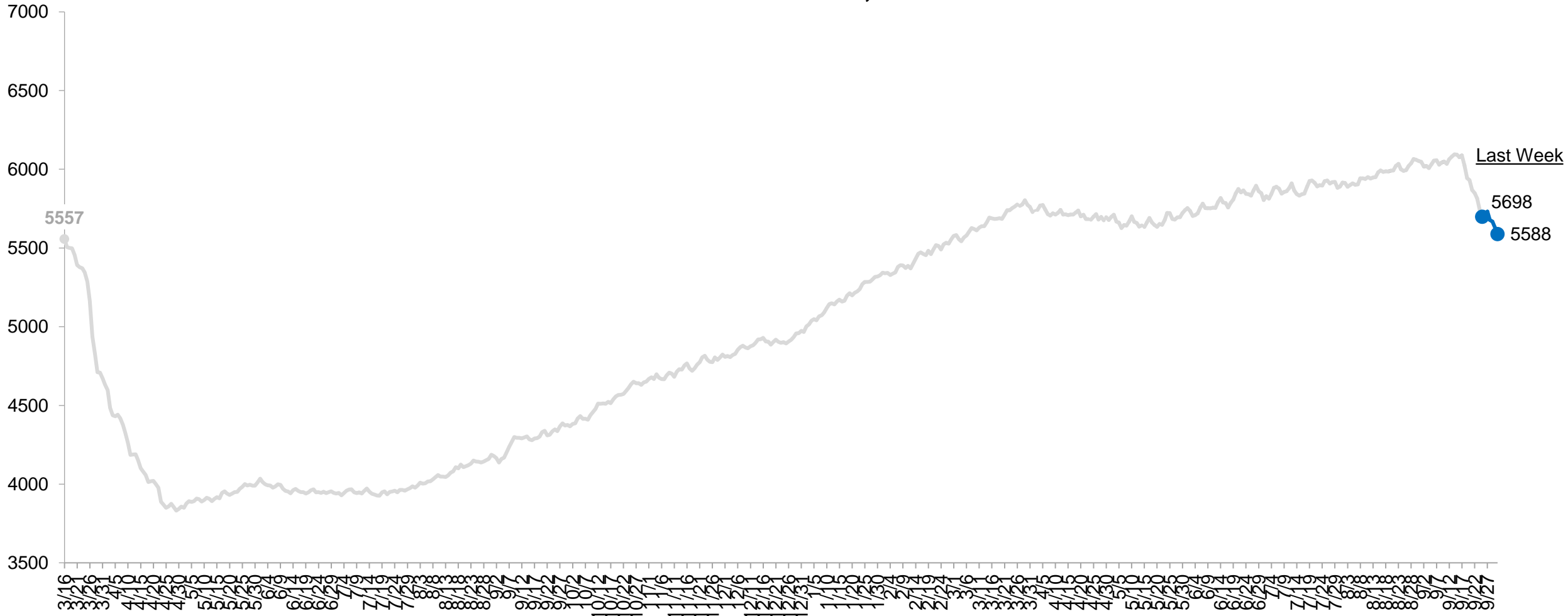

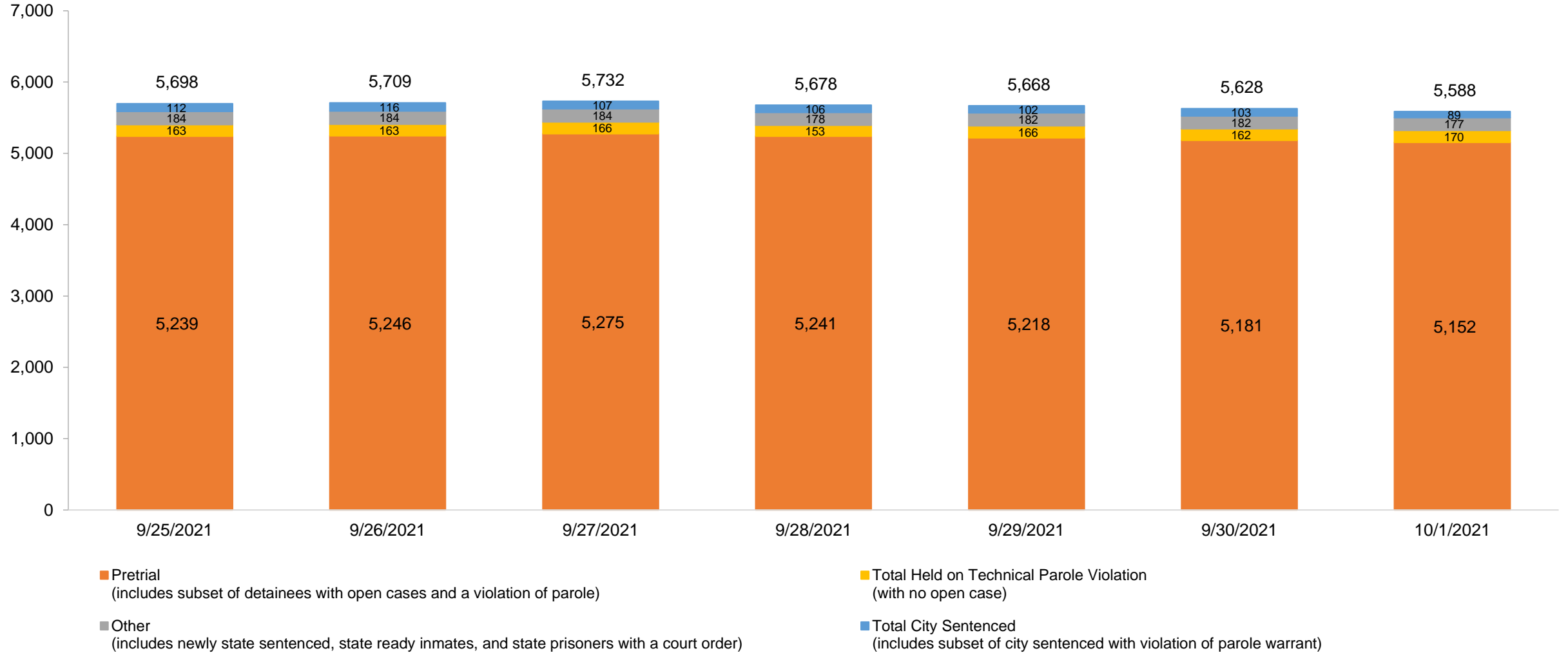
Total Population in DOC Custody March 16 – October 1, 2021

