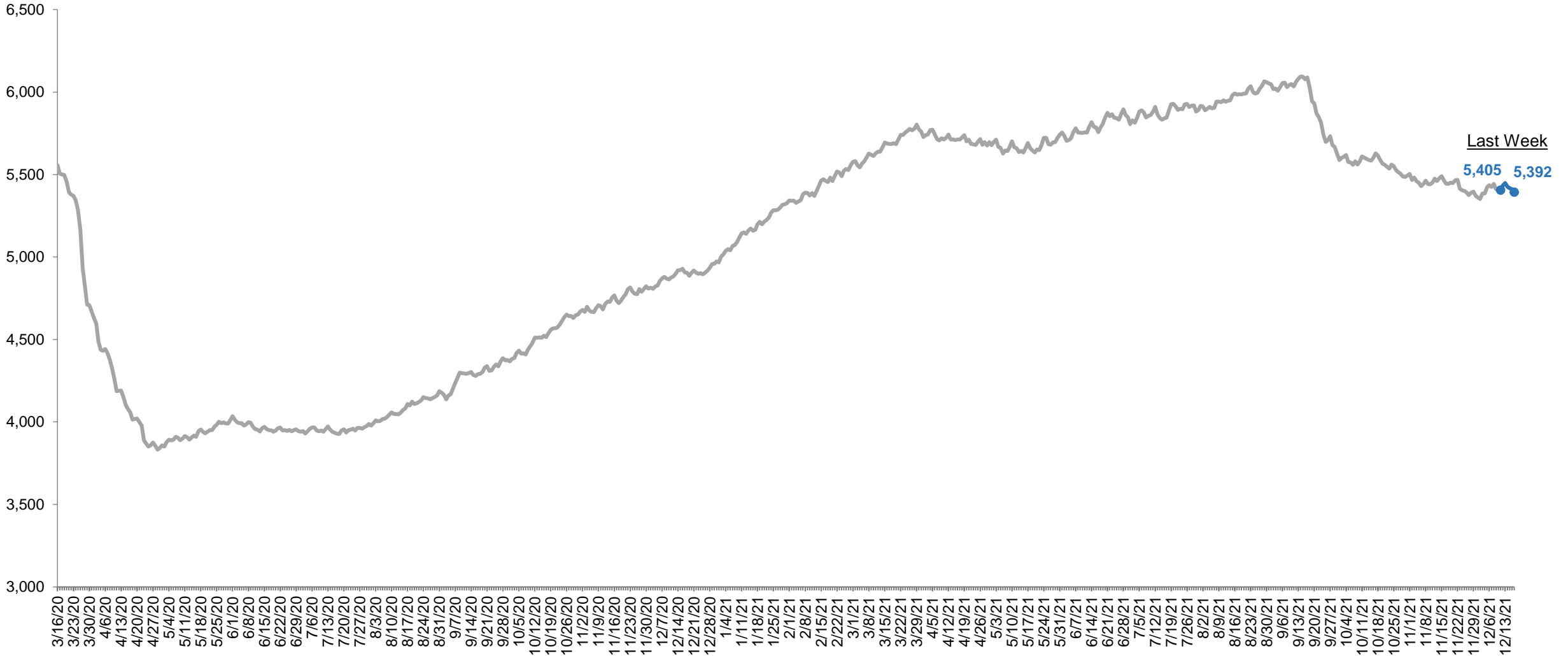

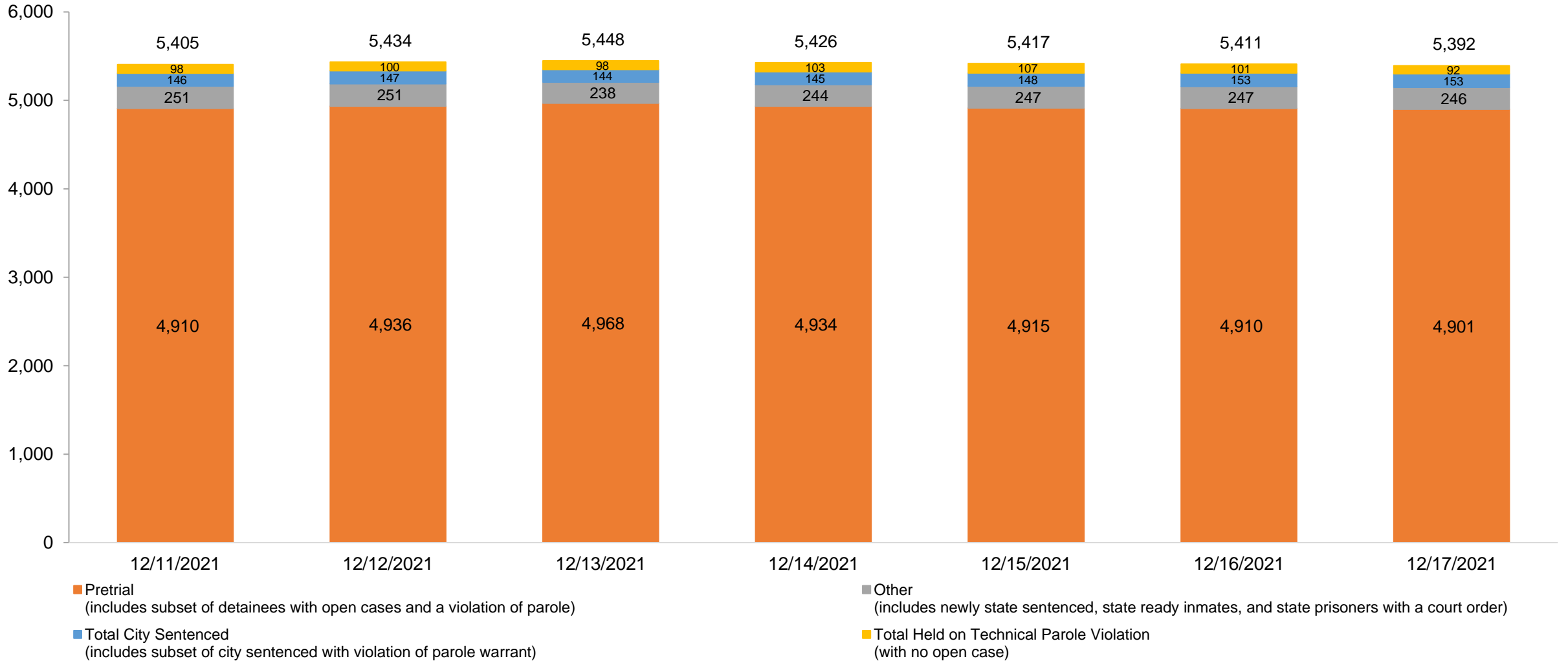
Total Population in DOC Custody

