Young adults who opted not to participate in recreation were consulted with and the general consensus was that they would rather opt for inside programming, television and/or sleep. In order to continue to follow social distancing guidelines programming staff were unable to facilitate structured activities. As an alternative, young adults were provided authorized books of their choice as well as cognitive skills therapeutic packets.