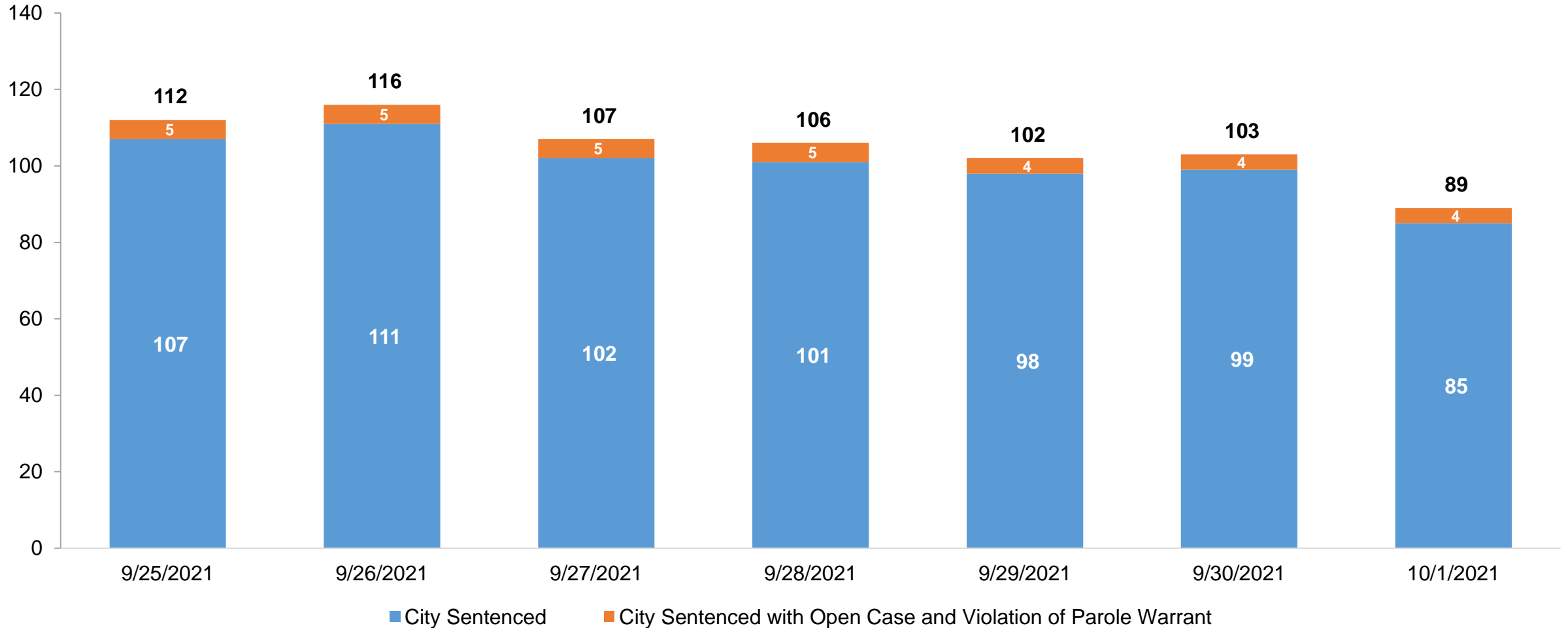

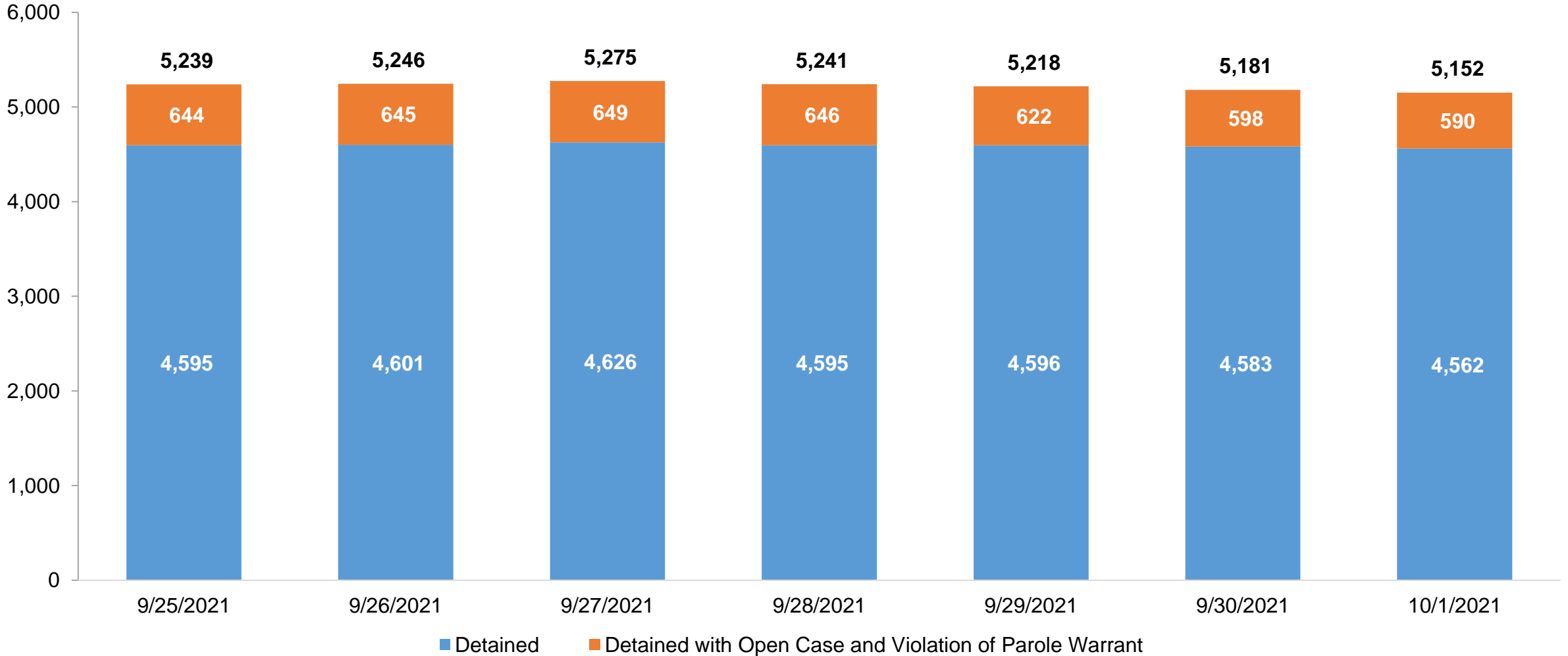
City Sentenced Population by Custody Status September 25, 2021 – October 1, 2021

