

## FREE TATTOO REMOVAL FOR YOUTH

### If you are a youth currently:

- Receiving any type of child welfare services from the NYC Administration for Children's Services (ACS)
- In foster care
- Receiving preventive services
- Receiving juvenile justice services

You may be eligible for **free tattoo removal**.

## Questions to Think About and Where to Get Help

- Has your employer or anyone else ever threatened to harm you, or your family or friends if you did not do what they said to do?
- Have you ever exchanged sex for money or for anything of value (like food, or clothes or a place to stay)?
- Has someone ever taken all or most of the money you earned?
- Have you ever been pressured, tricked, or forced into a job or work, or to do anything else you did not want to do?
- Did anyone ever pressure you to send them an intimate photo or video, or take an intimate picture or video of you without your knowing about it?
- Did you ever want to leave your job, or your relationship partner but were not allowed to?
- Are you allowed to contact family and friends?
- Are you allowed to travel freely?
- Do you have easy access to your identification or travel documents?
- Do you feel like someone is controlling you?
