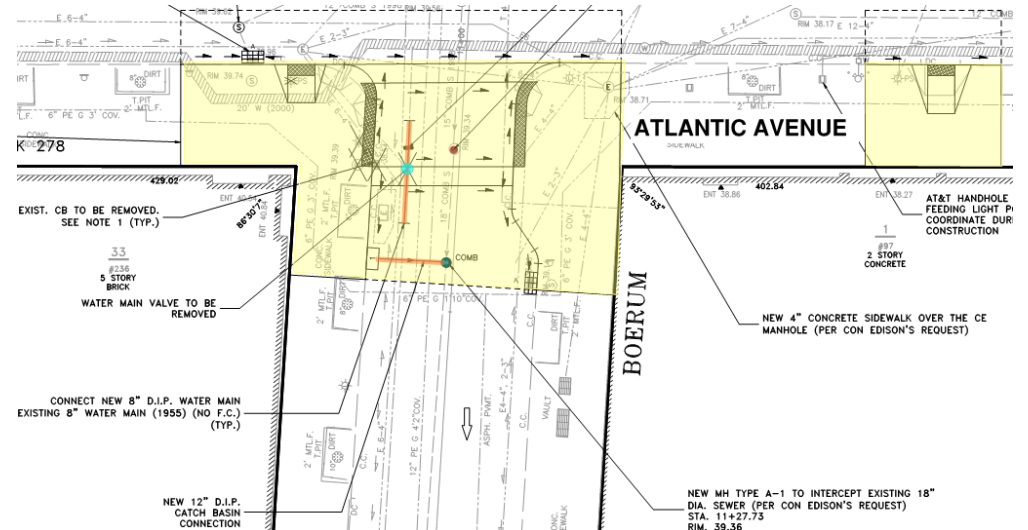

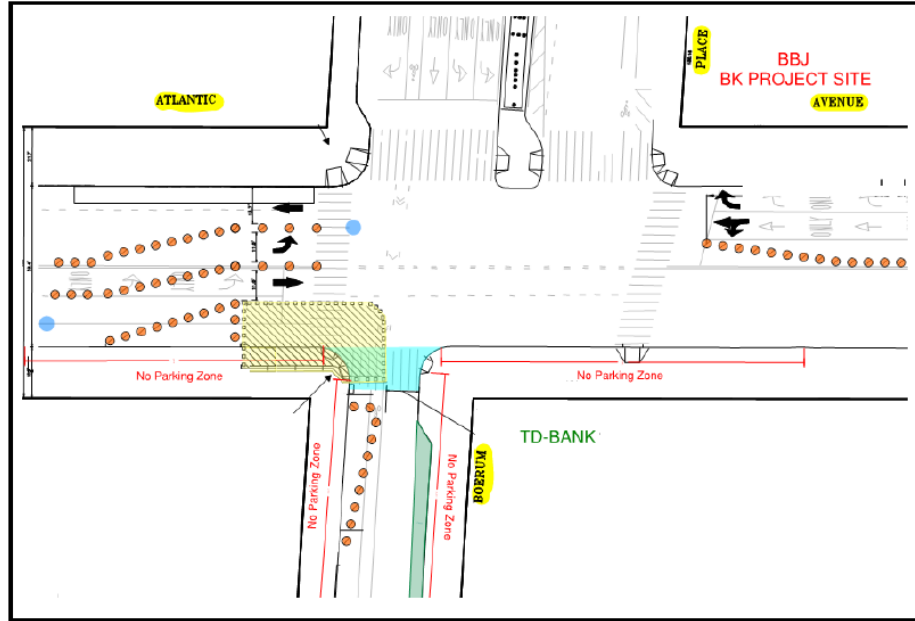

Work Scope at intersection of Atlantic Avenue and Boerum Place:

