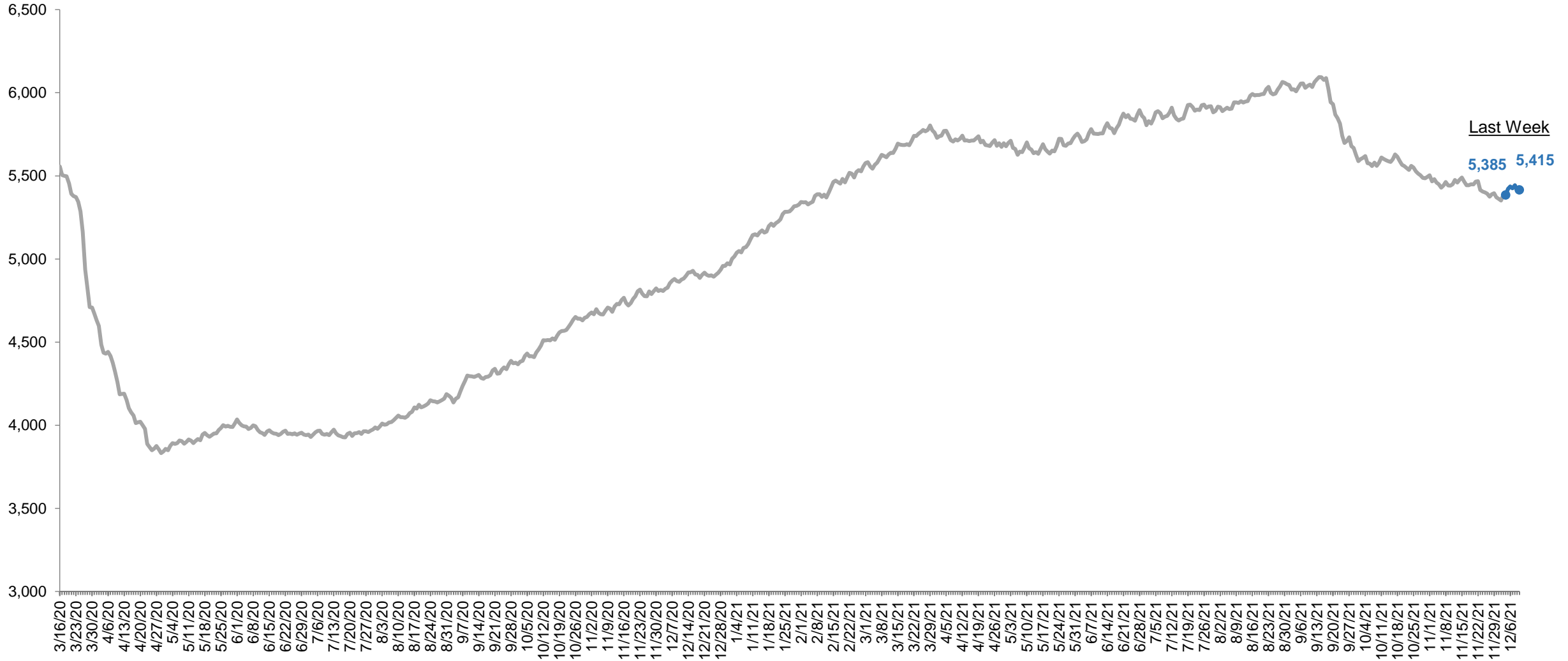

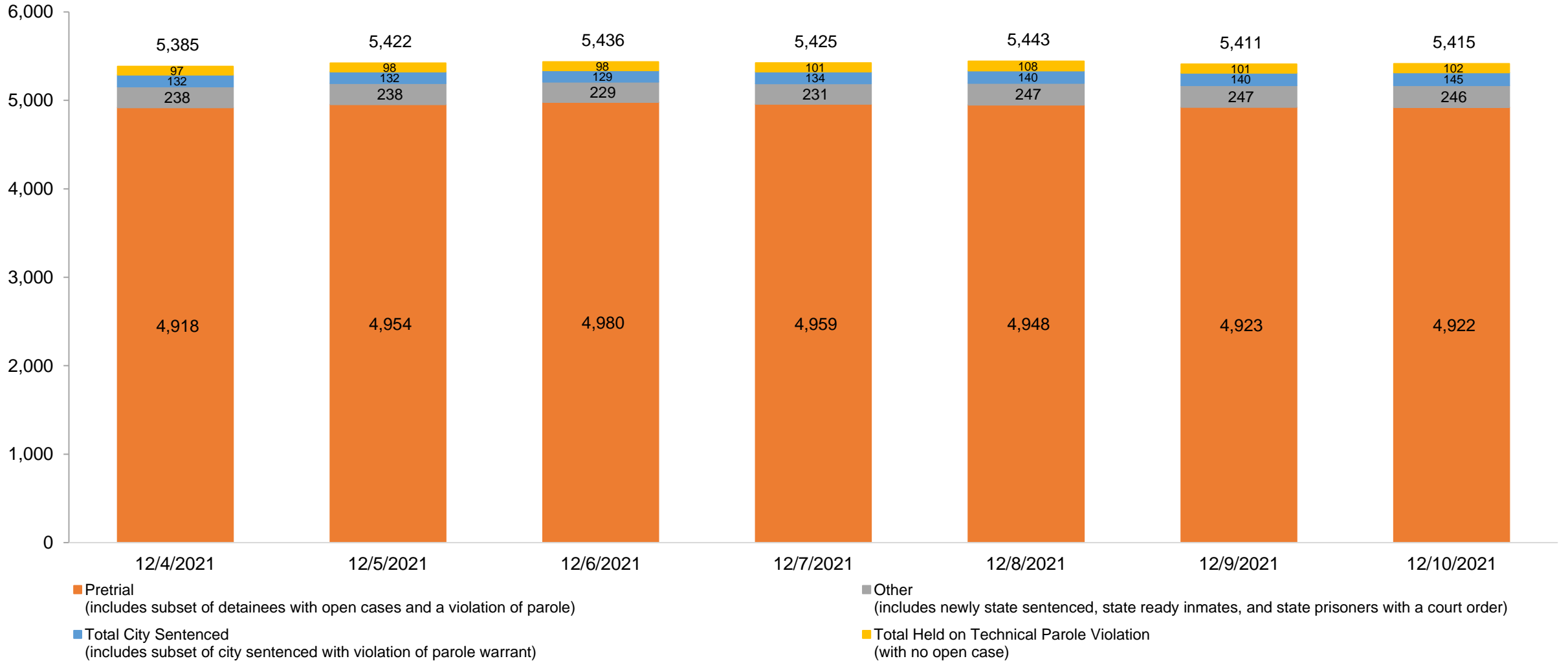
**Total Population in DOC Custody

December 4, 2021 – December 10, 2021**

