On November 10, 2015, the NYC Board of Correction voted to APPROVE the Health and Hospitals Corporation's request for a continuing variance from BOC Minimum Standard 1-02(2)(c) regarding implementation of the Young Adult Plan and the separation of inmates ages 18 through 21 from inmates ages 22 and over.

Pursuant to §1-15(b)(2)(i) of the New York City Board of Correction's ("Board") Minimum Standards, the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation ("HHC") requests a continuing variance from the BOC Minimum Standards §1-02(2)(c), which requires that "no later than October 15, 2015...inmates ages 18 through 21 be housed separately and apart from inmates over the age of 21," in relation to the housing of inmates in specialized mental health units, including but not limited to the Program for Accelerating Clinical Effectiveness (PACE) and Clinical Alternative to Punitive Segregation (CAPS) units and for the provision of services through the KEEP program at Anna M. Kross Center (AMKC) – and in the NIC infirmary and WF communicable disease unit (CDU).
