#### c. Overview of commingled programming:

- Internal: DOC-led programming. As a result of COVID-19, the Department revised programming services to include the provision of self-guided packages that has content such as activity packets, interactional journaling, and evidenced-based curriculum worksheets. Program Counselors conduct follow-up sessions to respond to questions and ensure the completion of the self-guided packets. Social service slips are made available as an additional service offered.
- II. <u>External:</u> DOC partners with seven nonprofit organizations to support incarcerated individuals pre and post release. As a result of COVID-19, the Department worked with providers to implement social distancing programing and have collaborated to development and distribute curriculum and activity
