Child, Discharge Resource and Child, and Approved Non-discharge

The Administration for Children's Services reminds foster care provider agencies of the importance of timely, complete and accurate data entry into our systems of record, which ensures the Administration's knowledge of the status and location of children in foster care as well as allows for appropriate payment for services.

This communication addresses data entry of weekend visits and expands on the language used in the July 26, 2011 memorandum waiving CCRS data entry of brief parent-child overnight visits¹.

Effective immediately, Children's Services is waiving the data entry requirement of movement codes into CCRS when a child leaves his/her placement on Saturday and Sunday visits of up to 48 hours with their birth parents, a discharge resource or an approved non-discharge resource. In such cases, the child is still considered to be in the foster or residential home for purposes of payment, since the child is still technically residing in the foster home and placement has not changed. It is Children's Services' expectation that CNNX progress notes reflect that the child is on a visit, with the start and return date clearly documented. This policy does not apply to interagency visits, which continue to require CCRS data entry. Intra-agency sibling visits still require data entry according to existing policy.

Children's Services reminds all providers of making certain a home is safe prior to giving approval for any visits.
