

Side Guard Fact Sheet

For <u>every</u> vehicle with BIC-issued Trade Waste Conveyance Plates ("BIC plates") and a GVWR over 10,000 pounds, you must:

- 1. Submit proof of side guard installation including photographs through the BIC Online Portal;
- 2. Apply for a waiver of the side guard requirement from BIC

in order to comply with the side guard law, which goes into effect on January 1, 2023.

Please be advised:

- Licensees and registrants that fail to provide proof of compliance with the side guard requirement or submit a waiver application for <u>EACH</u> vehicle by January 1, 2023, will be subject to a violation.
- Only side guard waiver applications submitted through the online portal will be reviewed by the Commission. BIC will not accept hard copy or emailed waiver applications.
- Providing false information to BIC is a violation of the Commission's Rules (see 17 RCNY § 1-09), which may subject you to criminal penalties or civil penalties of up to \$10,000 for each such violation, and could adversely affect your license or registration status.
