## BUSINESS INTEGRITY COMMISSION RESOLVES COMPLAINTS OF COMMERCIAL TRADE WASTE CARTER OVERCHARGING RESULTING IN EIGHTEEN MONTHS OF RESTITUTION RECOVERED FOR CUSTOMERS

The New York City Business Integrity Commission ("BIC") conducted an investigation into a licensed commercial trade waste carting company in response to customer complaints of overcharging by the company, and as a result two customers received more than eighteen months of restitution. BIC's review of numerous records found that the complainants, a commercial business located in Manhattan and a separate commercial business located in Brooklyn, had been overbilled by the company for waste collection services.

As a result of BIC's efforts, one customer received more than \$11,000 in restitution from the carter, in addition to a lower monthly collection bill moving forward, while the second customer received approximately \$2,000 in restitution and a lower monthly collection bill.

BIC regulates the trade waste industry in NYC, including enforcing the legal maximum rate, set by the agency, for trade waste collection. The current maximum rates that private carters may charge their customers are \$24.21 per cubic yard of loose refuse (volume), or \$15.89 per 100 pounds of refuse (weight).
