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Specifically, the new amendments provide for applications, requirements, general prohibitions, requirements regarding the disclosure of material changes to the applications and other pertinent information and terms and fees. Pursuant to Local Law 56, the rule amendment provides for requirements of trade waste licensees and registrants to disseminate workers' rights information to employees who operate vehicles or handle trade waste.
