Department of Sanitation Commissioner, Edward Grayson, Department of Investigation Commissioner, Margaret Garnett, Department of Consumer and Worker Protection Commissioner, Lorelei Salas, Deputy Commissioner for Legal and Regulatory Affairs, Andrew Schwartz of the Department of Small Business Services representing SBS Commissioner Jonnel Doris, and Captain John Dusanenko of the New York City Police Department representing Police Commissioner Dermot Thank you all for being here Shea. today.

Today, the Commission will consider two applications, which the Commission's staff have recommended be denied. One, Abarrotes and Mexican Flavors Corp., and two, Emerald Carting Services Corp.

Abarrotes and Mexican Flavors Corp. submitted an application for a

registration to operate as a wholesale food business in a public wholesale market, and Emerald Carting Services

Corp. submitted a renewal application for an exemption from the licensing requirements to operate as a trade waste business.

The applicants were each served with a notice of the grounds to recommend the denial of their applications. The applicants were advised that they had 10 business days to submit a sworn written response to the Commission.

The Commission did not receive a response from Abarrotes and Mexican Flavors Corp. and received a response from Emerald Carting Services Corp. on December 14, 2020.

The Commission carefully considered the applicant's response.

On January 14, 2021 we emailed the Commission members the recommended denial decisions regarding the applications at issue. There have been no material changes made to the

recommended denial decisions since then. 1 The Commission will now consider the 2. 3 recommended denials. For each application, the Commission 4 5 members will vote as to whether or not to 6 adopt the staff's recommendation to deny 7 the application. A vote of "yes" is a vote to adopt the staff's denial 8 recommendation. A vote of "no" is a 9 10 vote not to adopt the recommendation. 11 The first recommendation is for 12 Abarrotes and Mexican Flavors Corp. The 13 staff attorney in charge of this matter 14 is Executive Agency Counsel Kieran 15 Linehan. 16 The Commission's staff has 17 recommended denial of this application 18 based on the follow three grounds as fully set forth in the staff's 19 2.0 recommendation: 21 One, the applicant failed to provide truthful information in connection with 2.2 23 the instant application. 2.4 Two, the applicant and the 25 applicant's predecessor company have

1 repeatedly engaged in unregistered 2. activity. 3 And, three, the applicant and the 4 applicant's predecessor company have 5 failed to pay fines directly related to the applicant's business for which 6 7 judgment has been entered.
