

I Reiterate

The DOC & CHS continue to blatantly disregard the health safety life and rights of us, not only as detainees but as human beings as well. The treatment, or lack thereof, and lack of proper protocol and procedures to ensure our health and safety are far beyond gross negligent. This Wanton Act has caused many of us great mental, emotional, spiritual, and physical issues. Deep depression, anxiety, restlessness paranoia, sleep deprivation, constant headaches cough, sneezing, aches, pain and suffering, frustration and hopelessness just to name a few. I've asked numerous times for officers to put on latex or plastic gloves before searching me. As a result I've never been able to participate in recreation get something so simple and essential as fresh air sunshine and exercise. I haven't been afforded the physical therapy as needed nor the specialist / DRs I need and been scheduled to see since the past 7 to 8 months. My condition have not gotten better! The most recent appointment I had at Bellevue hospital was denied to me by the transporting officer because she couldn't get a note for my cane. Even though I have several notes, plus its in the computer system and you can't receive a cane without a DRs note yet

still I was denied medical treatment because I have a medical condition that requires me to use a cane to walk. October 1, 2020 I called Clinic around 9:45am and complained about my Right side upper chest pain and discomfort, strong constant headache and low back pain. The DR did not examine me at all. He simply had me take 2 X Rays and I was escorted back to my unit. I had a fever as well when vitals were taken. I Reported it, as always, ~~and~~ Nothing was done. I've reported issues with law library not afforded properly several times and how many of us wait weeks for simple things needed like; notary, copies, motions, and supplies. Many days like today, Tuesday 10-6-20, the legal coordinator is not here or available to provide the legal services we need but the officer comes at 7:12pm to sign books to show that law library service is afforded but it's actually not. Our legal matters and defenses are hindered and greatly affected by this inadequate service. As of Saturday 10-3-20 Kyle Alston was confirmed positive for Covid-19. The repeated complaints of overcrowding, lack of ppe and the lack of taking this pandemic serious has once again put my life in jeopardy, as well as the 44 other detainees that were in my unit. Social distance, and Constitutional, Civil, and prisoner rights all are and continue to be violated. In August I tested positive

for the antibodies. I encouraged others to get tested and 8 out of 9 people tested positive also. Now this is my second time being exposed to Covid 19 while in DOC custody yet I hardly ever leave my housing unit. I've witnessed Captain Harris & Jesus Alvarez lose their life from Covid 19 and many men gotten very ill. And to be going thru this again definitely affects one's psyche as well as physical, emotional, and spiritual health. The sad and scary part is that everyone has been made aware - from media to deputies, Captains, officers, medical staff, 311, and Board of Correction, yet nothing has changed at all since I've been here at VBC. I have over 10 personal injury claims against NYDOC and CHS from all the Hell, and gross negligent-attempt murder, violations, malpractice, injuries, and have much evidence proof and consistent reports throughout my entire 16 months in NYDOC custody. The less than 50% of commissary items that are afforded I won't even bother. Like I said, everything has been reported to everyone yet ZERO has been done about anything, but DOC has you all and the public believing otherwise.

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