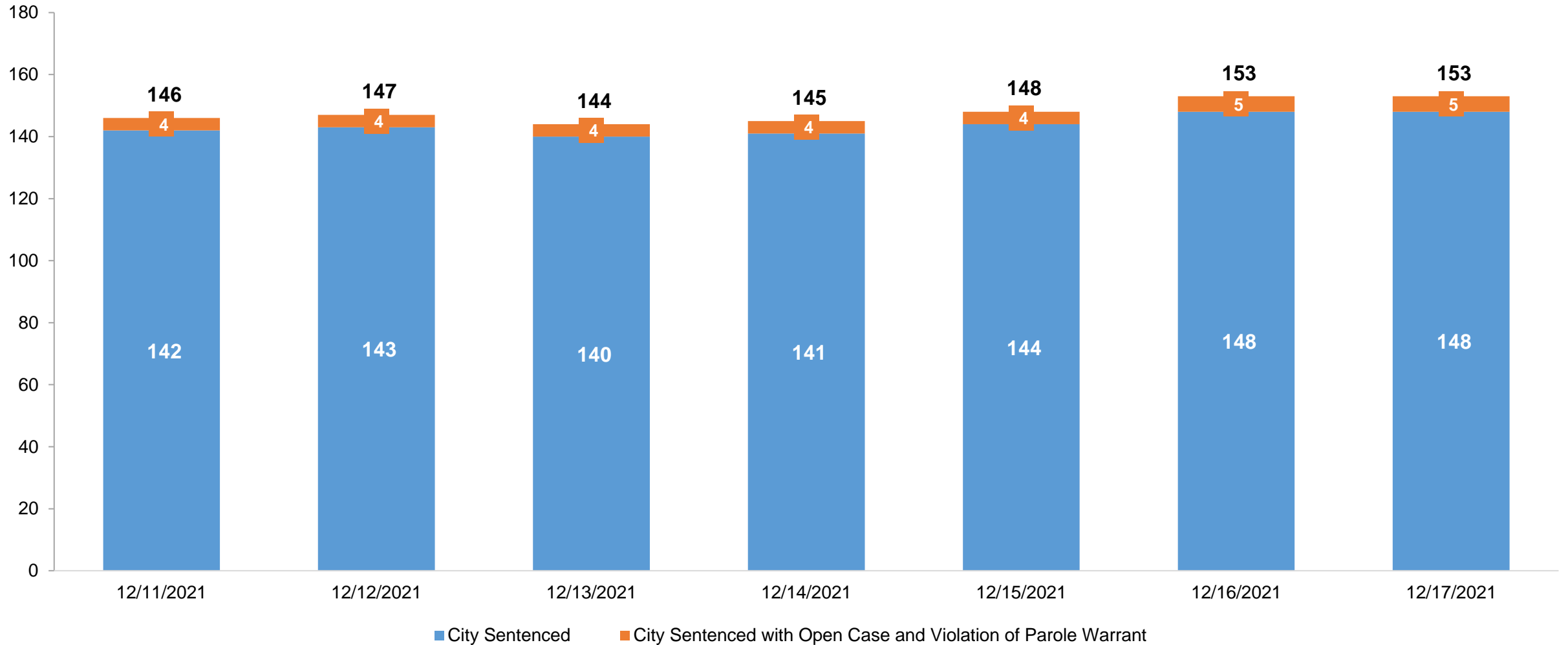

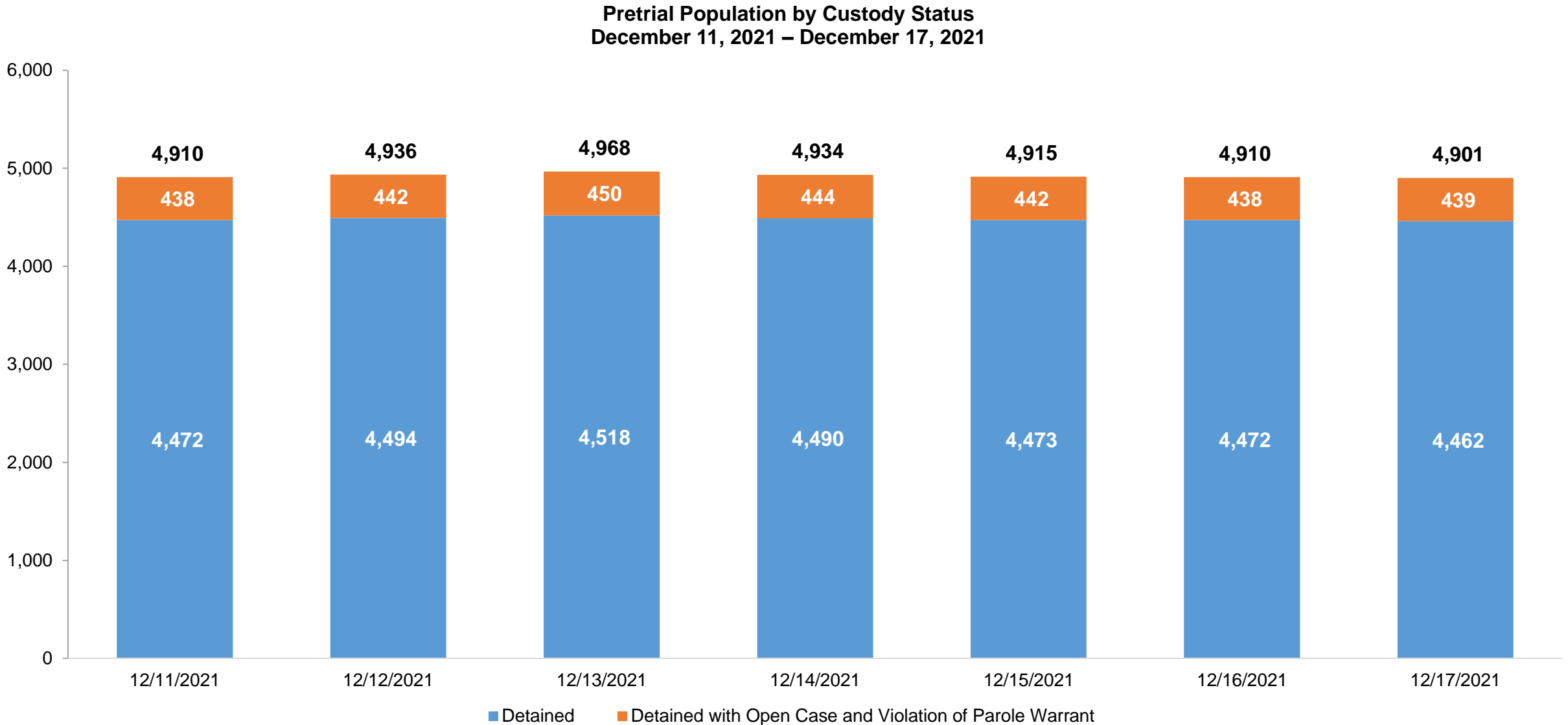