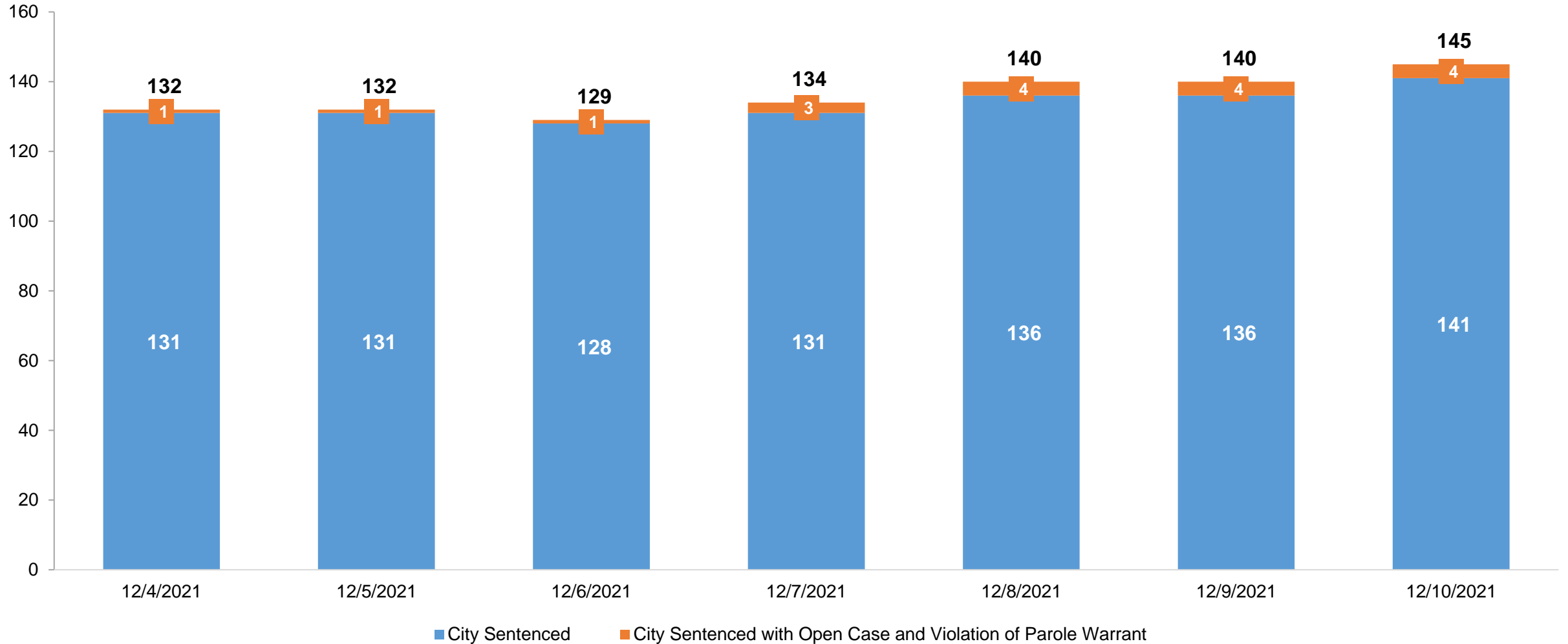

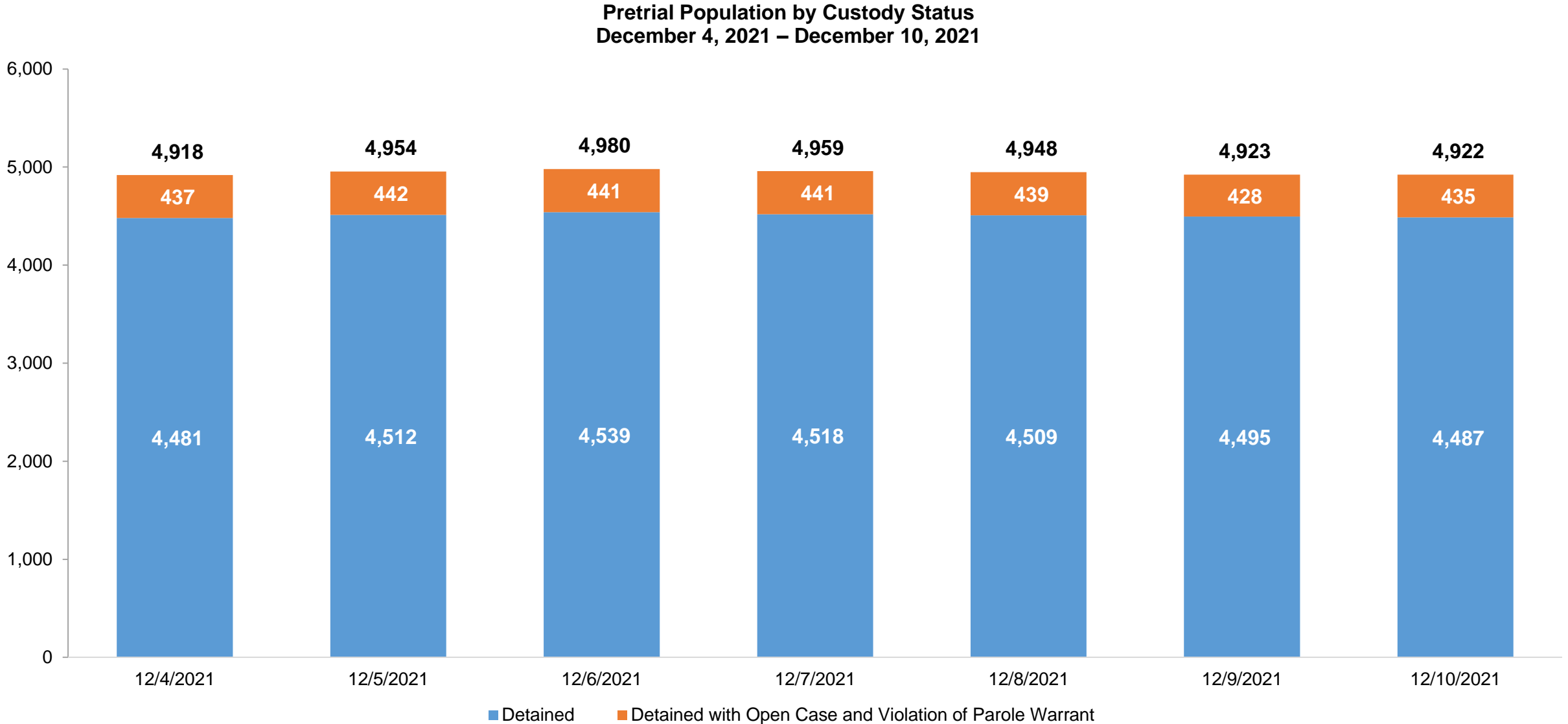
**City Sentenced Population by Custody Status

