NYC Department of Correction – June 2018 PREA Investigations Corrective Action Plan

Current PREA Investigations Division Caseload

The current total PREA caseload is approximately **1,295**. This includes cases from 2015 through present that fall under PREA-reportable criteria. All cases are investigated within the first 72 hours of the allegation.

The average approximate caseload of investigators carrying PREA cases is **95**, since they are tasked with also investigating cases that are not PREA-reportable, such as one-time sexual harassment allegations. Counting non-PREA reportable cases, the total caseload managed by the ID PREA Team is 2,275.

Cases Over 90 Days

Out of the 1,295 PREA-reportable cases, 1,216 are over 90 days old.

Current PREA Investigations Staffing

The Investigation Division ("ID") PREA team consists of **19** investigators; there are approximately 536 cases out of the 2,275 being carried by ID Investigators not currently assigned to the "PREA team."

Goals

Staffing: 30 investigators, 6 supervising investigators and 2 Deputy Directors.

Caseload per PREA investigator: 30 or less.

Closure of Cases Older than 90 Days: By February 2019

Target Dates

August 2018 (next reporting period): Closure of an additional 300 cases

February 2019 (following reporting period): Closure of all cases older than 90 days
