Weekly

- Coffee and Art Mothers: a group of mothers who gather for coffee, arts, and peer-to-peer support weekly.
- Social Service Discussions: local providers do presentations about their programs, services, and mission and take questions from residents.
- Toddler Group: a play group for toddlers, whose caregivers also meet at the FEC to provide one another with support.
- Anti-Bullying Committee: a group of concerned residents who meet to identify ways to build relationships with schools to address student bullying.
- Grameen America: a group of local entrepreneurs that meet to provide one another with tips and mentorship around starting their own businesses.
- Zumba: weekly exercise sessions for free!