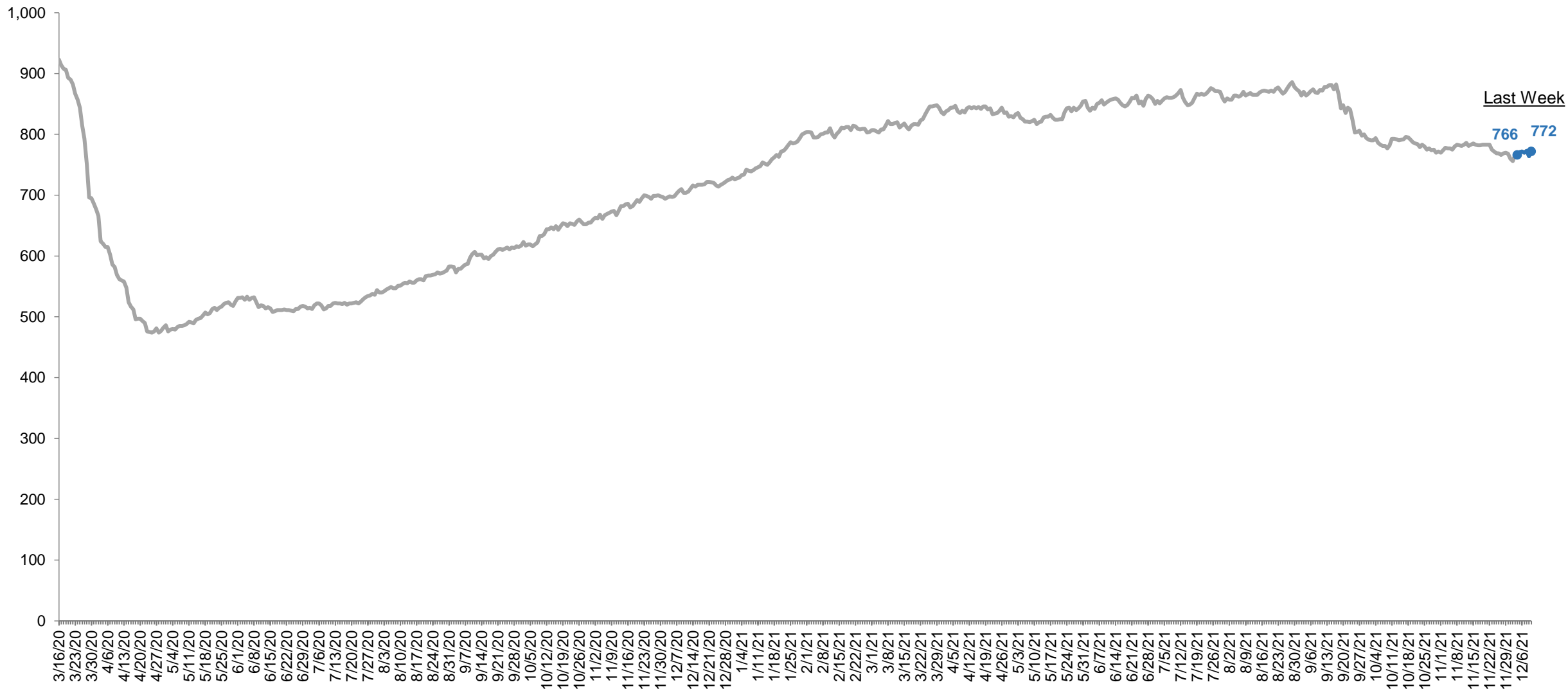

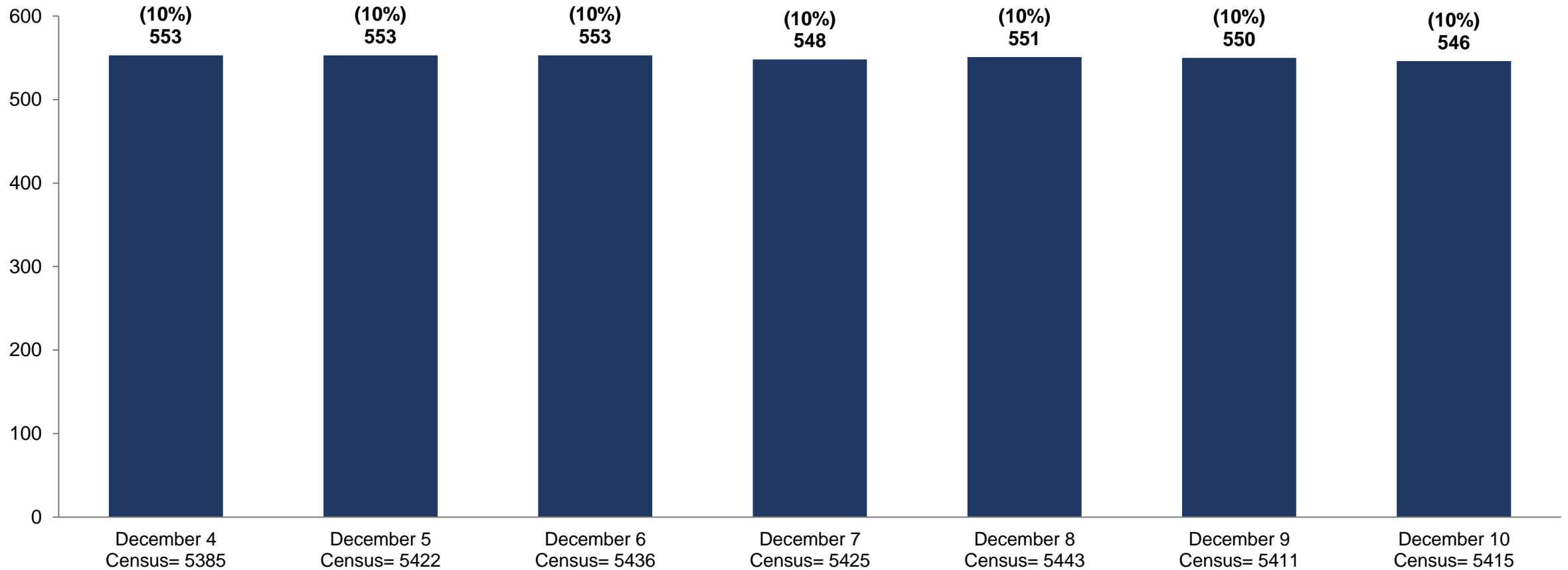