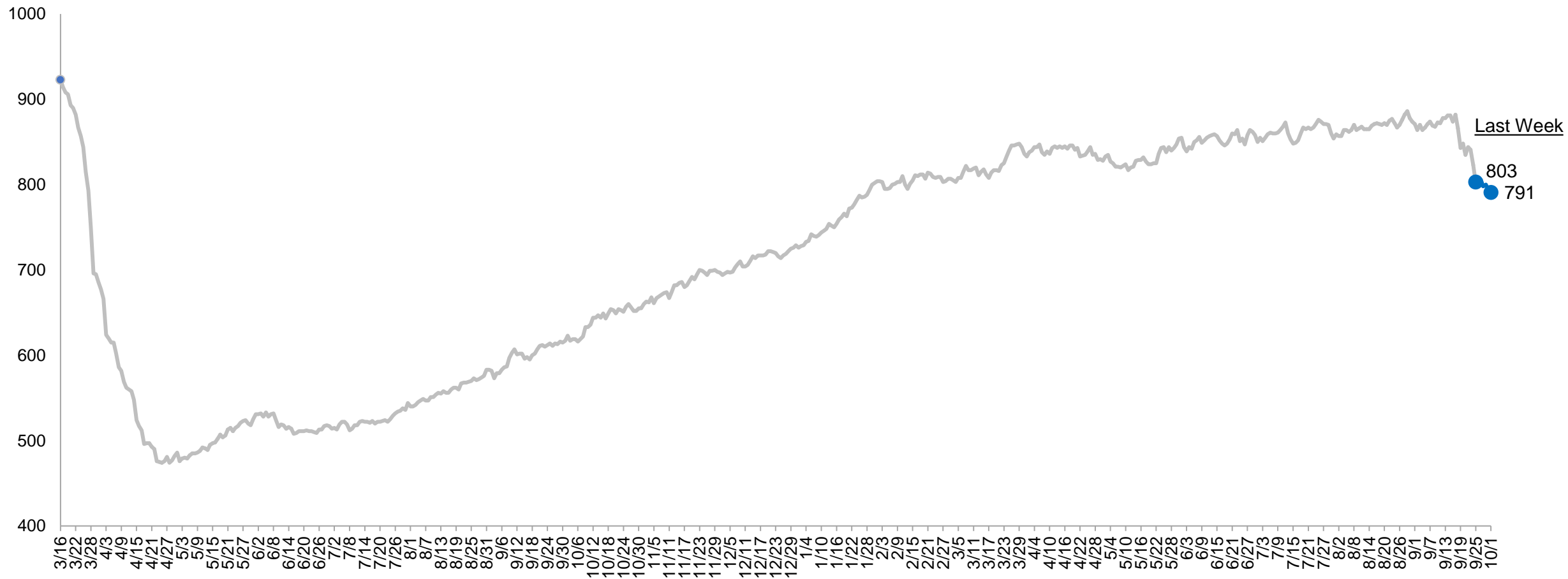

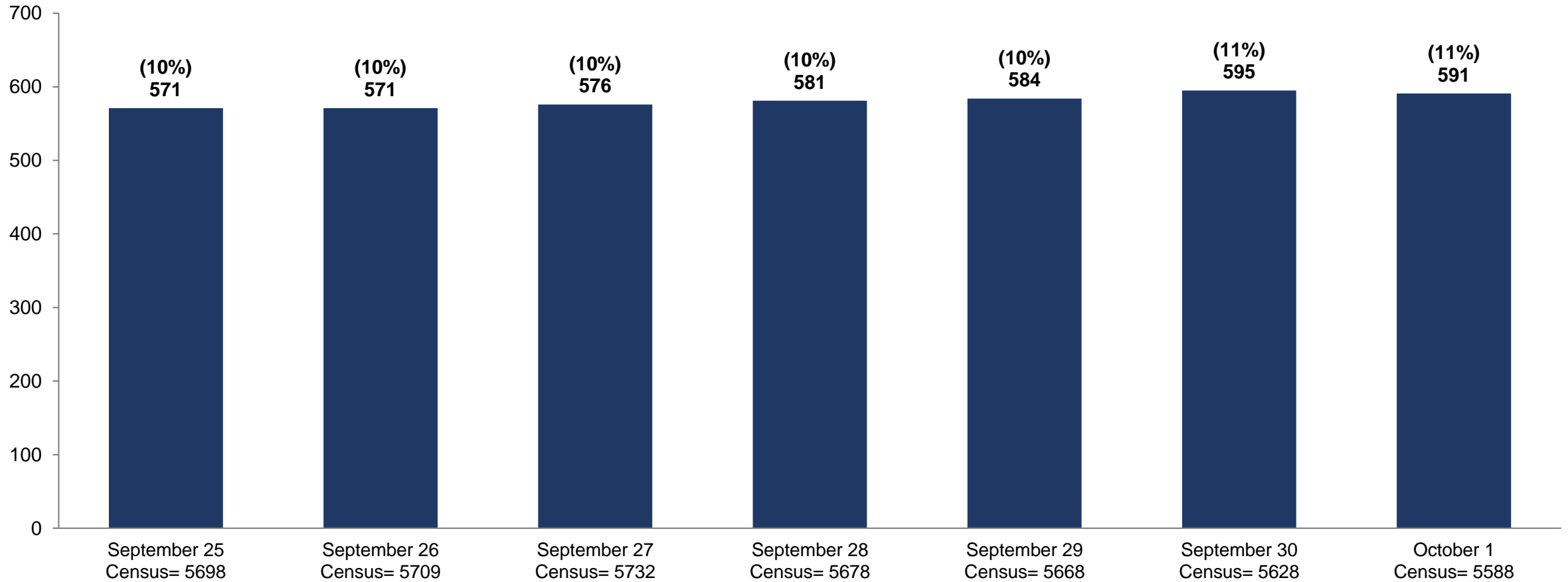

