The applicants were advised that they have 10 business days to submit a sworn written response to the commission. The commission did not receive any responses. On October 27, 2020, we e-mailed to the commission members the recommended denial decisions

There have been no material changes made to the recommended denial decisions since then. The commission will now consider the recommended denials. For each application, the commission members will vote as to whether or not to adopt the staffs' recommendation to deny the application. A vote of yes, is a vote to adopt the staffs' denial recommendation. A vote of no, is a vote not to adopt the recommendation.
