THE BUSINESS INTEGRITY COMMISSION DENIES TWO APPLICATIONS FOR CLASS 2 TRADE WASTE REGISTRATIONS

On June 27, 2017, Commissioner and Chair Daniel D. Brownell announced that the New York City Business Integrity Commission denied two applications for class 2 registrations to operate as a trade waste business in New York City.

The denials are as follows:

- La Bella Vista Industries, Inc. (BIC #3460); and
- NYC Topline Construction & Management Inc [sic] (BIC #491145).

La Bella Vista is a trade waste company whose sole principal was convicted of scamming his customers while acting as the driver of a heating oil delivery truck. At the Commission meeting today, Commissioner Brownell stated, "This case demonstrates that BIC will not allow the corruption that is rampant in the heating oil supply industry to bleed over into the trade waste industry. . . . [Nortesano] will not find a home in the trade waste industry. And, if the City Council passes Intro. No. 1268, which proposes placing the heating oil supply industry under BIC regulation, Nortesano and other fraudsters like him will no longer be welcome in that industry either."
