1/27/25 - 1/31/25	M-F / 6:00 am - 12:00 am	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Foundation construction (Noise / Vibrations / Excavating soil and installation of structural, electrical, and mechanical components for the crane and building foundations / Work will take place inside the perimeter fencing with no public interaction)
1/27/25 - 1/31/25	M-F / 6:00 am - 12:00 am	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Pile drilling (Noise / Vibrations / Drilling within site for foundation and crane structural support piles / Minimal dust expected with mitigation practices to be employed)
1/27/25 - 2/1/25	M-F / 6:00 am - 12:00 am Sat / 9:00 am - 5:00 pm	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Site dewatering (Noise / Vibrations / Excavating soil to expose and remove underground water / Pump will run 24/7 but will be underground, minimizing community noise impacts)
1/27/25 - 1/31/25	M-F / 6:00 am - 12:00 am	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Debris and waste trucking (Noise / Removal of concrete, soil, and buried building remnants from the excavated site / Flaggers will direct pedestrian and vehicular traffic as necessary)
1/27/25 - end of Feb 2025	M-Sun / 24-hour work cycle	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Supportive work for Smith St. MTA tunnel shaft (Noise / Work will take place inside the perimeter fencing with no public interaction / Work will take place overnight for subway system safety and operation)
