THE NEW YORK CITY BUSINESS INTEGRITY COMMISSION DENIES THREE APPLICATIONS FOR TRADE-WASTE REGISTRATIONS

NEW YORK —Today, Commissioner and Chair Daniel D. Brownell announced that, at a public meeting, the New York City Business Integrity Commission denied the applications of three businesses for registrations to operate as a trade waste business in New York City. The denials are for the following entities: Armtech Industries Corp., Grand Street LLC, and Nu Way Contracting Inc.

The Business Integrity Commission is a commission, comprised of Chair Brownell and the Commissioners of the Department of Sanitation, the New York City Police Department, the Department of Investigation, the Department of Small Business Services, and the Department of Consumer Affairs.