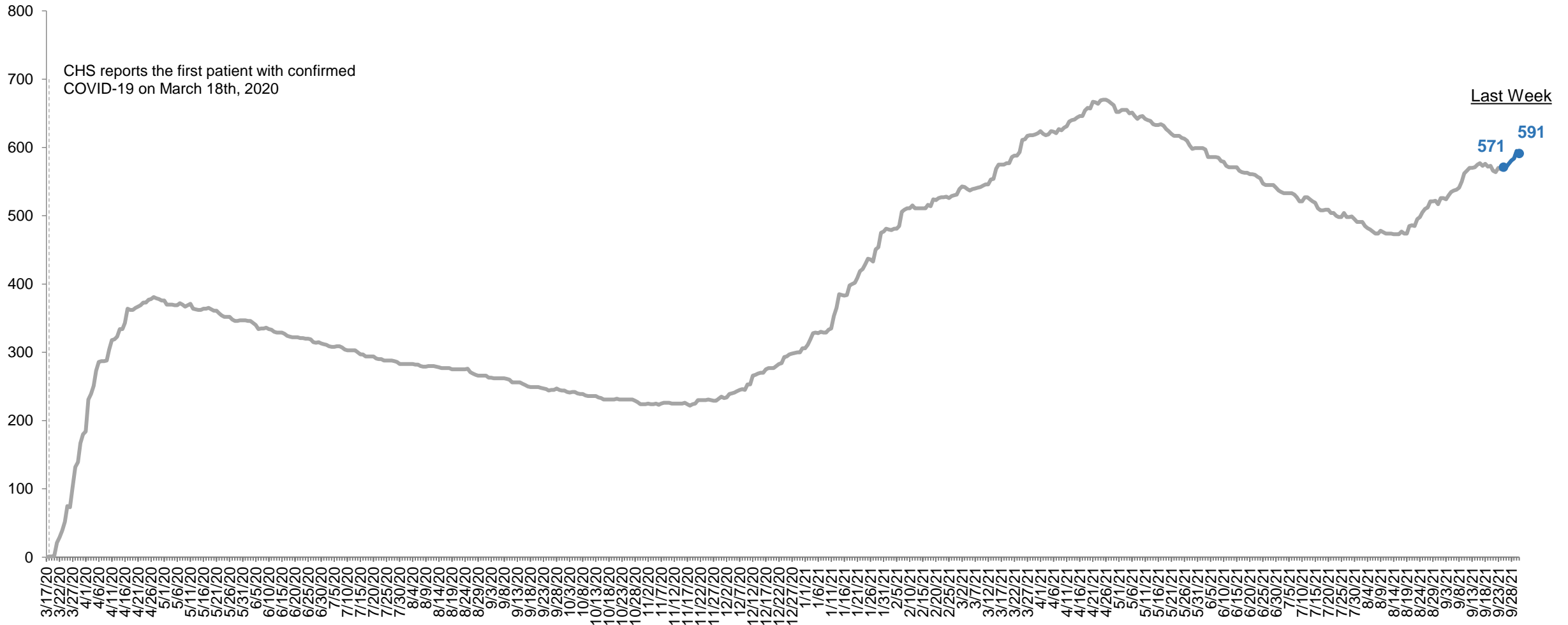
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

