MR. FINKEL: Good morning, and welcome to today's meeting. The time is now eleven o'clock a.m. on Tuesday July 9, 2024. My name is Matthew Finkel, and I'm an executive agency counsel here with the New York City Business Integrity Commission.

We do have a court reporter present with us today, who will be transcribing the hearing. And to avoid background noise during this hearing, we ask everyone to please mute yourself until we call on speakers. The Commission is conducting this remote meeting pursuant to the requirement set forth by the City Administrative Procedure Act, commonly referred to as CAPA.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public on the Commission's proposed rules regarding the implementation of the Commercial Waste Zone program. And we are also proposing to increase the maximum allowable rates for the hauling of waste by licensees. Additionally, the Commission is seeking to streamline and amend rules that are no longer necessary.

The Commission published the proposed

rules in the City Record on June 6, 2024. We also disseminated copy of the rules via e-mail to all New York City elected officials, the managers of all 59 community boards, several media organizations in the City, and other interested parties. Lastly, we posted the proposed rules on both the Commission's website, as well as the website of the New York City Rules.

In summary, the Commission is seeking to modify some of its rules that affect trade waste licensees once particular commercial waste zones are implemented, specifically indicating which sections of the rules will no longer apply to carters within designated zones. The Commission is further seeking to modify traffic safety reporting rules that affect trade waste licensees and registrants. These rules are no longer necessary, since the Commission's authority was expanded to include traffic safety requirements for vehicles used in the collection, removal, transportation, or disposal of trade waste.

The Commission is also proposing to require the surrender of Commission issued

trade waste license plates upon the disposition of a vehicle that has been issued such plates. The proposed rules also clarify the recycling requirements for self-hauler registrants. And finally, the Commission is proposing an increase in the maximum rate that a licensee may charge for the collection, removal, disposal or recycling of trade waste to \$26.87 per cubic yard and \$17.64 per 100 pounds. The Commission's authority for these rules can be found in Sections 1043(a) and 2101(b) of the New York City Charter.

That concludes the summary of the proposed rules changes at this hearing. You may present an oral statement for the record or submit written comments concerning the proposed rules changes. Additionally, the Commission has been accepting written comments on the proposed rules since the publication in the City Record. And we will accept further comments until five o'clock p.m. today, July 9, 2024.

The Commission will make available a copy of any written comments that are

received in connection with today's hearing on its website. The Commission will carefully review and consider all comments and submissions and make necessary changes, if the Commission deems them so necessary. The rules will go into effect 30 days after they are published in the City Record.

We will begin calling those of you who wish to speak this morning. When you speak, please state your full name and affiliation, and speak slowly and clearly, so that the court reporter can understand and accurately transcribe your statement. We ask that you limit your statement to three minutes.

Nicole Mathias, our director of policy, will now begin calling on members of the public to testify. If you wish to testify, please unmute yourself now.

Good morning. My name is David
Biderman. I am the president at Biderman
Consulting LLC. I'm appearing today on
behalf of the following licensees; Century
Waste Services, D&D Carting, M&M Sanitation,
and Mr. T Carting. I will be testifying
solely concerning the proposed adjustment to
maximum rate caps.

The four licensees that I just identified submitted oral testimony and written comments in October and November of last year, in support of their request for a rate cap increase. These licensees, and I suspect most of the industry, are pleased that the Business Integrity Commission is proposing an increase to \$26.87 per cubic yard and \$17.64 per 100 pounds. We urge the BIC to expeditiously finalize this adjustment to the rate caps as labor, disposal, and other costs are increasing on a monthly basis.

This concludes my testimony, and thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony today.
