The Commission published the

proposed rules in the City Record on
June 7, 2019. We also disseminated a

managers of all 59 community boards,
several media organizations in the City,
and other interested parties. Lastly,
we posted the proposed rules on both the
Commission's and the New York City
Rules' websites.

As background for this hearing,
Mayor deBlasio signed into law Local Law
55 and 56 of 2019 on March 18, 2019.
The rule amendments that are the subject
of today's hearing are designed to
operationalize Local Law 55 and 56.

As to Local Law 55, the proposed rules would facilitate the registration of labor unions and labor organizations and for suspending or disqualifying officers of such unions or organizations. Specifically, the new amendments provide for application requirements, general prohibitions,

requirements regarding the disclosure of material changes to the application and other pertinent information, and terms and fees.

As to Local Law 56, these rule amendments provide for requirements for trade waste licensees and registrants to disseminate workers' rights information to employees who operate vehicles or handle waste.

That concludes the summary of the proposed rule changes at issue at this hearing. You may present an oral statement for the record or submit written comments concerning the proposed rule changes.

Additionally, the Commission has been accepting written comments on the proposed rule since the publication in the City Record, and will continue to do so through the close of business today.