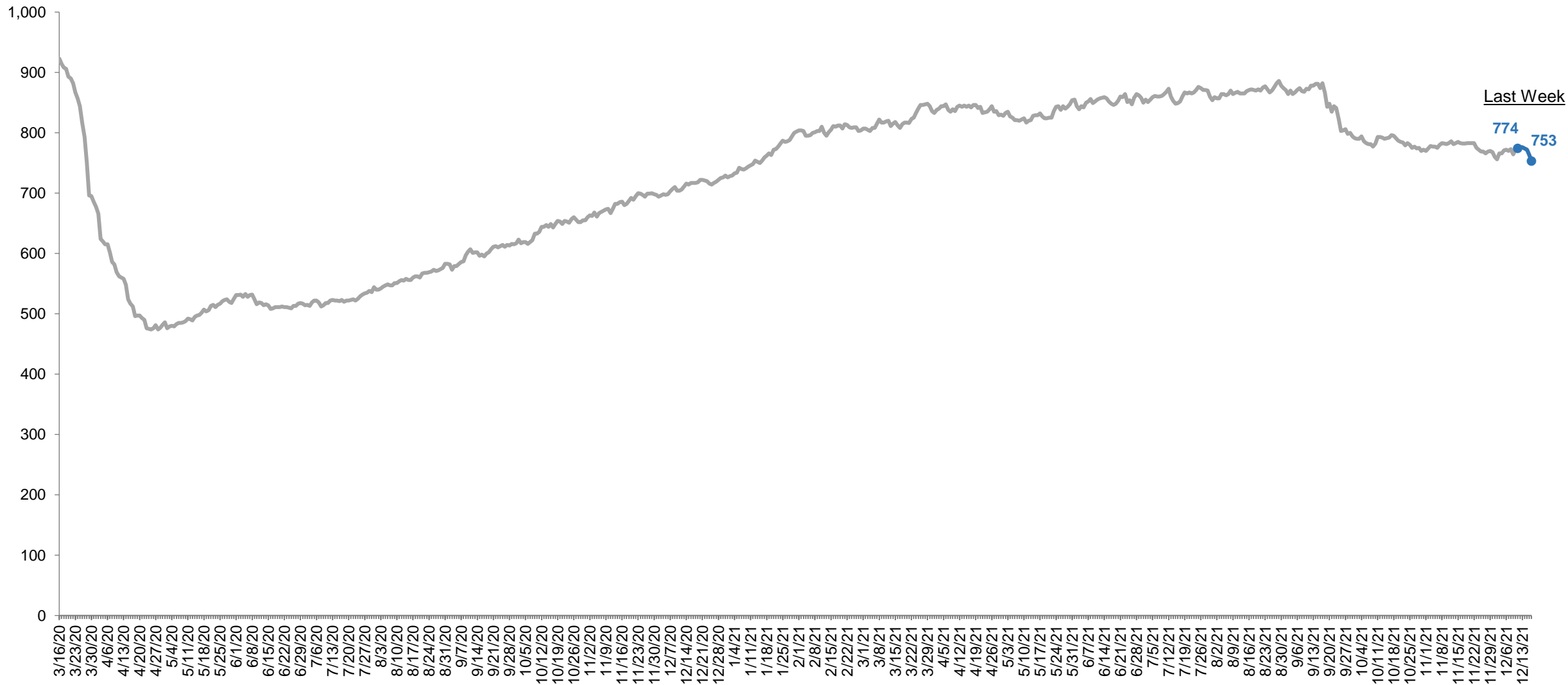

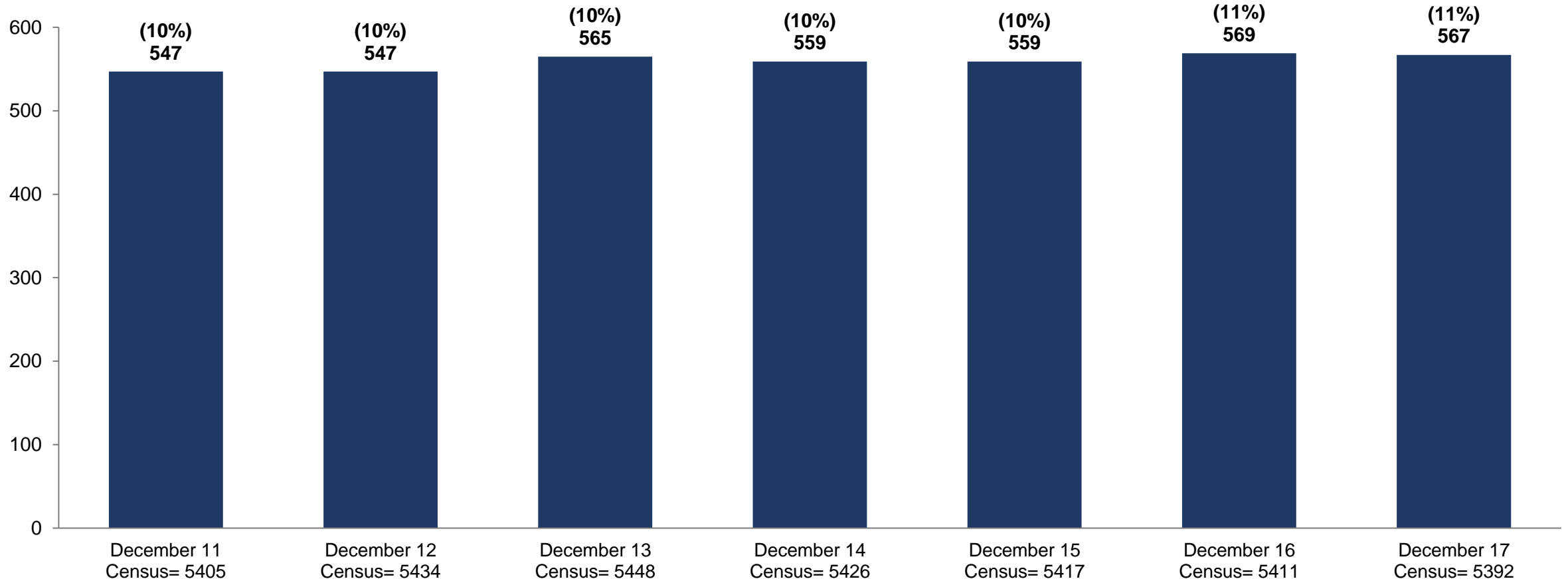

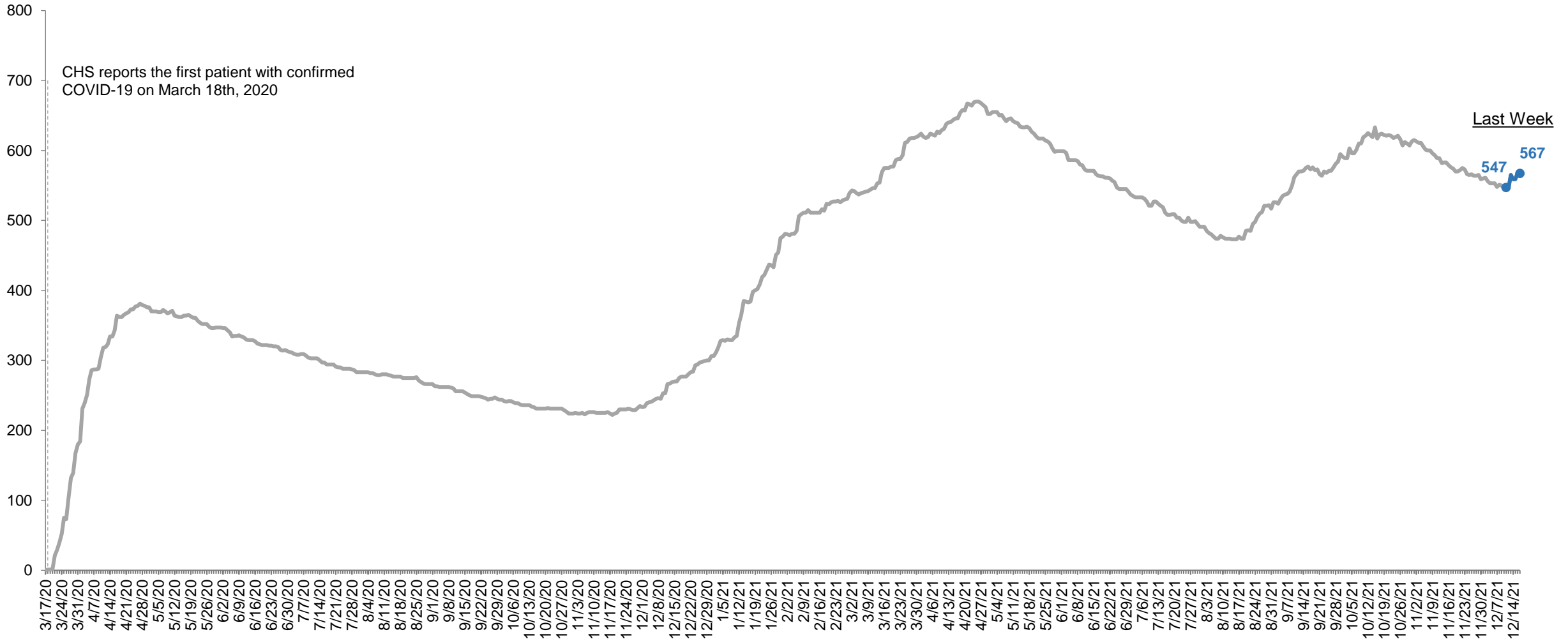
**Number and Percent of Patients Ever Confirmed Positive for COVID-19 While in Custody

