Economic Development Committee Meeting (rev.) Tuesday, Jan. 3, 2023

The meeting began at 7 pm with the pledge of Allegiance.

All attendees were welcomed. Each was advised that when called upon to state name, position and provide an overview of the establishment. The P.O, Reports were gone over and discussed with the Committee. One renewal establishment was tabled for the February meeting because a representative was not present.

The following Resolution for renewal licenses was read and voted on unanimously:

Mr. Accomando noted the Mr. Caruso drafted a letter of compliance and Mr. Accomando advise the committee that this was a letter of compliance only and not in support. The Committee was supplied with a copy of the letter. A motion to draft letter was made by Mr. Bieder and 2nd by Mr. Chirico. The vote was unanimous.

New Business: Mr. Claudio addressed the committee at this time. He informed the committee that he was appointed by the mayor as the ACS Director of gangs and that he is offering his services when needed to community board 10. Mr. Accomando suggested he attend the 45th Precinct Community Council meeting 1/5/23 Thursday and introduce himself to the new Captain of the 45th Precinct.
