Foundation Work

Planned to start July 13th, 2026 through February 2027

In continuation of construction for the Bronx Borough-Based Jail Facility, concrete foundation placement work is anticipated to begin July 13th, 2026. Extended hours work and Saturday work may occur on an as-needed basis due to extended pours, equipment breakdowns, or weather delays, with the following schedule:

- Mondays – Fridays: 6:00 am – 6:00 pm
- Saturdays: 7:00 am – 6:00 pm

Working hours will be in accordance with the authorized NYC Department of Buildings (DOB) After Hours Variance (AHV). Noise, dust, vibration impacts, and increased truck traffic along 141st Street are expected. Flaggers will be on site to direct trucks entering and exiting the site and to manage pedestrian and vehicular traffic during this mobilization. Please see the graphic below for location details:
