



Resources for Driver License Records

Note: This information is being provided as suggested resources for use in obtaining driver license records.

- **New York State DMV:** The License Event Notification Service (LENS) can supply important information about the driving qualifications of drivers that you employ. Organizations that use LENS can quickly identify their problem drivers, and focus efforts to improve safety and decrease vulnerability. LENS can notify your organization about the suspension, revocation and restoration of a driver license, changes to a driver license class and privilege, and a variety of other events. <https://dmv.ny.gov/dmv-records/overview>
- **New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission** The Customer Abstract Information Retrieval (CAIR) is a program offered by the MVC to provide businesses quick and direct access to driver history abstracts and other records.