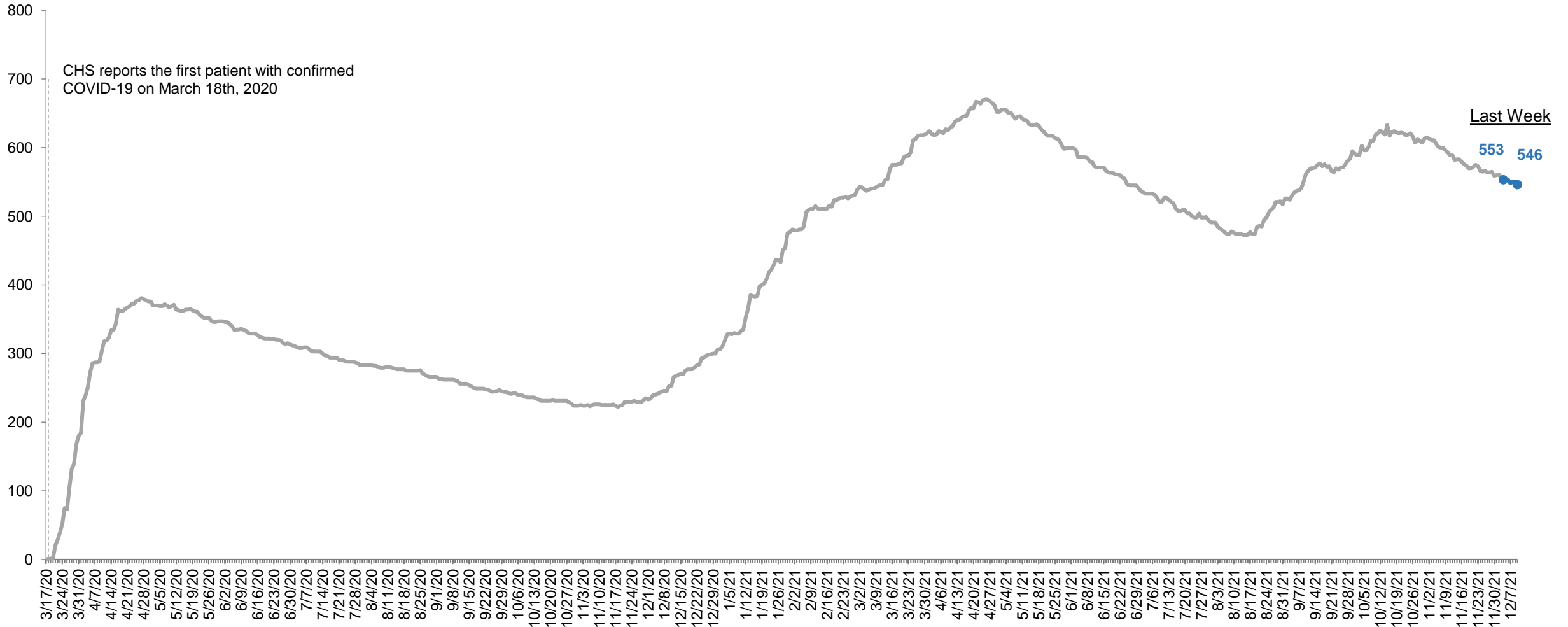
Number and Percent of Patients with Confirmed COVID-19

