COMMISSION DIRECTIVE

Dear Licensees and Registrants:

On July 16, 2019, a new law went into effect that requires all labor unions or labor organizations that represent (or seek to represent) employees "directly involved in the collection, removal, transportation, or disposal of waste" in New York City to register with the Business Integrity Commission ("BIC"). See Title 16-A of the New York City Administrative Code § 16-505(c) and (d). As part of its mandate to register such labor unions or labor organizations, BIC is gathering information on such organizations currently operating in the trade waste removal industry.

Accordingly, all BIC licensees and registrants are hereby directed to provide the following information:
