**THE NEW YORK CITY BUSINESS INTEGRITY COMMISSION DENIES THREE
APPLICATION FOR TRADE-WASTE BUSINESSES**

NEW YORK — On June 12, 2019, Commissioner and Chair Noah D. Genel announced that, at a public meeting, the New York City Business Integrity Commission voted to deny one license renewal application, one renewal application for a registration to operate as a trade waste business, and one application for a registration to operate as a trade waste business. The following entities were denied: (1) Flag Container Services Inc., (2) Formica Construction, Inc., and (3) Prestige Stone & Pavers Corp.

The Business Integrity Commission is a commission, comprised of Chair Genel and the Commissioners of the Department of Sanitation, the New York City Police Department, the Department of Investigation, the Department of Small Business Services, and the Department of Consumer Affairs.