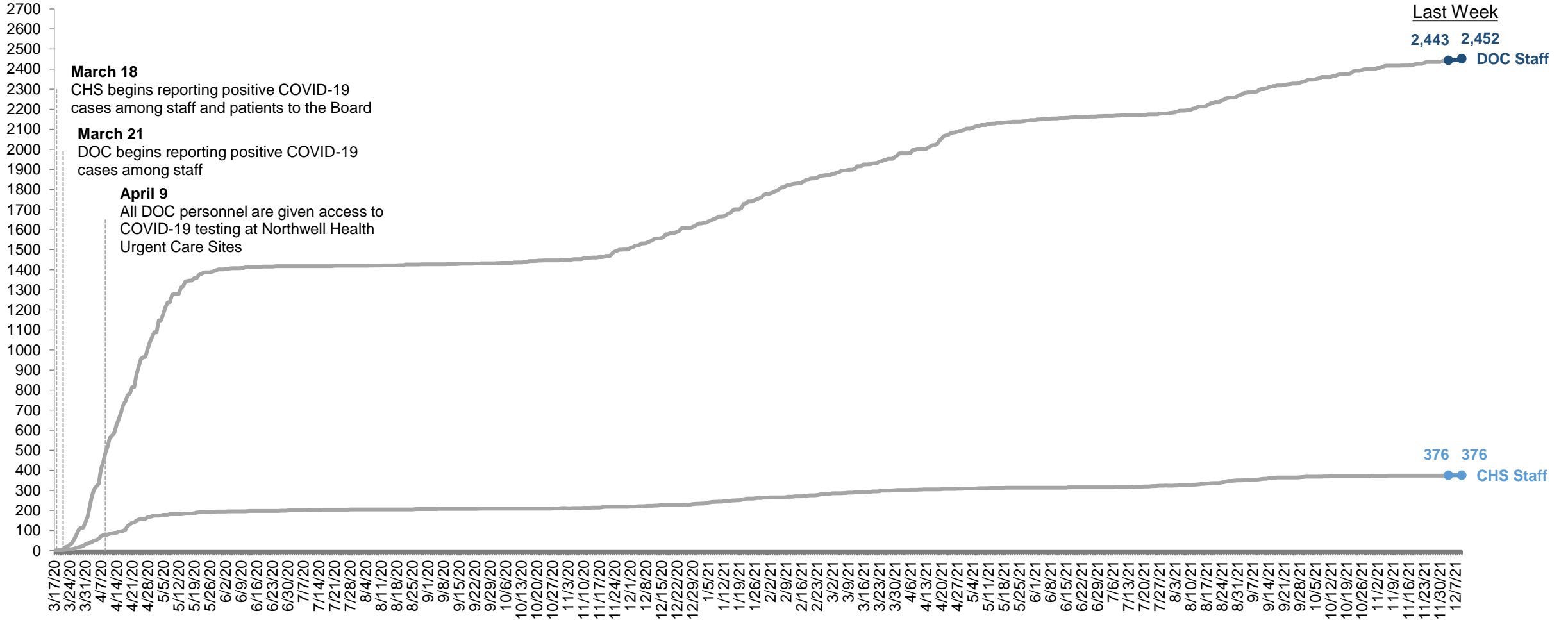

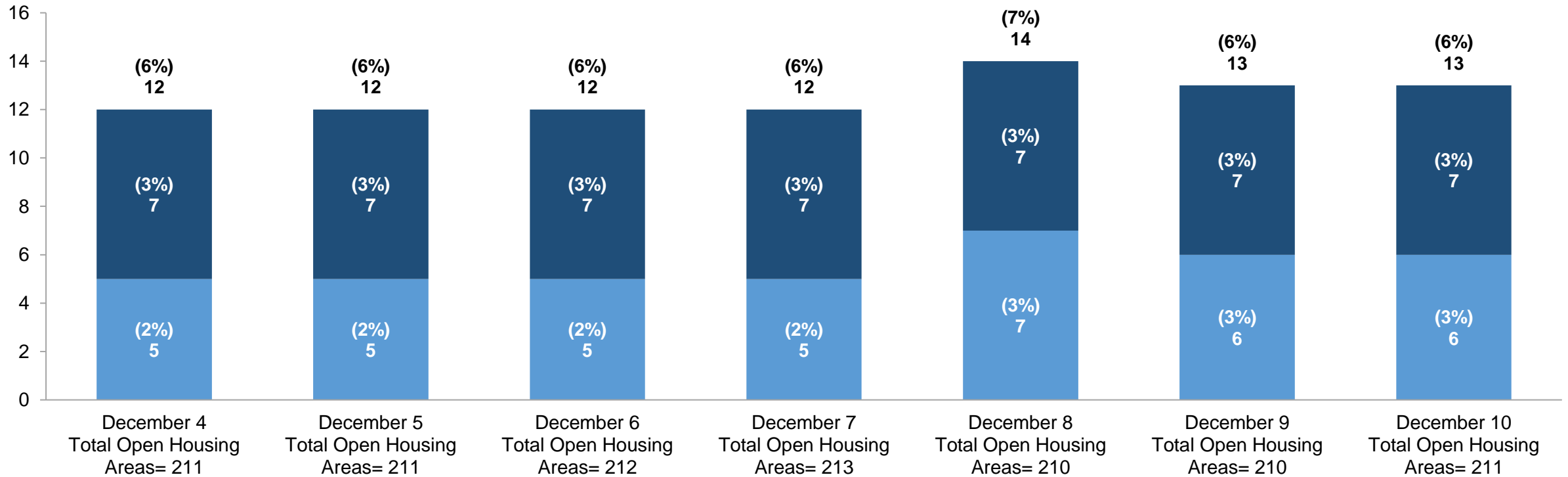