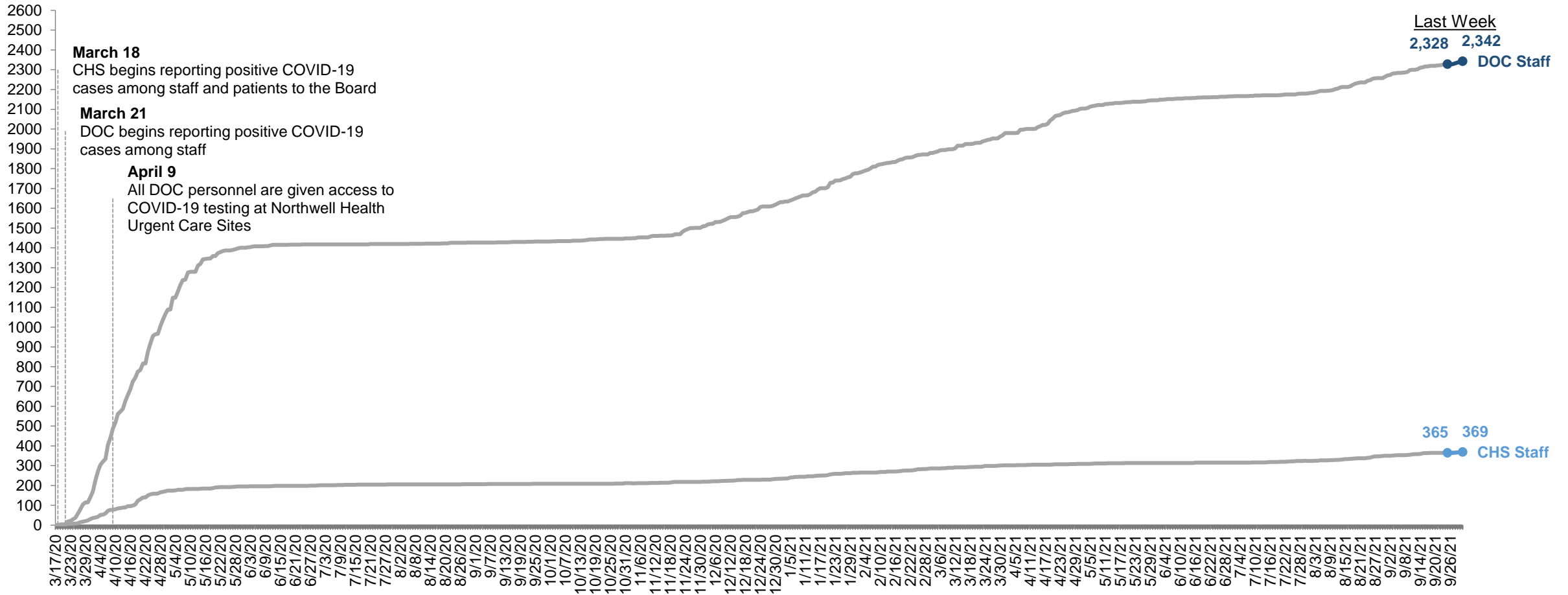
Number of Currently Incarcerated Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

