1 2 MR. FELDMAN: Good afternoon, we are 3 all on record. Today is April 28, 2021. The time is 2:03 P.M. 4 Welcome to today's meeting of the New 5 York City Business Integrity Commission. 6 7 We are conducting this meeting via telephone conference pursuant to 202.1 8 9 issued by Governor Andrew Cuomo 10 permitting the attendance of public 11 meetings telephonically under Article 7 12 of the Public Officers Law. 13 This is a public meeting which was 14 duly noticed for today's date at 2 P.M., 15 along with the dial-in information for 16 the phone conference. This meeting is 17 being audio recorded and the recording 18 and meeting minutes will be posted on 19 BIC's website in a timely manner following the conclusion of this 20 21 meeting. 2.2 I am David Feldman, Deputy 23 Commission of Legal Affairs and general 24 counsel for the Commission and joined by 25 the following commission members:

Zeus Waste 19 20 Management submitted a renewal 21 application for a license to operate as 2.2 a trade waste business. The applicant 23 was served with a notice of the grounds 24 to recommend the denial of their 25 application. The applicant was advised

1 that they had ten business days to 2 3 submit a sworn written response to the 4 Commission. The Commission did not 5 receive a response from the applicant. On April 26, 2021, we e-mailed the 6 7 Commission members the recommended denial decision regarding the 8 9 application at issue. There have been 10 no material changes made to the recommended denial decision since then. 11 12 The Commission will now consider the 13 recommended denial. The Commission 14 members will vote as to whether or not 15 to adopt the staff's recommendation to 16 deny the application. A vote of yes is 17 a vote to accept the staff's denial of recommendation. A vote of no is a vote 18 19 not to adopt the recommendations. 20 The staff attorney in charge of the 21 denial recommendation of Zeus Waste 2.2 Management Inc. is associate 23 commissioner of legal affairs David 24 Mandell. The Commission staff have 25 recommended denial of this application