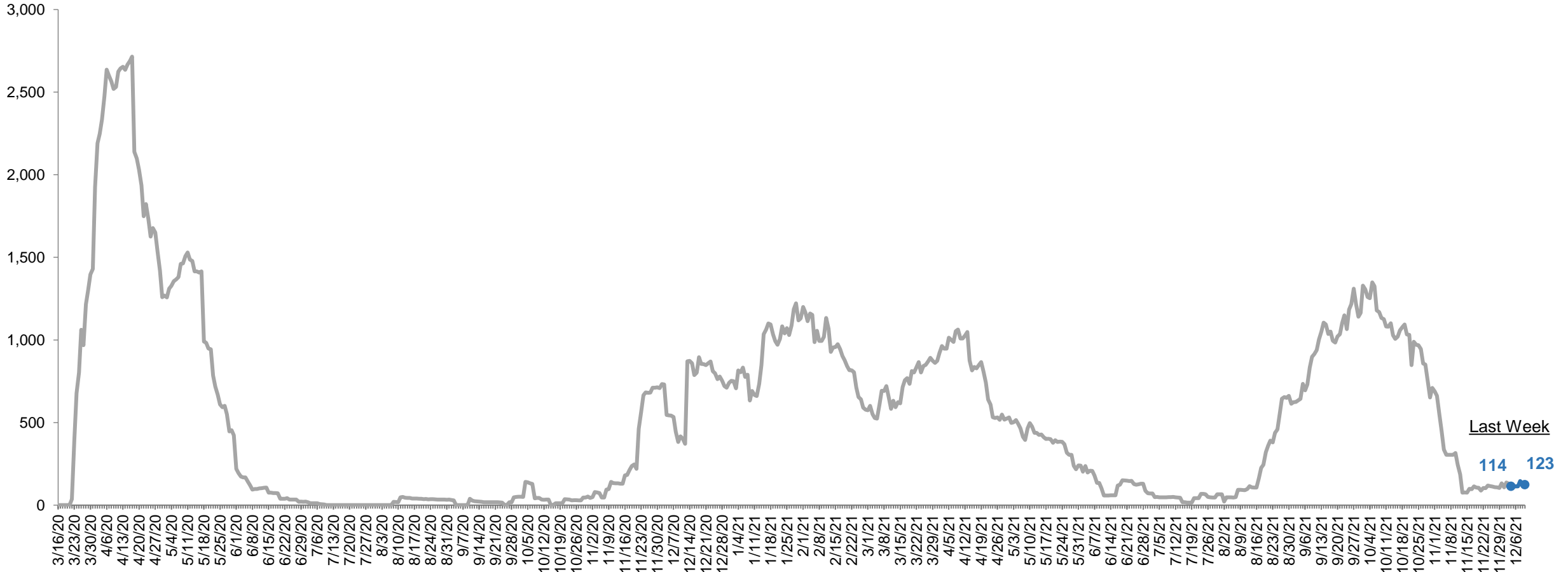

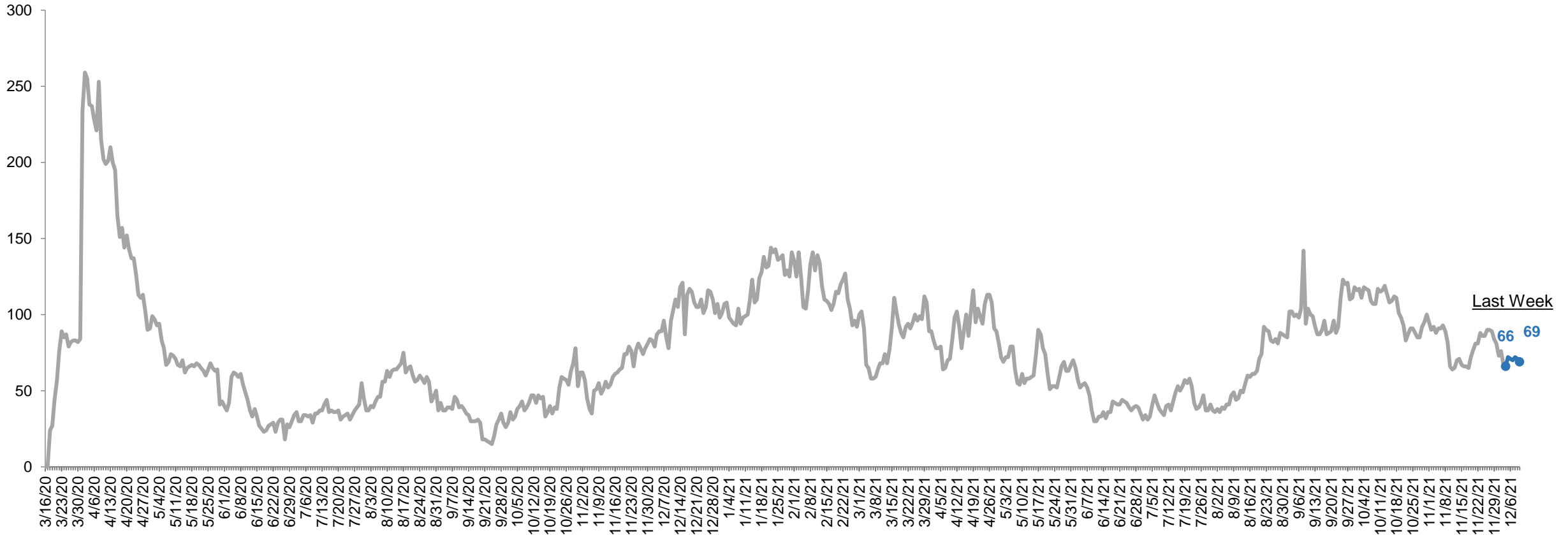