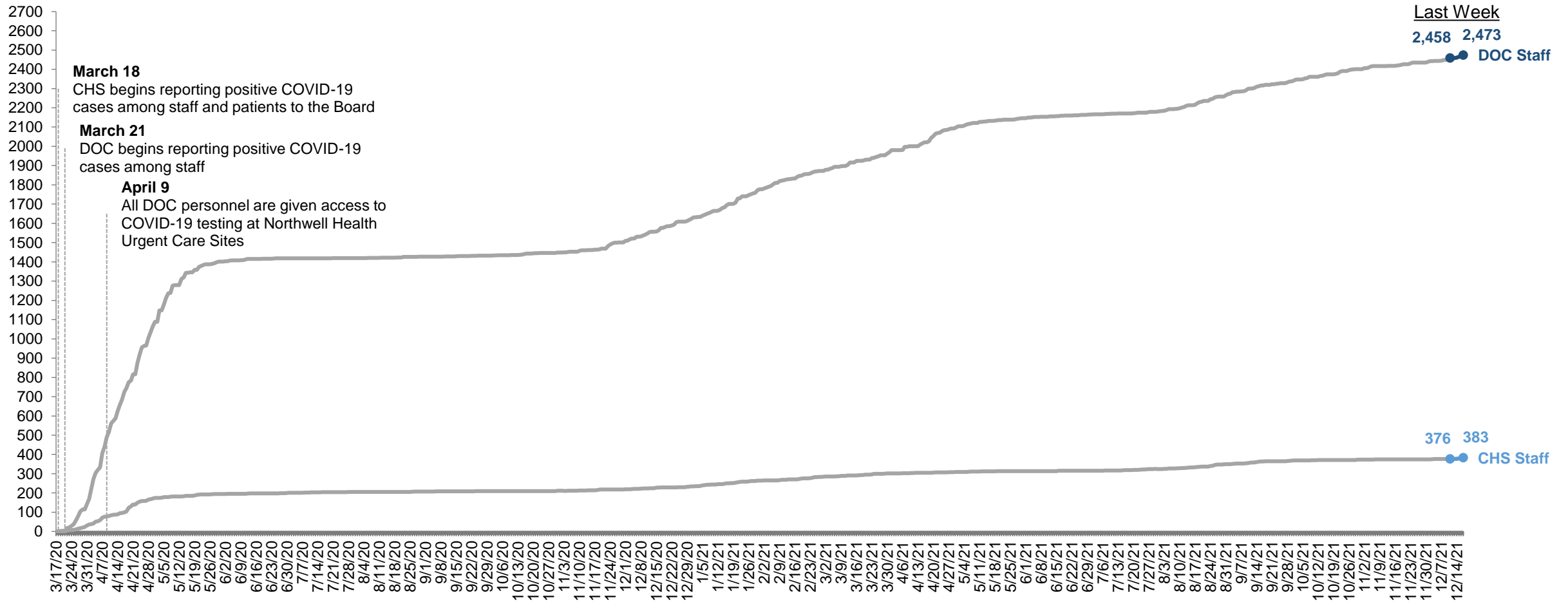

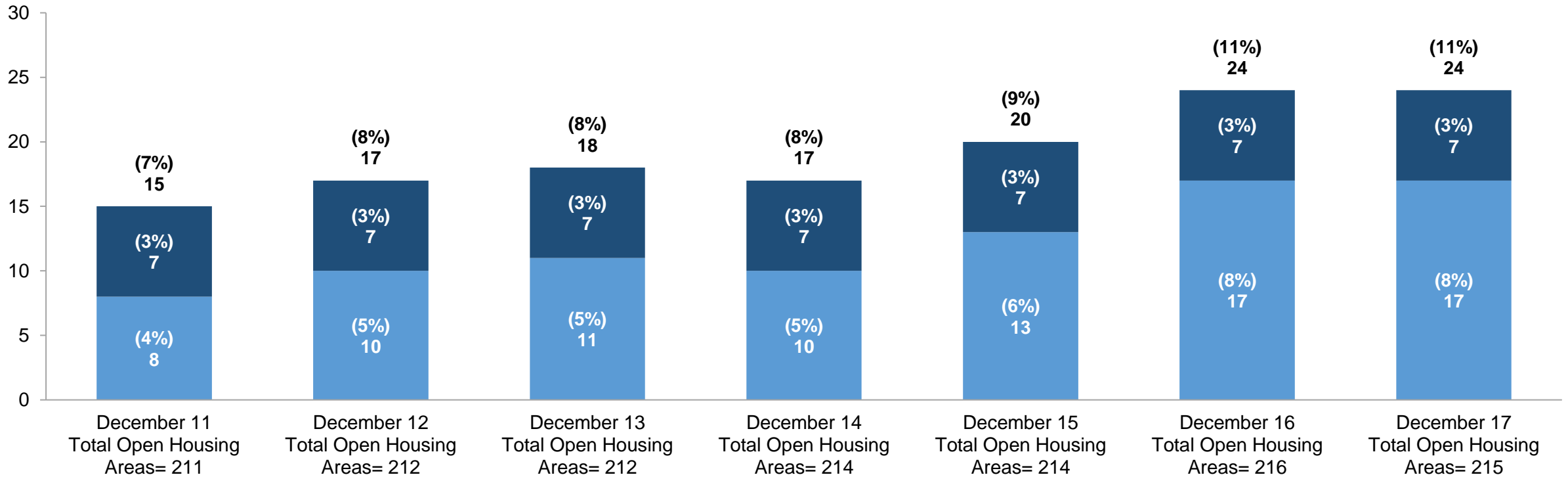

