**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF CORRECTION
OCTOBER 14, 2025 PUBLIC MEETING**

WHEREAS, New York City Charter § 626(e) authorizes the Board to “establish minimum standards for the care, custody, correction, treatment, supervision, and discipline of all persons held or confined under the jurisdiction” of the Department of Correction (“DOC” or the “Department”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Charter-mandated duty to establish minimum standards, the Board established a Minimum Standards Review Committee to review the minimum standards and recommend amendments accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the Minimum Standards Review Committee recommends that the Board initiate rulemaking to amend sections 2-05(b)(2)(i-ii) and 3-04(b)(2)(v)(A) of Title 40 of the Rules of the City of New York (“RCNY”) to codify long-standing variances granted by the Board regarding psychotropic medication and tuberculosis screening, and to amend outdated language in the mental health and health care minimum standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board authorizes Board staff to draft proposed rules for the Board’s consideration and undertake all aspects of rulemaking pursuant to the Citywide Administrative Procedure Act;

IT IS FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be posted conspicuously on the Board’s website.

At the Board’s October 14, 2025 meeting, the Board unanimously voted to approve the Resolution.