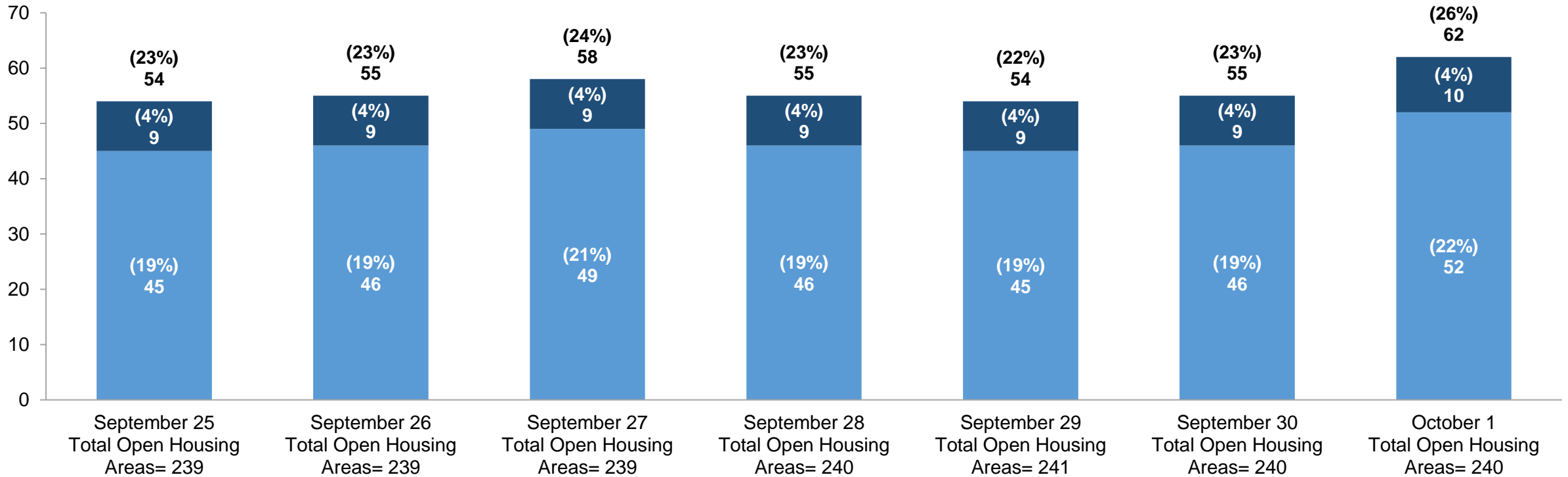

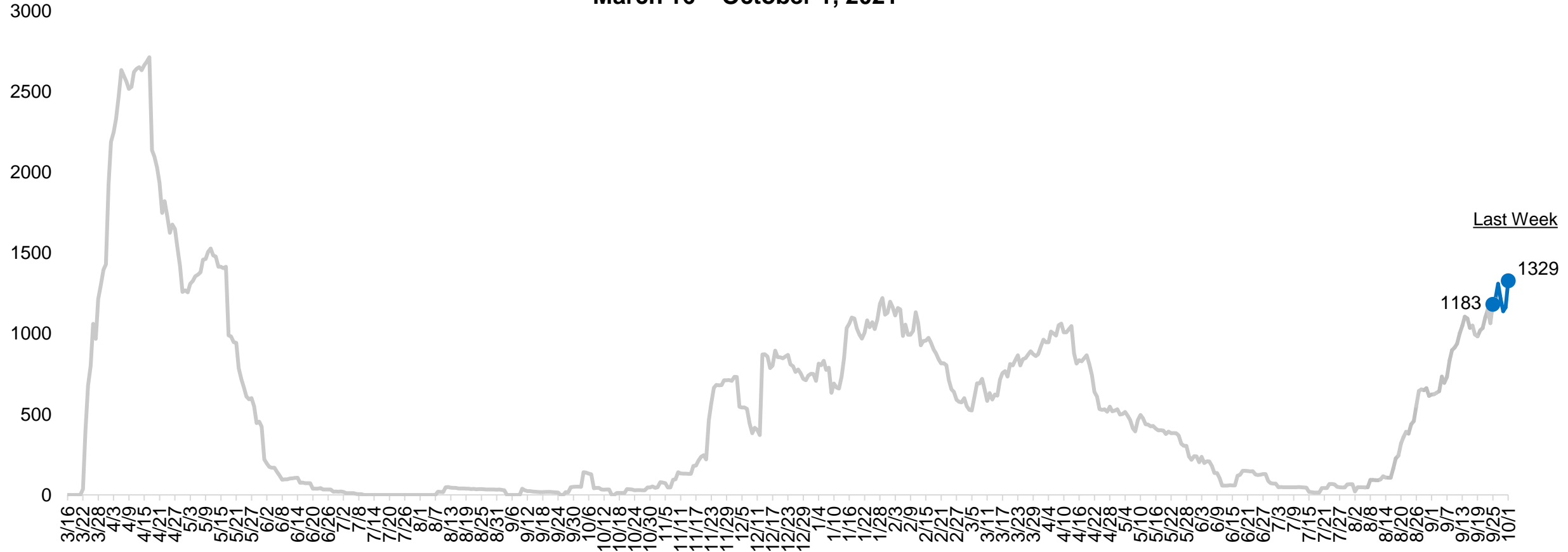

March 16 – October 1, 2021**

