1 MS. STATZ: Good morning, everyone. We  
2 are on the record. Today is July 1, 2025.  
3 The time is 11:00 a.m., and we are at  
4 100 Church Street in New York City on the  
5 20th floor. And welcome to today's meeting  
6 of the New York City Business Integrity  
7 Commission. This is a public meeting which  
8 was duly noticed for today's date at this  
9 location at 11:00 a.m.

10 We have a court reporter here taking  
11 doing what is being said, and this meeting is  
12 also being videotaped. The video recording  
13 will be posted on BIC's website following the  
14 conclusion of this meeting.

15 I am Olga Statz, deputy commissioner  
16 for legal affairs and general counsel for the  
17 Commission. I am joined by the following  
18 Commission members: Elizabeth Crotty,  
19 commissioner and chair of the Business  
20 Integrity Commission; Frank Marshall,  
21 assistant commissioner, Bureau of Commercial  
22 Waste for the Department of Sanitation;  
23 Commissioner Vilda Vera Mayuga of the  
24 Department of Consumer and Worker Protection;  
25 and Deputy Inspector George Pietropinto of

1 the New York City Police Department. Thank  
2 you all for being here with us today.

3 COMMISSIONER MAYUGA: SBS.

4 MS. STATZ: Oh, I'm sorry -- SBS.

5 And we also have for SBS, Shormina  
6 Ahmed who is associate general counsel of the  
7 Small Business Services Commission.

8 So today, the Commission will take up  
9 the matter of the Business Integrity  
10 Commission staff recommendations for the  
11 denial and the revocation of certain license  
12 and registration applications. The first  
13 matter under consideration is Loja Jr  
14 Construction Corp., which had applied to  
15 renew its registration to operate a trade  
16 waste business, solely engaged in the removal  
17 of materials resulting from building  
18 demolition, construction, alteration or  
19 excavation.

20 The staff has recommended denial of  
21 that registration renewal application for the  
22 following independently sufficient grounds:  
23 The Applicant failed to pay taxes, fines,  
24 penalties, or fees that are related to the  
25 Applicant's business for which judgment has

1           been entered by a court or administrative  
2           tribunal of competent jurisdiction; and the  
3           Applicant has knowingly failed to provide  
4           information and/or documentation required by  
5           the Commission. Loja Jr Construction did not  
6           submit a response to the staff's written  
7           recommendation.

8           At this time, I will ask whether there  
9           is a motion with respect to the denial of  
10          Loja Jr Construction Corp.'s registration  
11          renewal application.

12                 Is there a motion?

13                 COMMISSIONER MAYUGA: So moved.

14                 MS. STATZ: Commissioner Mayuga.

15                 Is there a second?

16                 MS. AHMED: I second.

17                 MS. STATZ: SBS.

18                 All in favor?

19                 (Chorus of ayes.)

20                 MS. STATZ: Let the record reflect that  
21          there is unanimous agreement, Loja Jr  
22          Construction Corp.'s registration renewal  
23          application has been denied.

24                 The second matter under consideration  
25          is the revocation of Sarv Enterprise Corp., a

1 registered company that operates a trade  
2 waste business, solely engaged in the removal  
3 of materials resulting from building  
4 demolition, construction, alteration or  
5 excavation.

6 The staff has recommended that the  
7 registration of Sarv Enterprise Corp. be  
8 revoked for the following independently  
9 sufficient grounds: Number 1, the Registrant  
10 violated city, state, and federal law, rules  
11 and regulations relating to traffic safety;  
12 Number 2, the Registrant failed to obey  
13 lawful orders from employees of the  
14 Commission; Number 3, the Registrant violated  
15 federal and state traffic laws, rules, and  
16 regulations; and Number 4, the Registrant  
17 persistently violated city, state, and  
18 federal rules and regulations regarding the  
19 collection, removal, transportation or  
20 disposal of trade waste. Sarv Enterprise  
21 also did not submit a response to the staff's  
22 written recommendation.

23 At this time, I will ask whether there  
24 is a motion with respect to the revocation of  
25 Sarv Enterprise's registration?

1 MR. PIETROPINTO: There's a motion.

2 MS. STATZ: Thank you very much.

3 Is there a second?

4 MR. MARSHALL: Second.

5 MS. STATZ: Thank you very much.

6 All in favor?

7 (Chorus of ayes.)

8 MS. STATZ: Let the record reflect that  
9 the vote is unanimous in favor of revocation.  
10 Sarv Enterprise Corp.'s registration renewal  
11 application is denied. Thank you very much.

12 But before we leave, I'd like to take a  
13 moment to see whether we can schedule the  
14 next meeting. So, the dates that we propose  
15 are October 28th or October 29th; those are  
16 Tuesdays and Wednesdays -- a Tuesday or a  
17 Wednesday.

18 Do these dates suit everyone?

19 MS. AHMED: Yes.

20 MR. PIETROPINTO: Yes.

21 MS. STATZ: Okay. So, let's say that  
22 the meeting will take place on October 28th  
23 at 11 a.m., and we'll send a notice to you  
24 confirming this. Thank you very much.

25 This concludes the matters before the

1 Commission. Thank you to all of the  
2 Commission members for their participation,  
3 and to the members of the Commission staff  
4 for their hard work on these matters. We  
5 thank you, also, for the interns and the  
6 other participants in the audience.

7 We are now off the record. It is  
8 11:12. Thank you.