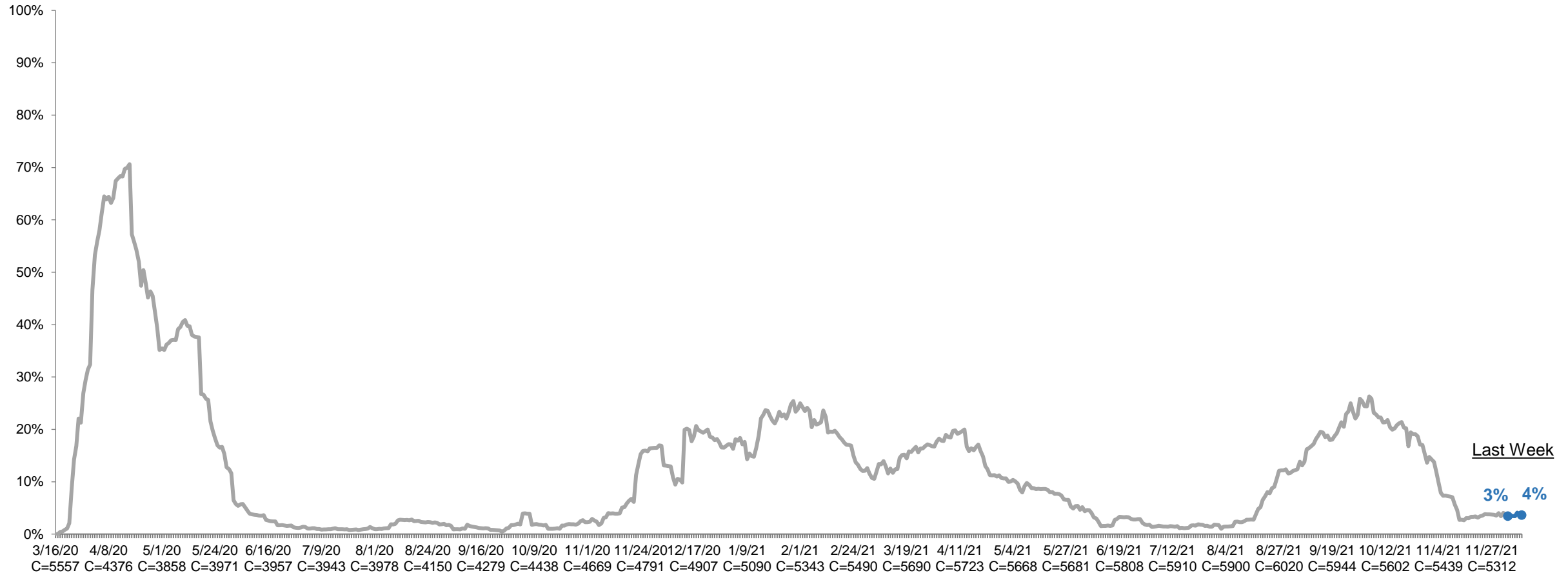

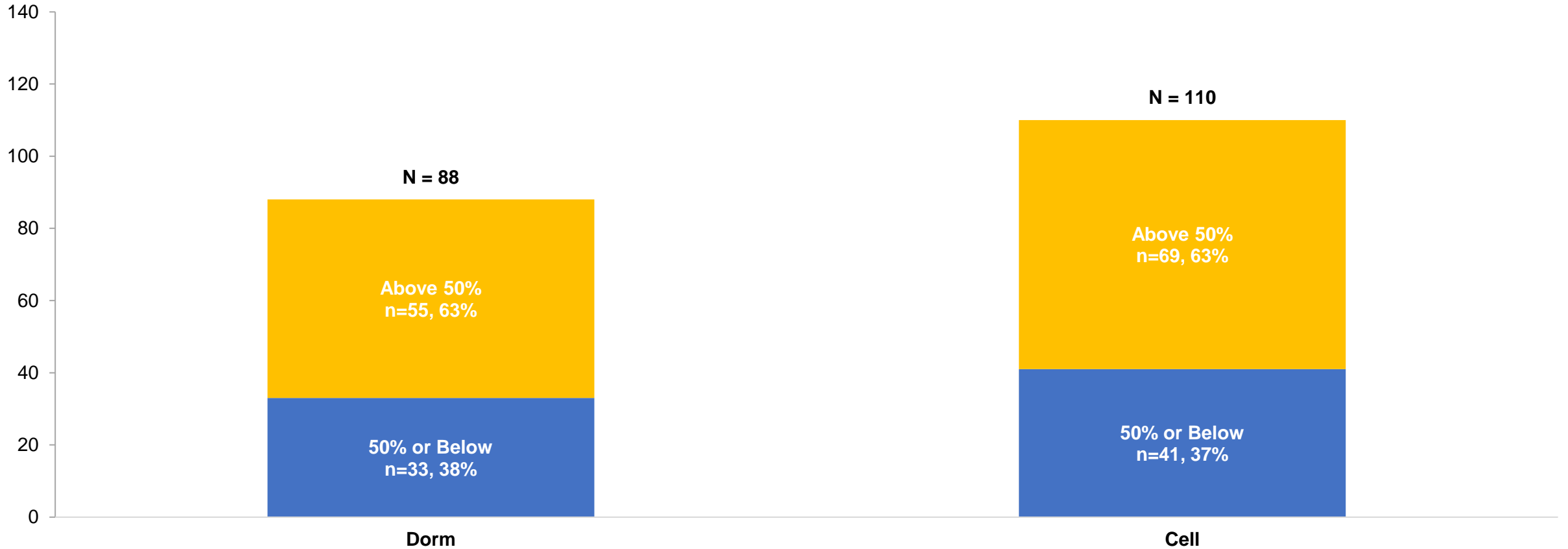

