The committee meeting commenced at 7:30 P.M by Pledge of Allegiance. D. Krynicki spoke how well the parks and playgrounds in our community have been maintained throughout the summer. M. Anderson, Pelham Bay Park Administrator, spoke of the flooding within the borough parks. Pelham Bay Park was well attended throughout the summer but has not yet reached 2019 levels. M.