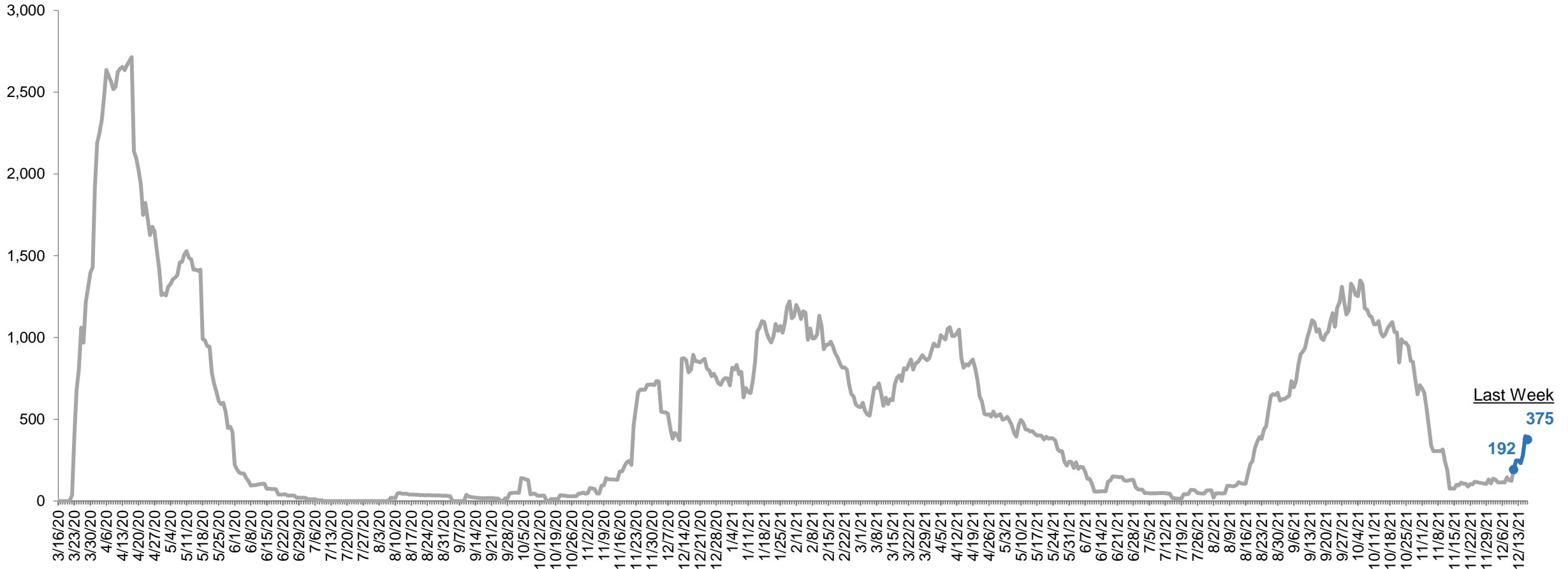

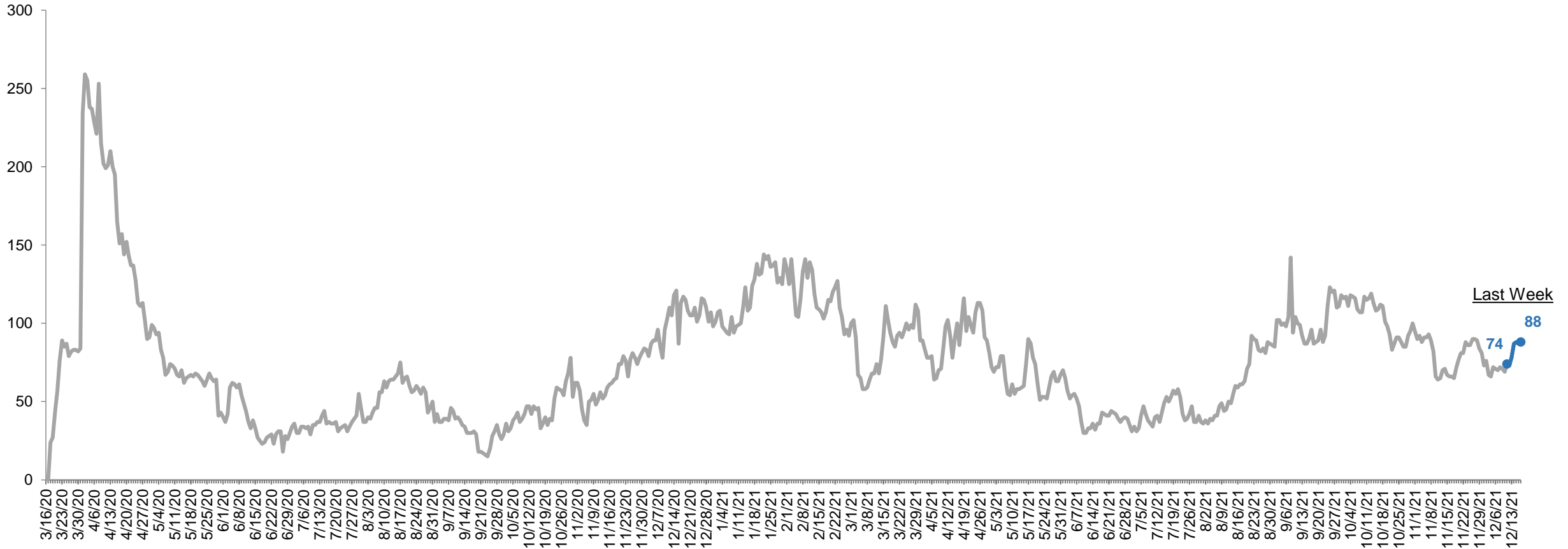

