# Policy & Legislation Committee Minutes April 17th, 2025

### **Dalourny Nemorin, Committee Chairperson**

### New York State Budget Delays and Policy Discussions

- Committee Chair Dalourny Nemorin calls the meeting to order, skipping introductions and old business.