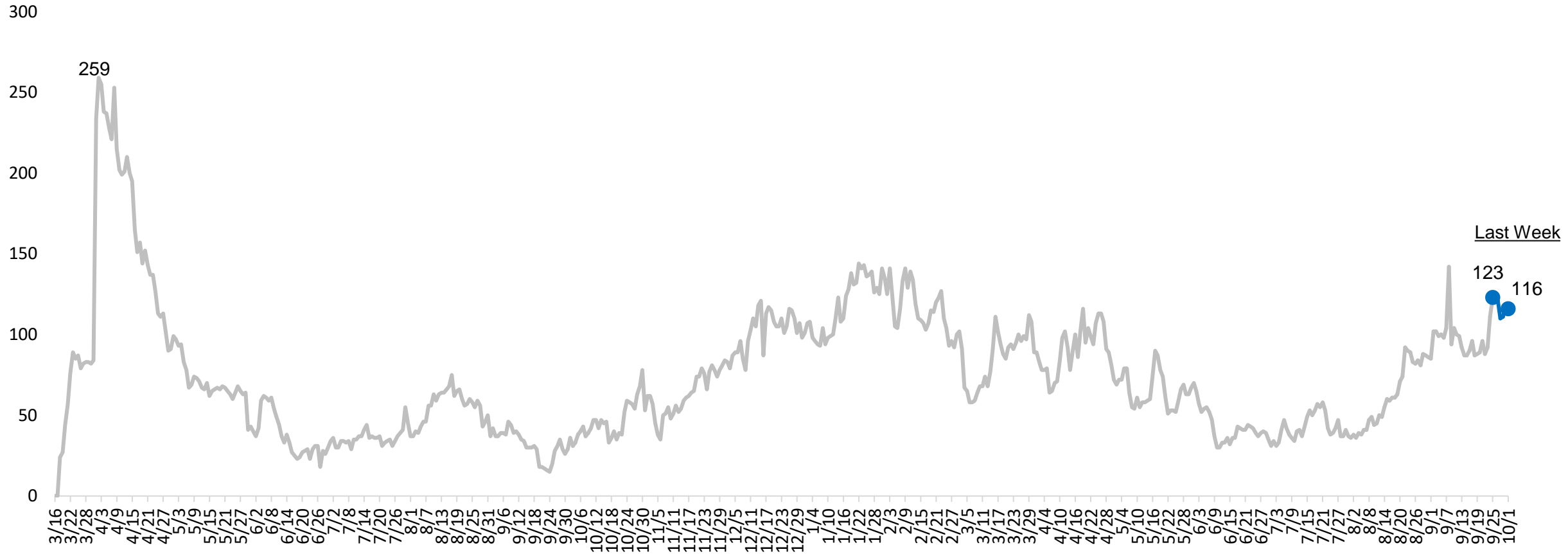

March 16 – October 1, 2021**

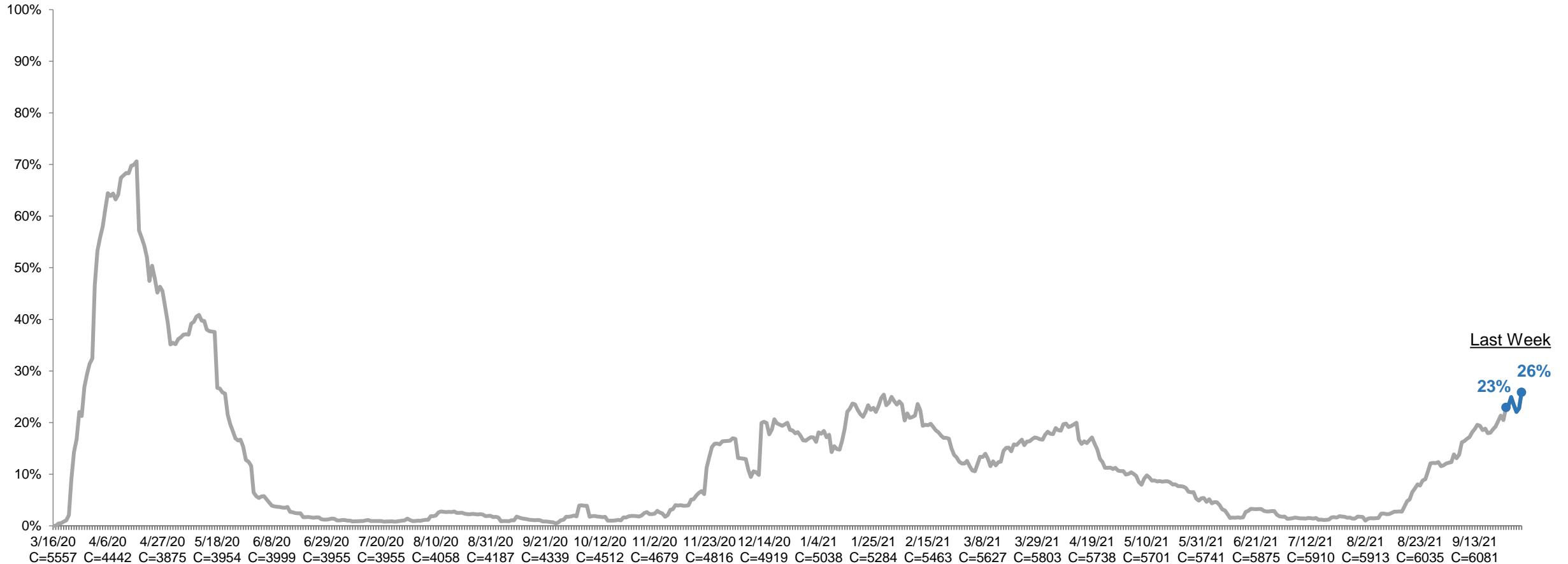

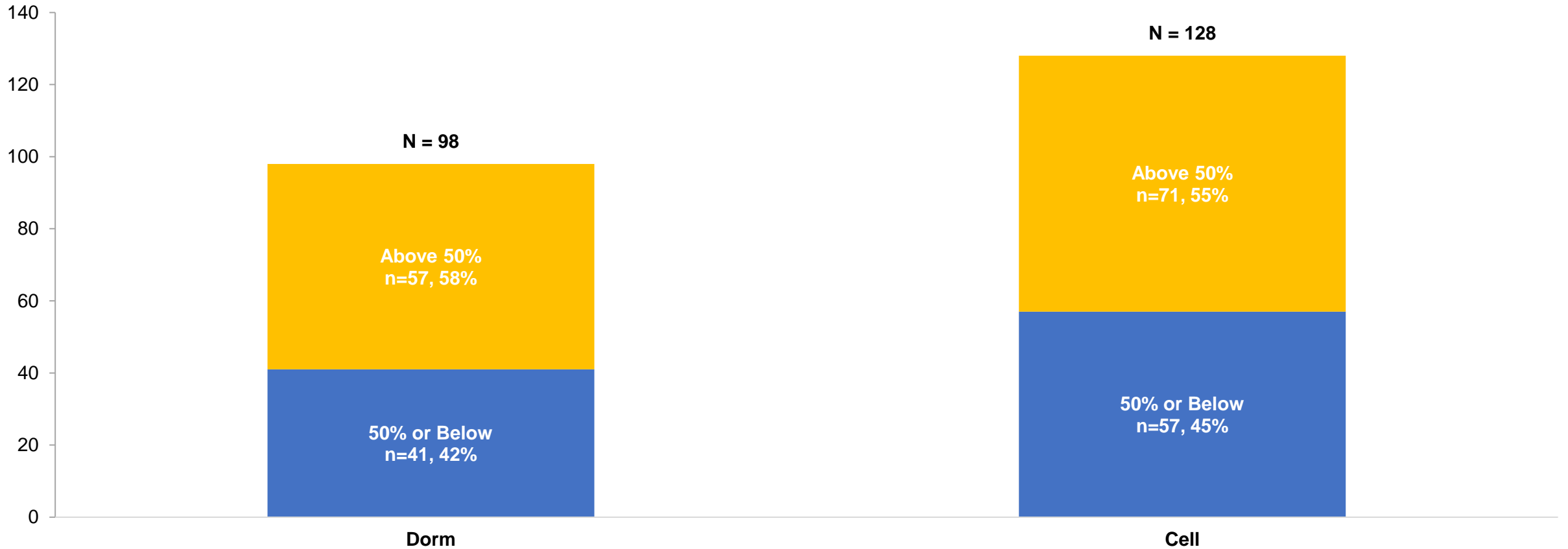