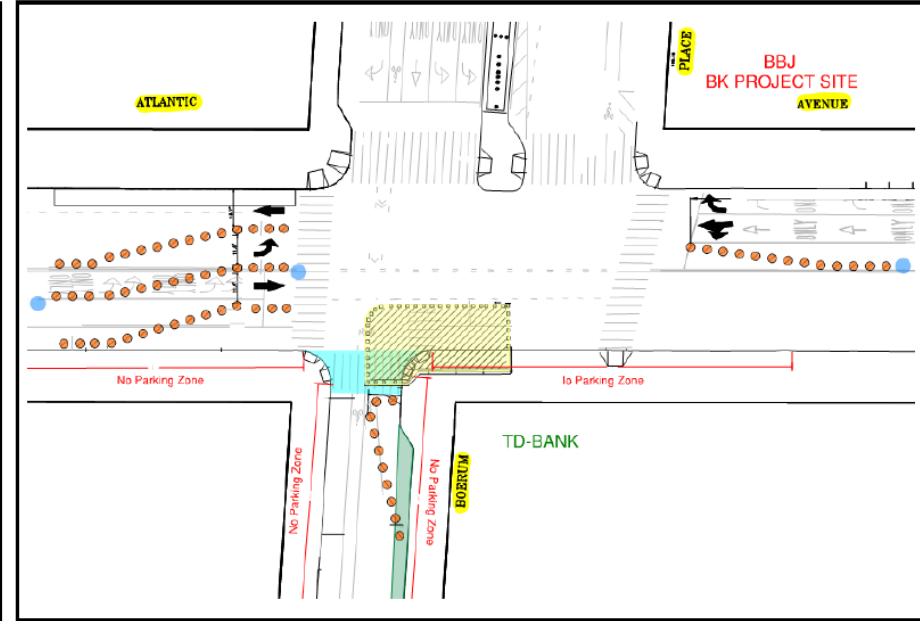
- New ADA compliant ped ramps, raised crosswalk and APS

- Watermain valve relocation
- Installation of new catch basin/chute connection/manhole



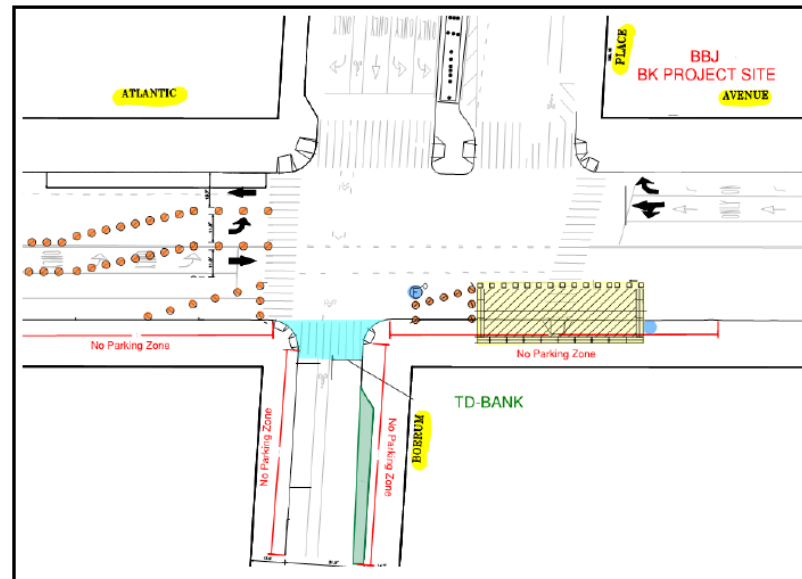
PHASE 1 - 2 WEEKS

Community Impacts:

- Work will be performed within DEP Noise Code and Dust Control Regulations.

Traffic Mitigation:

- 3 lanes of traffic will be maintained on Atlantic Avenue (one left turn eastbound lane, one through eastbound lane and one through westbound lane) during working hours. All travel lanes restored after working hours.
- 4 NYPD traffic agents to assist during construction hours.
- Crosswalk closure for Atlantic Avenue west of Boerum Place during work hours.
- Bike lane will be shared with the Boerum Place southbound vehicles between Atlantic Avenue and Pacific Street.

Parking Impacts:

- Temporary no parking on both sides of Boerum Place between Atlantic Avenue and Pacific Street.
- Access to parking garage and buildings will be maintained.

Water Shutdown Impacts:

- Water shutdown details will be shared with the community once locations and dates are confirmed.
