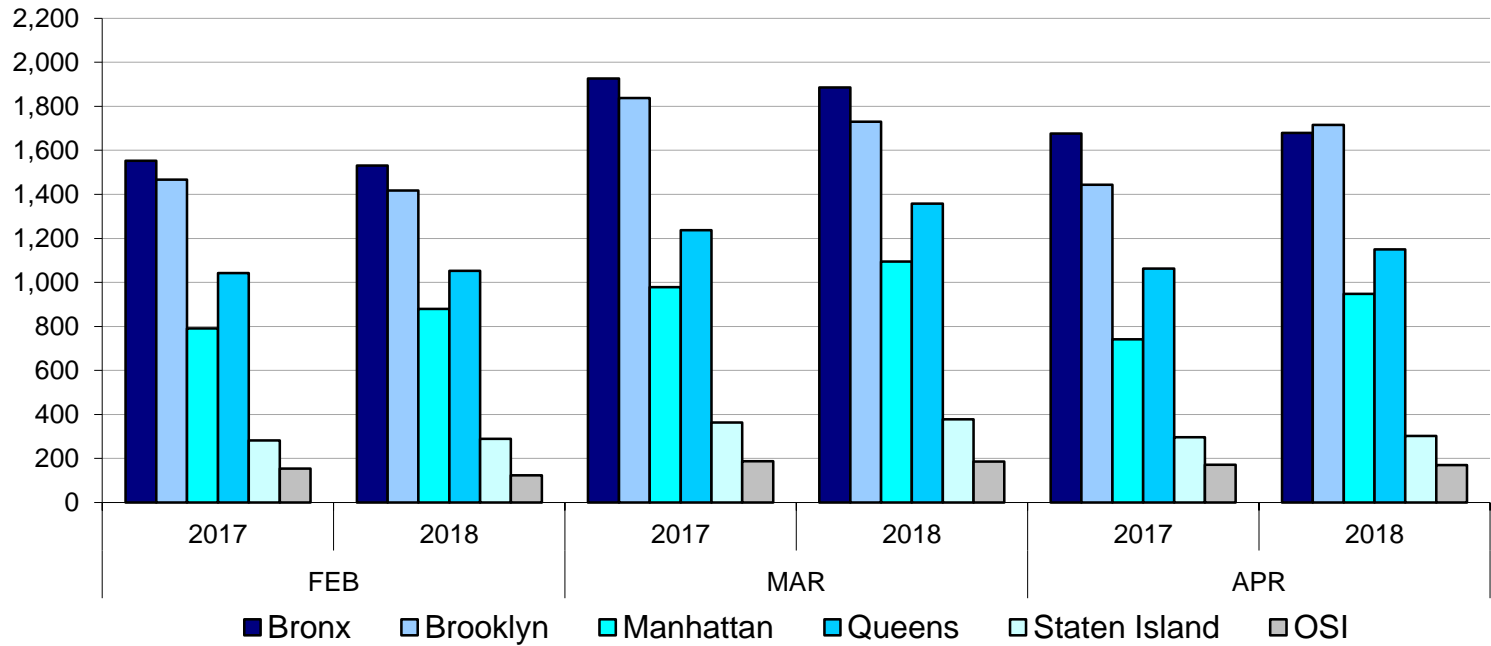

Figure 2: Citywide SCR Intakes by Reporter Group, FEB 17 – APR 17 and FEB 18 – APR 18