September 30, 2021



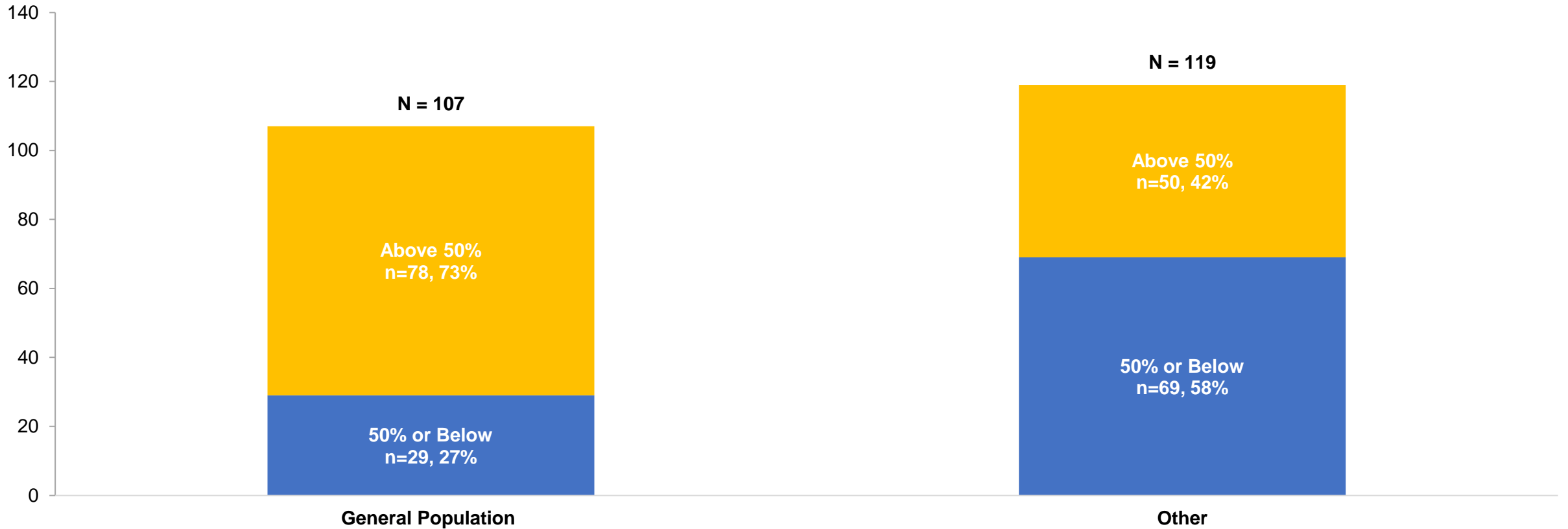

September 30, 2021**



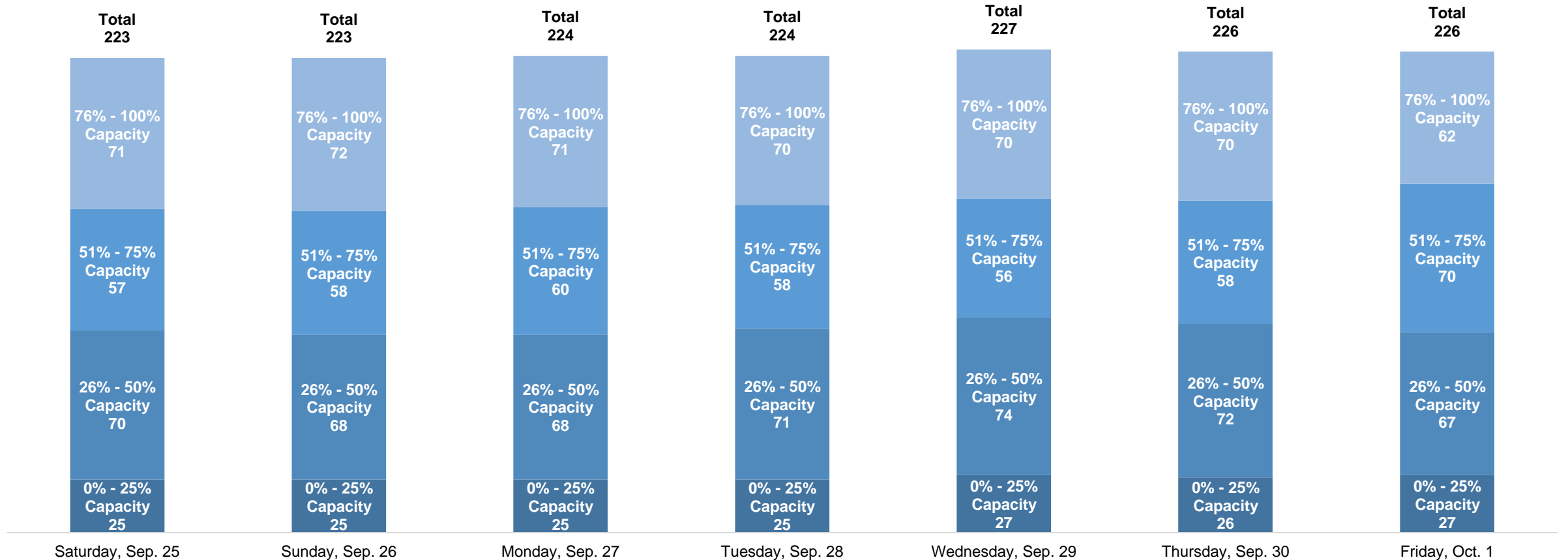