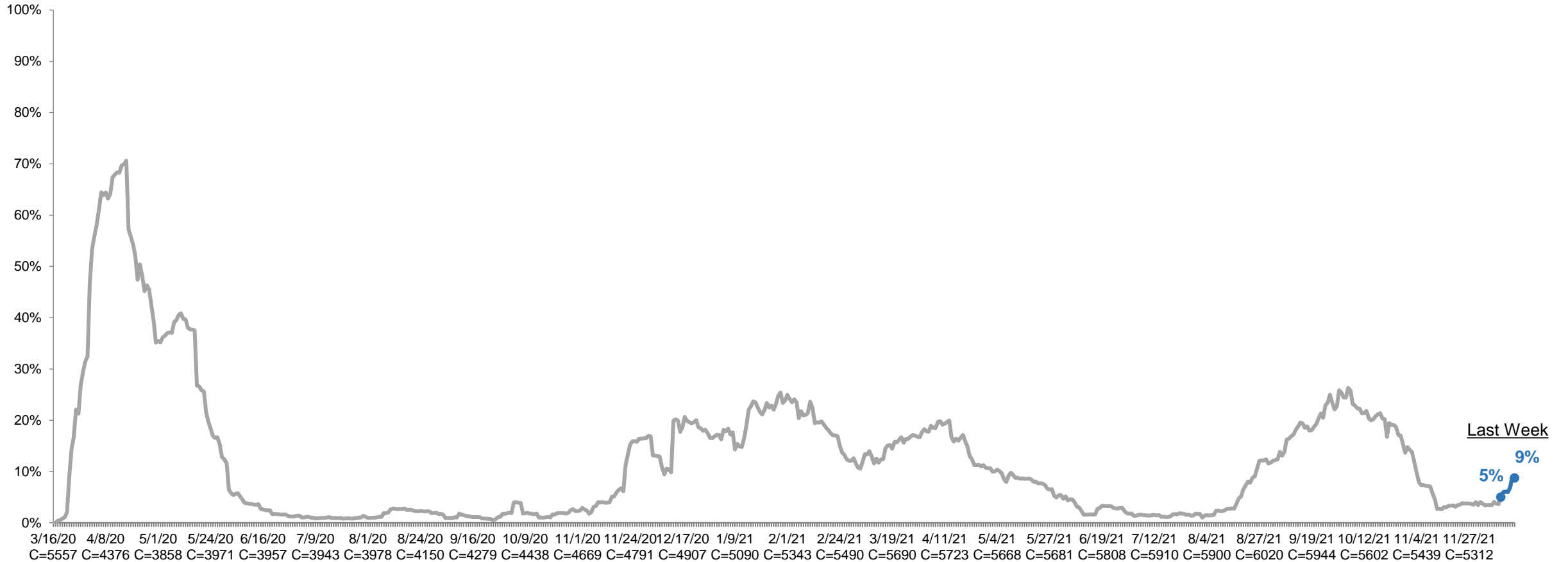

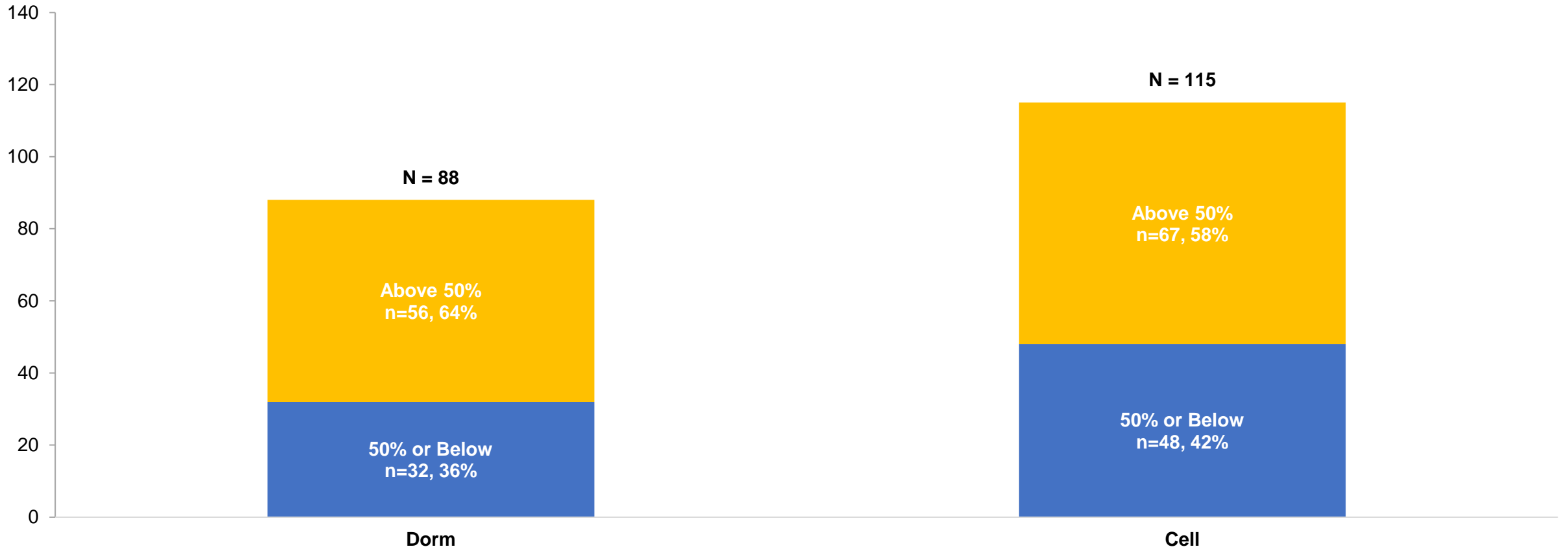

December 16, 2021



