6/9/25 – 6/14/25	M – F / 7:00 am – 12:00 am Sat / 9:00 am – 5:00 pm	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Steel Construction (Noise / Delivery, placement, and installation of steel around building cores. / Materials will be delivered by truck and placed inside the site by tower crane. / Installation of steel by use of bolting, welding, and hammering. / Flaggers will direct deliveries into the site)
6/9/25 – 6/14/25	M – F / 7:00 am – 12:00 am Sat / 9:00 am – 5:00 pm	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Smith St. shed construction (Noise / Construction of sidewalk shed over MTA walkway inside the site perimeter / All material staging and work activities will take place inside the site with no public interaction / Flaggers will direct deliveries into the site.)
6/9/25	M / 7:00 am – 12:00 am	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Boerum Pl. sidewalk reconstruction and shed construction (Noise / Vehicular and pedestrian access restrictions / Reconstruction of the Boerum Pl. sidewalk followed by construction of sidewalk shed / The Boerum Pl. pedestrian walkway will be closed and flaggers will direct pedestrians across the perimeter of the site on Boerum Pl.)
6/9/25 – 6/14/25	M – F / 10:00 am – 6:00 pm Sat / 9:00 am – 5:00 pm	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Atlantic Ave. utility tie-ins (Noise / Vibrations / Saw-cutting the roadway and jackhammering to excavate road materials to expose existing utility connections and install new utility tie-ins / Flaggers will direct pedestrian traffic as necessary)