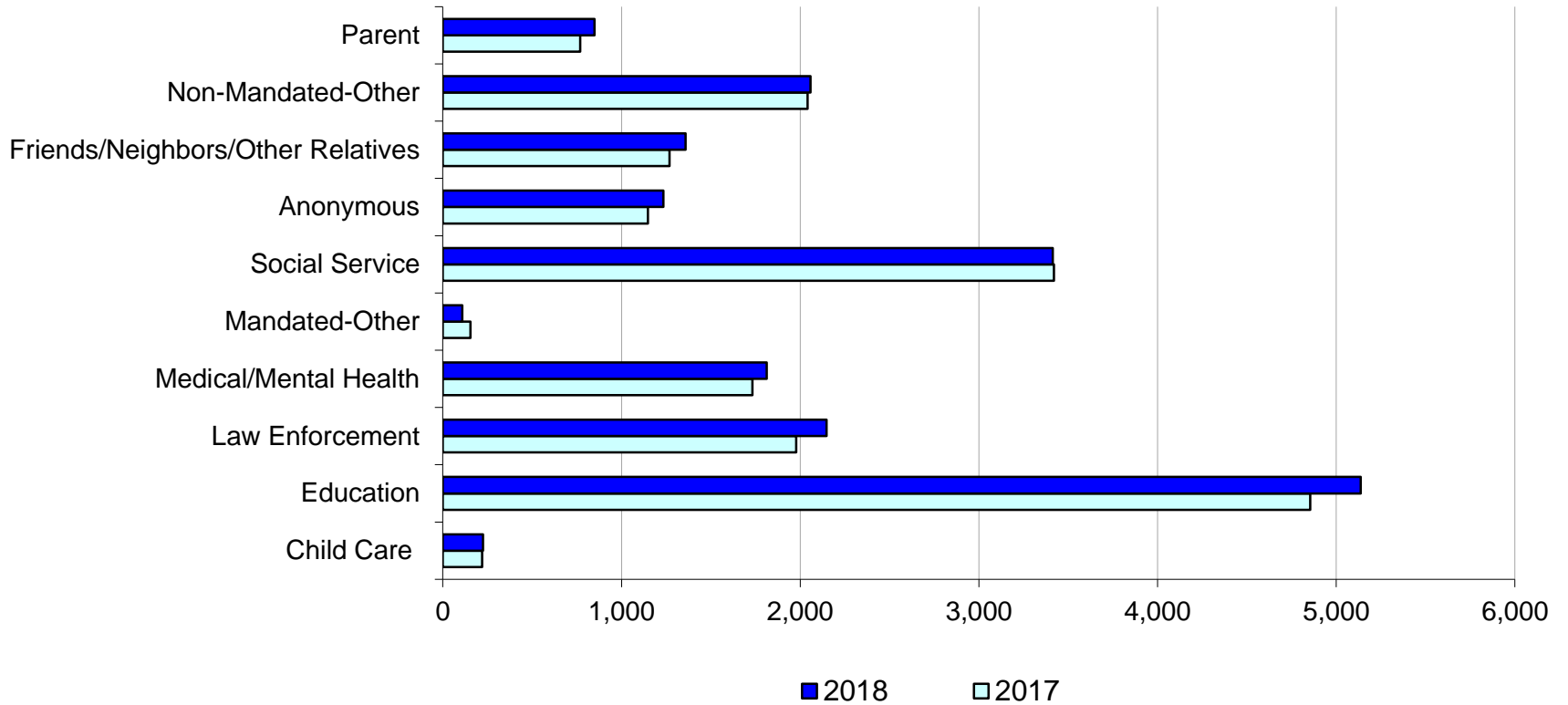
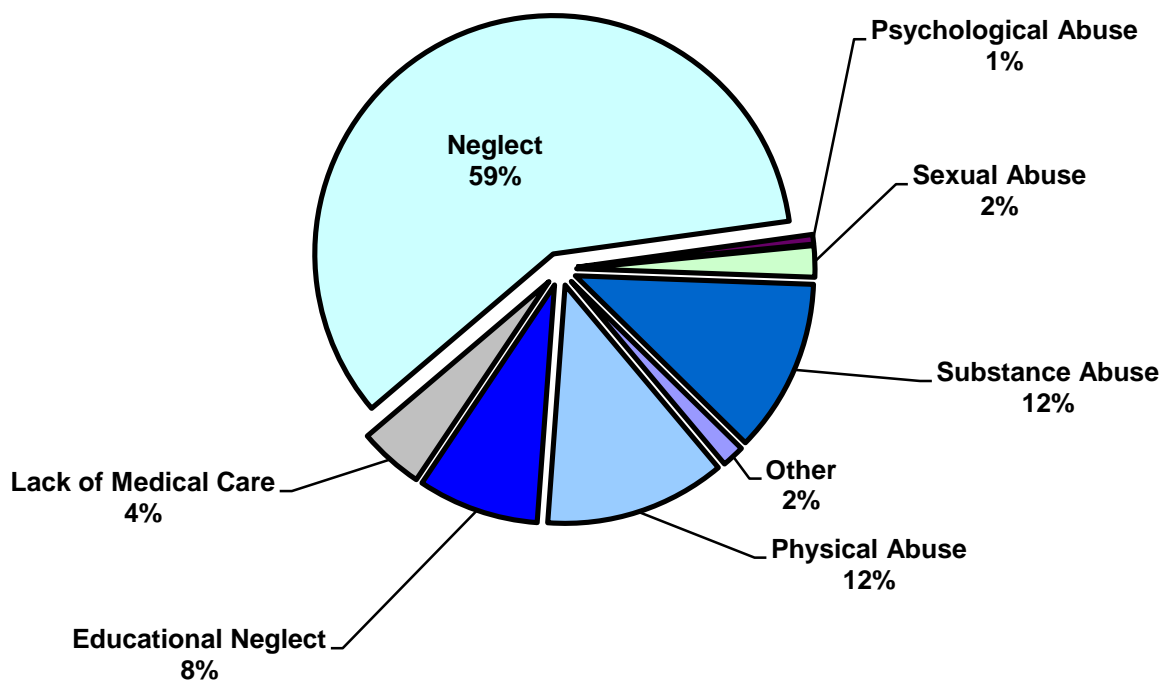

Allegations are grouped as follows: Physical Abuse - burn, fatality, fracture, choking, twisting, shaking, excessive corporal punishment, internal injuries, lacerations, bruises, welts, poisoning, noxious substances; Educational Neglect – educational neglect; Lack of Medical Care – lack of medical care; Neglect - inadequate guardianship, inadequate food, clothing, shelter, lack of supervision, malnutrition, failure to thrive, swelling, dislocations, sprains; Psychological Abuse - isolation, emotional neglect; Sexual Abuse – sexual abuse; Substance Abuse - parental drug use, child drug use; and Other - abandonment, inappropriate custodial conduct.