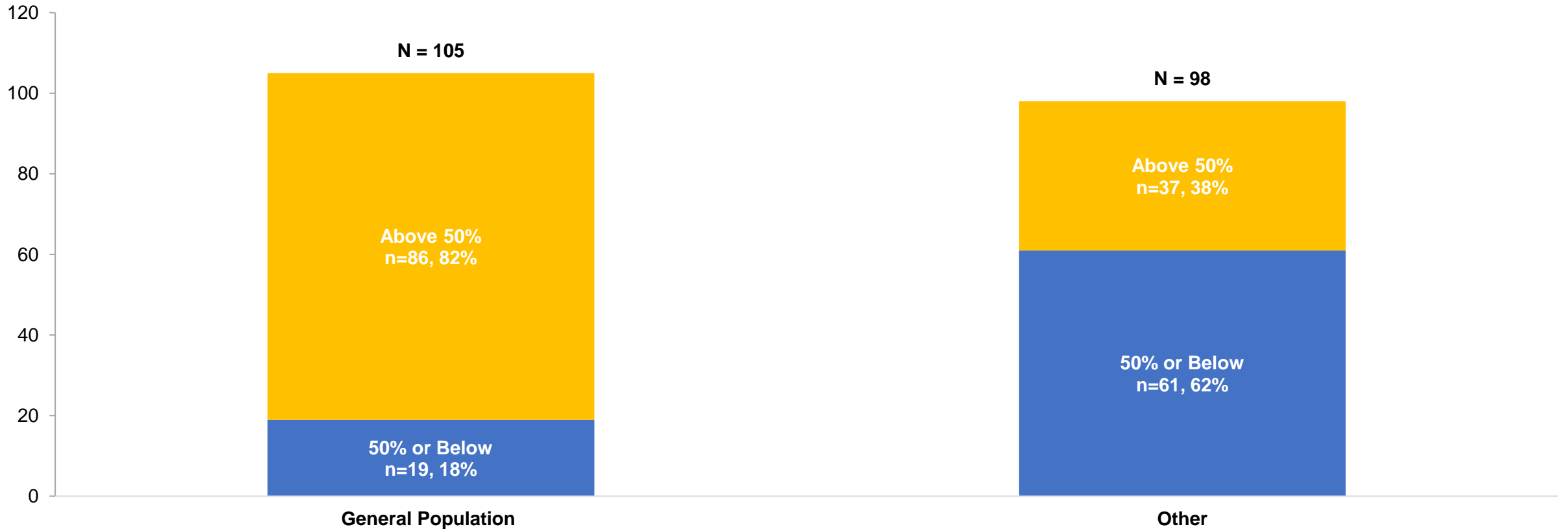

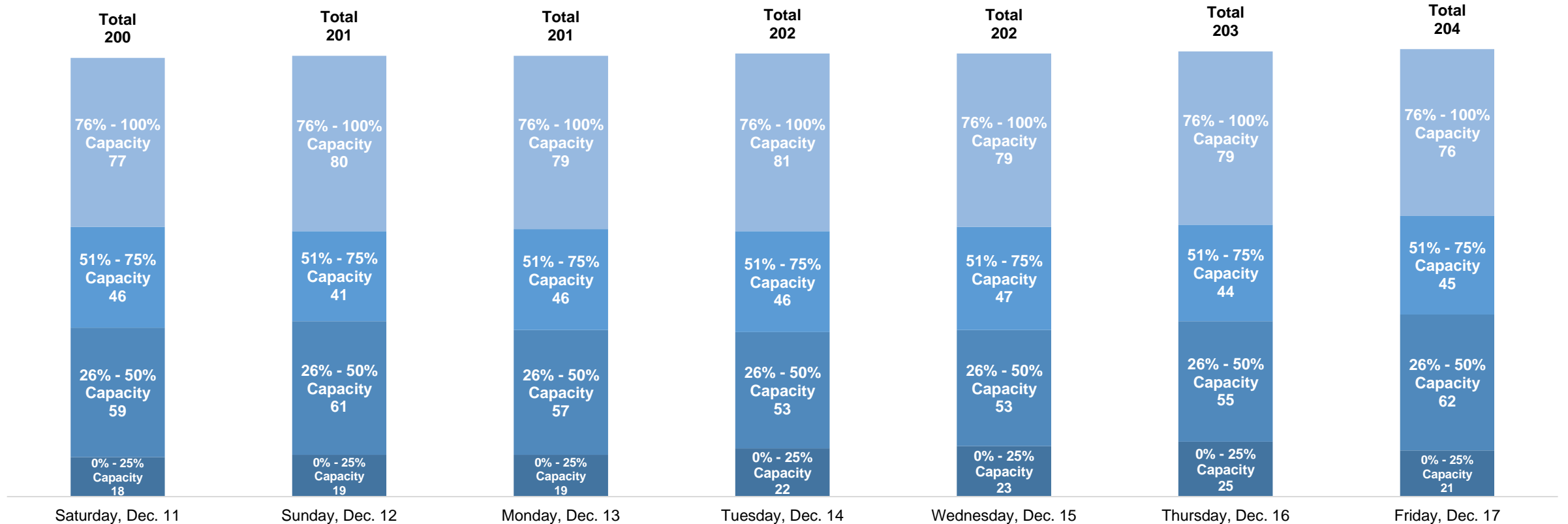