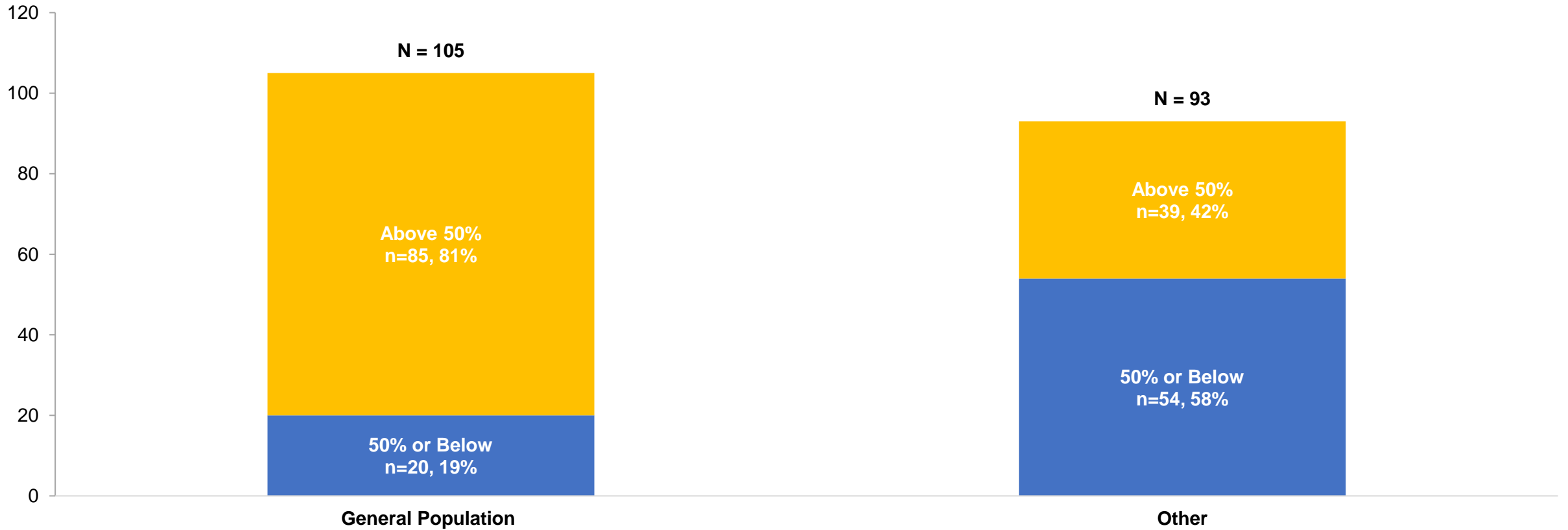

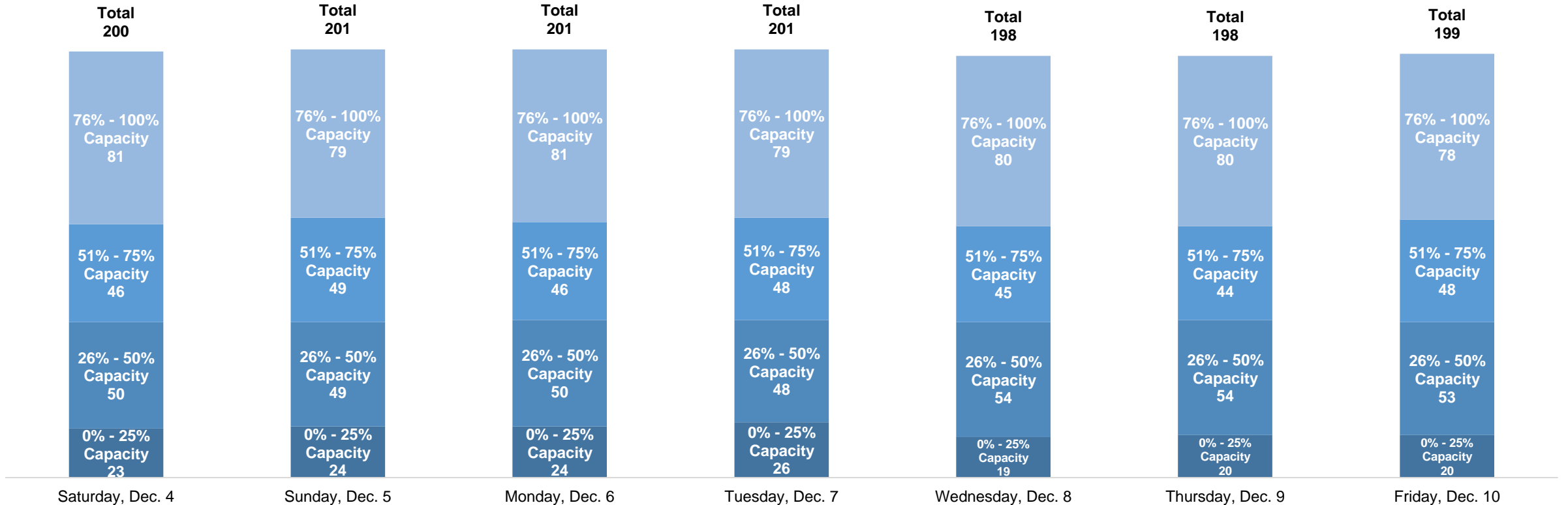
