Atlantic Avenue Lane Closures & Parking Restrictions

Scheduled for:

**Saturday, August 15th, 2026 - 7:00 am to 7:00 pm &
Saturday, August 29th, 2026 - 7:00 am to 7:00 pm**

To facilitate the deliveries and loading of large building equipment for the Brooklyn Borough-Based Jail Facility, temporary lane closures and parking restrictions will be implemented along Atlantic Avenue between Boerum Place and Smith Street on Saturday, 8/15 and Saturday, 8/29, from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. *In the event of delays, this work may be rescheduled to a future Saturday, or Sunday - if necessary, weather and field conditions permitting.*

During this work activity, three westbound lanes on Atlantic Avenue will be temporarily closed, and parking will not be permitted on the South side of Atlantic Avenue to maintain traffic flow. Sidewalk access will remain open except during active overhead crane deliveries. All lane closures and parking restrictions will be restored after work hours. During this work activity, Flaggers, Cross guards, and NYPD Traffic Agents will be present to help direct traffic and pedestrians. Noise impacts are anticipated during this operation.
