Executive Agency Counsel at the New York

City Business Integrity Commission and

The Commission is conducting this remote hearing pursuant to the requirements set forth by the City

Administrative Procedure Act, commonly referred to as "CAPA". The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public on the Commission's proposed rules regarding the procedure for permitting a person to petition the Commission to consider the rule -- to consider the adoption of a new rule.

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The Commission published the proposed rules in The City Record on January 17, 2023. We also disseminated a copy of the rules via email to all New York City local-elected officials, the managers of all 59 Community Boards, several media organizations in the City, and other interested parties.

Lastly, we posted the proposed rules on both the Commission's and the New York City Rules' websites.

In summary, the Commission is proposing to amend Title 17 of the Rules of the City of New York to implement Section 1043(G) of the New York City Charter, which permits any person to petition any agency to consider the adoption of any rule and requires each agency to have rules creating a procedure for such petitions.

The proposed rules set forth the procedures that petitioners must follow in petitioning the Commission to consider a new rule. The proposed rules also set forth a procedure for rejecting

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or adopting petitions. The rules would require the Chair to deny or approve petitions within 60 days.

If the Chair wishes to adopt a petition, the proposed rules will be drafted in accordance with the authority delegated in Section 15-01 of Chapter 3 of Title 17 of the Rules of the City of New York. The Commission must still approve, by majority vote, any rule before it is promulgated.

This concludes the summary of the proposed rule changes at issue at this hearing.

You may present an oral statement for the record or submit written comments concerning the proposed rule changes. Additionally, the Commission has been accepting written comments on the proposed rules since the publication in The City Record and as of February 21, 2023.

The Commission will make available a copy of any written comments that were received in connection with today's

hearing on its website. The Commission 1 will carefully review and consider all 2 comments and submissions and make 3 changes if the Commission deems that is 4 5 necessary. The rules will go into effect 30 days after they are published 6 7 in The City Record. We will begin calling on those of 8 9 you who wish to speak this morning. 10 When you speak, please state your full name and affiliation, and please 11 12 speak slowly and carefully so the court reporter can understand and accurately 13 14 transcribe your statement. We ask that you limit your statement to three 15 16 minutes. 17 I will now begin on calling on 18 members of the public who wish to 19 testify.
