Executive Committee Minutes January 6th, 2025 Clarisa Alayeto, Chairperson

Municipal Services Cancellation and Calendar Updates

- District Manager Anthony Jordan explains that municipal services were canceled due to the flood and the need to reschedule.
- Committee Chair Leslie Lopez Hernandez is thanked for her cooperation in making flyers and getting information out.
- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto emphasizes the need to inform people about meeting locations.
- Committee Chair Leslie Lopez Hernandez mentions creating a flyer on Canva and confirms no other changes to the calendar.

District Needs and Committee Priorities

- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto outlines the top district needs: sanitation, safety, and affordable housing.
- Emphasis on focusing on these priorities for the next six months.
- Committee Chair Zion Baldwin discusses upcoming ACS visit and the need for quality services at home.
- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto stresses the importance of collaboration between committee cochairs.

Youth and Education Committee Plans

- Committee Chair Zion Baldwin mentions planning a job fair for April and creating game nights.
- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto suggests focusing on voter registration for 18-24-year-olds and literacy.
- Discussion on involving committee members like Christina and Jackie Thomas in special needs and literacy initiatives.

- Discussion on the need for community education and engagement on these issues.

Community Board Office and Communication Challenges

- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto suggests creating a WhatsApp group for the executive team to improve communication.
- Discussion on the need for better flyering in the community to inform residents about meetings.
- Emphasis on the importance of community engagement and proactive solutions.

LGBTQ Committee and Community Outreach

- Committee Chair Audrey Dejesus expresses the need for more members in the LGBTQ committee.
- Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto suggests scheduling time to plan the next steps for the LGBTQ committee.
- Discussion on the impact of the departure of Michael Brady and the need for community outreach.
- Emphasis on the importance of addressing the needs of the LGBTQ community and finding resources for support.

Community Screenings and Engagement

 Committee Chair Evelyn Alvarez suggests organizing community screenings of movies like "Emilia" to promote understanding and engagement.

Schedule a meeting with Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto and Stephanie to plan the Youth and Education Committee's activities.

Invite the Department of Transportation, Sanitation, and Environmental Services to the Aging Committee meeting to address concerns about bus stop locations and bus parking.

Create a flyer to recruit more members for the Aging Committee.

Schedule a meeting with Chairperson Clarisa Alayeto to plan the next steps for the LGBTQ Committee.

Send an email to the executive team with a prompt for each committee chair to identify their top 3 solutions for addressing the issues in their committee.
