Notice: Cold Weather Advisory

To all Trade Waste Licensees and Registrants:

The National Weather Service has issued a **Cold Weather Advisory** for New York City that remains in effect from **10 AM on January 31, 2026 until 10 AM February 1, 2026**. Very cold wind chills are expected to go as low as 5 to 10 below.

BIC urges licensees and registrants to take all necessary precautions during their operations while the cold weather advisory is in effect. Safety is the priority, including protecting the safety of the public and your employees. As a reminder:

- Prolonged exposure to extreme cold may result in hypothermia if precautions are not taken.
- Drivers and helpers should exercise extra caution when working during these freezing temperatures by adequately being protected from the cold and staying alert to hazardous road conditions.
- If weather conditions are deemed too dangerous for the safe operation of vehicles, cease operations until they can be resumed safely.
