2 MR. MANDELL: Good morning. Today

4 we're at 100 Church Street in New York
5 City on the 20th floor.

6 This is a public meeting of the
7 Business Integrity Commission. I am
8 David Mandell, Associate Commissioner
9 for Legal Affairs and Acting General
10 Counsel.

11 The purpose of today's meeting of
12 the Business Integrity Commission is to
13 consider proposed rules that will
14 operationalize both Laws 55 and 56 of
15 2019.

16 Pursuant to Local Law 55, the rule
17 amendments will facilitate the
18 registration of labor unions or labor
19 organizations that represent or seek to
20 represent employees directly involved in
21 the collection and removal,
22 transportation with disposal of trade
23 waste, and allow the commission to
24 suspend or disqualify officers of such
25 unions or organizations.

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Specifically, the new amendments provide for applications, requirements, general prohibitions, requirements regarding the disclosure of material changes to the applications and other pertinent information and terms and fees.

Pursuant to Local Law 56, the rule amendment provides for requirements of trade waste licensees and registrants to disseminate workers' rights information to employees who operate vehicles or handle trade waste.


