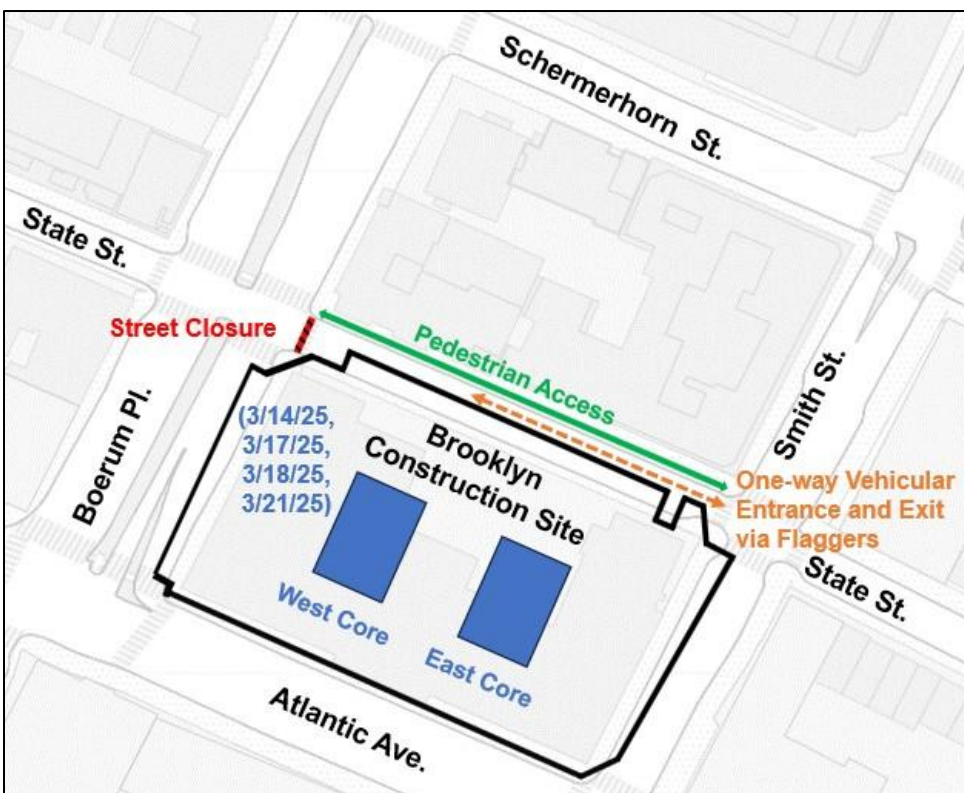

UPDATE State St. Vehicular Access Restrictions

In continuation with the construction of the new Brooklyn Borough-Based Jail Facility, concrete pours are scheduled for the new facility foundations. Concrete truck staging will make State St. open to Authorized Vehicles ONLY (DOC, NYPD, and Enterprise R-A-C). Flaggers will direct pedestrians and vehicles during this work. Pedestrian access on the north side of State St. will remain. Overnight activities will be conducted within permitted hours for extended after-hours work.

Anticipated schedule (with additional dates) as listed below:

- Fri 3/14: start at 9:00 am and will continue for approximately 16 hours with an additional approximate 4 hours for site clean-up and restoration.
- Mon 3/17: start at 9:00 am and will continue for approximately 8 hours including site clean-up and restoration.
- Tue 3/18: start at 9:00 am and will continue for approximately 8 hours including site clean-up and restoration.
- Fri 3/21: start at 9:00 am and will continue for approximately 8 hours including site clean-up and restoration.
